- All eight high school recruits are ranked in the top 15 in their respective state and in the top 400 nationally.
- Class is made up of eight (8) pitchers, two (2) infielders, one utility player and one catcher.
- Rated by StudentSportsBaseball.com as the No. 1 recruiting class in the nation.
