Head Swimming Coach, Michael Chasson --

Chasson is in his fourth season heading the men's and women's swimming programs at ASU after seven with Harvard. There, he coached the Crimson to six Eastern Seaboard Championships and was named Ivy League Coach of the Year three times.

At ASU, Chasson has led the men to NCAA finishes of 16th, 10th and 14th, while the women have placed 23rd once and 21st the past two seasons. 21 swimmers have accumulated 35 All-America honors during his tenure. He is assisted by Keri Buff, John Pontz and Adam Schmitt.

ASU MEETS TEXAS IN TUCSON, HOSTS NAU

February 1-3, 2002 • Tucson, Ariz./Tempe, Ariz.

They may not have to face the nation's best teams, as they did over the weekend at No. 1 Stanford, but the competition doesn't get any easier for Arizona State's men's and women's swimming and diving teams this weekend. In a pair of meets held at the University of Arizona's Hillenbrand Aquatic Center, Feb. 1-2, the 5th-ranked Sun Devil men will challenge No. 3 Texas, while the No. 7 Sun Devil women go up against a Texas team that's ranked second in the nation. Friday's meet is scheduled to begin at 2:00 p.m. MST, with Saturday's contest getting underway at 9:00 a.m. But the weekend won't end there for the Sun Devil women, who return home to host Northern

Arizona in intrastate dual action Sunday, February 3, at Mona Plummer Aquatic Center at $1:00\ p.m.\ MST$ (previously scheduled for noon).

The College Swimming Coaches Association of America (CSCAA) releases national rankings on a bi-weekly basis. After both Sun Devil teams debuted at No. 13 in the polls (Nov. 1), in the most recent Jan. 17 rankings the ASU men are fifth for the second straight poll, with the women holding a season-best No. 7 ranking. A complete list of those current rankings appears on Page 2 of this release. The next poll will be released January 31, just prior to ASU's weekend meets. For more information, access www.cscaa.org.

ASU vs. Texas

The Longhorn men are 4-1 in dual meets this year and are ranked third in the nation behind only Stanford and Auburn. For all their talent inside the lanes, the Longhorns' top athlete is arguably senior Troy Dumais, a two-time NCAA Diver of the Year. The men are coached by Eddie Reese.

The Texas women's team, which has defeated the likes of Georgia and Florida in dual meets this season, boasts a 7-2 record. Among those to watch is senior Lauren Thies, who has posted some of the nation's fastest times this season in the 100 free (49.26), 200 free (1:45.38) and 500 free (4:43.42). The UT women are led by co-head coaches Jill Sterkel and Mike Walker.

Excluding the Texas Invitational or the NCAA Championships, ASU hasn't matched up against Texas since the end of the 1999-2000 season, when (again at Tucson) UT prevailed 206-147 (men) and 190.5-162.5 (women).

ASU vs. Northern Arizona

The NAU Lumberjacks are 2-6 on the dual season, most recently falling at home to Missouri, 123-75. The ASU and NAU women have met annually since the 1992-93 season, with ASU a perfect 9-0 in that span. Last season, the Sun Devils knocked off NAU 186-107 on Senior Day. The Jacks are coached by Andy Johns.

ASU, LAST TIME IN THE POOL

Having put together their longest dual meet winning streaks since the 1991-92 seasons, ASU's undefeated (5-0) men's and women's teams made the difficult Bay Area road trip to challenge California (No. 7 men/ No. 6 women) and (No. 1/No. 1) Stanford. Both Sun Devil teams came away with a pair of losses, but that didn't diminish a weekend of impressive swimming. Most notable was freshman Ágnes Kovács, who went head-to-head with the defending NCAA champion in the 200y breast, Stanford's Tara Kirk. Kovács swam what is believed to be the fastest dual meet 200y breast in NCAA history, a 2:10.40, to edge Kirk by nearly a second (2:11.28).

UP NEXT FOR THE SUN DEVILS

ASU has but one dual meet remaining before it heads into the post-season. Saturday, February 16, the Sun Devil swimming and diving teams host arch-rival Arizona at Mona Plummer Aquatic Center at noon.

SARAH BAHAM (ALL-AMERICAN -- SENIOR) --

Notched NCAA automatic qualifying times in the 100 fly (54.34) and 200 fly (1:58.84) at the Texas Invitational, placing fourth in both. Also swam a consideration time of 4:19.26 in the 400 IM (10th). Swam a victorious 2:00.59 in the 200 fly at Cal last weekend.

CLAIRE HEDENSKOG (ALL-AMERICAN -- JUNIOR) --

Improved her personal bests in the 50 and 100 free at the Texas Invitational. Placed seventh in the 50 free (23.32), matching her prelim time. Placed eighth in the 100 free in 50.71, although her prelim time of 50.32 made her the second-fastest Sun Devil ever in the event. Only school record holder Nancy Osborne has raced faster (49.90). Sat out a few meets due to injury, but made her return vs. Cal.

Although his finals time in the 100 back made him the second fastest Sun Devil ever in the event (behind only Pablo Abal's 47.85), Hussein's prelim time in the 200 back (1:45.07) ranked him third all-time at ASU in that event. Both of Hussein's bests are NCAA consideration times.

While improving her collegiate bests in four events, became the school record holder in two of them at the Texas Invitational. Won the 200 breast in an NCAA automatic qualifying time of 2:07.98, almost a full second ahead of her nearest competitor (Stanford's Tara Kirk: 2:08.84), and almost two seconds ahead of the previous ASU record (Beata Kaszuba's 2:09.71). Placed third in the 400 IM in an NCAA automatic time of 4:11.68, besting Carolyn Adel's ASU record of 4:13.05 by more than a second. In the 100 breast, improved her best to 1:00.68 (NCAA auto), placing third. In the 200 IM, placed fifth with an NCAA consideration standard of 2:01.27. At Stanford, touched the wall in 2:10.40 to defeat defending national champion Tara Kirk with what is believed to be the fastest dual meet time in NCAA history. NCAA History • None.

ANDERS LYRBRING (ALL-AMERICAN -- JUNIOR) --

Earned season-bests in the 100 and 200 free at the Texas Invitational. Placed 12th in the 100 free in 45.26 (45.13 in prelims), but finished third in the 200 free in an NCAA consideration time of 1:37.10, the fastest time by a Sun Devil this season.

Also at the Invite, notched consideration times in the 50 free (20.25), 100 free (44.84) and 100 fly (48.56). In finals of those latter events, placed sixth, sixth and seventh, respectively.

Also moved to sixth all-time at ASU with her 18th-place showing in the 100 fly (55.53).

Although shy of her personal best time of 4:49.44 in prelims, placed eighth in the 500 free at the Texas Invitational in 4:52.33. Finished sixth in the 1650 free with a personal best of 16:37.36. SUN DEVIL WOMEN'S RELAYS --

The Sun Devils established three ASU records at the Texas Invitational. In the 400 free, a team of Szigeti, Wilcox, Baham and Hedenskog clocked in at 3:22.03. In the 200 medley and 400 medley relays, Shald, Kovacs, Baham and Hedenskog went 1:40.87 and 3:39.50, respectively. The 400 medley effort was an NCAA automatic qualifier. ASU's other consideration standards are 1:33.63 in the 200 free relay and 7:18.85 in the 800 free relay.
