





MEET THE SUN DEVILS











Jacquelyn Johnson 5-8 • RS Junior • Multi-Events Yuma, Ariz. (Yuma HS)

Arizona State: One of the most accomplished athletes in Sun Devil history... has won three NCAA titles and earned four All-America honors in two years... following the season, was selected by the USTFCCCA as the 2006 Women's Co-National Field Athlete of the Year after earning the Women's West District Field Athlete of the Year honor... returns in 2007 as the favorite to win the indoor pentathlon and the outdoor heptathlon national crowns for the second year in a row... will also look to capture her third Pac-10 title in the heptathlon and become just the third woman to do so in conference history.

2006 Outdoor: Won her second heptathlon title in as many years, adding the 2006 crown to her 2004 title... won the event with 5,939 points with individual event wins in the 100m hurdles (13.34), high jump (1.78m/5-10.00) and long jump (6.09m/19-11.75)... her hurdle time is the fastest in school history in the heptathlon... victory earned her the fourth All-America honor of her career and led to two other awards: USTFCCCA Women's Co-National Field Athlete of the Year and USTFCCCA Women's West District Field Athlete of the Year... secured her second Pac-10 heptathlon title with a career-high 5,987 points and was named Pac-10 Athlete of the Week (May 9)... scored 29 points to help team to first Pac-10 title... finished second in the high jump, third in the 100m hurdles, sixth in the long jump and ran the third leg of the second-place 4x400m relay squad... scored in the heptathlon (10), high jump (8), 100m hurdles (6), long jump (3) and 4x400m relay (2)... selected Academic All-Pac-10 Honorable Mention... 2006 Indoor: Captured her first indoor multi-event title by winning the pentathlon with 4,287 points... won the pentathlon hurdles in 8.37, just off her personal best of 8.34 set earlier in the season... victory gave her the third All-America honor of her career... also competed in the individual high jump competition, tying for 14th place overall (1.76m/5-09.25)... in the pentathlon, won titles at the MPSF Championships (4,207 points) and the Husky Invitational (3,998 points)... 2005 Track: Redshirted following season of basketball for the Sun Devils...hoops team advanced to the Sweet 16...played in 17 games for the Sun Devils... 2004 Outdoor: Became the first Sun Devil since the 1996 outdoor season to win an NCAA title with her victory in the heptathlon...scored 5,807 points on her way to upsetting the defending champion...earned All-America honors in the heptathlon...also won the Pac-10 Championship in the heptathlon one week before winning the conference high jump crown and placing eighth in the 100m hurdles...selected as the 2004 Pac-10 Newcomer of the Year and Pac-10 Athlete of the Week (May 10)...ranks highly on several event lists for ASU...seventh all-time in the 100m hurdles (13.52), sixth in the high jump (1.77m) and second in the heptathlon (5,807 points)...also competed in the 2004 US Olympic Team trials, placing 12th in the meet... 2004 Indoor: Took national runner-up honors in her first NCAA meet, placing second in the pentathlon with 4,263 points...earned All-America honors for her NCAA finish...opened her collegiate career in stellar fashion by winning the pentathlon at the Boise State/Holiday Inn Invitational with 4,044 points...at that meet, won all five individual events (60m hurdles, high jump, shot put, long jump and 800m run)...helped lead the women to wins over Arizona and Northern Arizona at the Double Dual by winning the individual high jump and 55m hurdles while placing second in the long jump and running the third leg of the winning 4x400m relay team. High School: Graduate of Yuma High School (Yuma, Ariz.)...one of the most decorated athletes in Arizona high school history as a winner of 14 state titles in track and field... Johnson won gold four times in the high jump and long jump while winning state titles in the 100m hurdles and triple jump three times...in her sophomore and senior seasons, Johnson won the title in all four events...holds state records in the 100m hurdles (13.60) and the high jump (6-00), setting both in her senior season...established the hurdle mark as a sophomore before breaking it as a junior and then again as a senior...a three-sport standout, she lettered four times in track and field, basketball and volleyball...the Yuma Daily Star named her the 2003 Athlete of the Year...she also earned Arizona's Gatorade Athlete of the Year in 2003 for her performances on the track...was a four-time first-team all-region selection in all three sports as well as honorable mention all-Arizona in basketball as a senior...from 2000 through 2003, was named the team captain of both the volleyball and basketball teams. Personal: Majoring in kinesiology...parents are Earl Johnson and Beth Knapp...two siblings: Jessica and Jermyn (twin)...born Sept. 8, 1984, in San Jose, Calif....hobbies include music, shopping and swimming...full name is Jacquelyn Kate Johnson.

Amy Hastings 5-4 • RS Senior • Distance Leavenworth, Kan. (Leavenworth HS)

ASU: Perhaps the most successful distance athlete in ASU history... on the track, won the 2006 NCAA Indoor 5,000m Championship, the longest race won for a national title by a Sun Devil since Maicel Malone's 400m dash crown at the 1992 indoor meet... also is a three-time Pac-10 Champion, winning titles in cross country, the 3,000m steeplechase and the 10,000m run... is a seven-time All-American, earning three in both cross country and the indoor 5,000m run and adding one in the outdoor 10,000m run... earned her third cross country All-America honor by placing 13th in 2005, the first Sun

Devil to earn three honors in cross country... set a school record for cross country wins in a career at five... is the first Sun Devil, male or female, to win a Pac-10 Cross Country Championship with her win in 2004... just the second woman to earn Pac-10 Athlete of the Year honors in cross country... school record holder in the indoor 5,000m (15:45.45) and ranks second in the outdoor 5,000m (15:52.06) and 10,000m (33:17.89). 2006 Outdoor: Secured her seventh All-America honor by placing fourth in the 10,000m run at the NCAA Championships (33:41.18)... set the school record in the event earlier in the year at the Stanford Invitational (33:17.89) before Victoria Jackson broke it later in the year... won her third career Pac-10 title by taking gold in the 10,000m (34:03.85)... also scored in the 5,000m run by finishing third (16:32.82)... won the mile run at the Sun Angel Classic (4:47.29)... regionally qualified in three events, including the 1,500m, the 5,000m and the 10,000m run... placed 15th at the USA Championships in the 5,000m run (16:22.82)... earned Academic All-Pac-10 Honorable Mention... 2006 Indoor: Won her first NCAA title by claiming the 5,000m run at the NCAA Indoor Championships... won the race in 15:51.63 and earned All-America honors, her third year in a row in the event... also won the 5,000m run at the Husky Invitational in a school-record 15:45.45... placed 19th in the 3,000m run at the NCAA Indoor meet... placed fifth in the same event at the MPSF Championships... 2005 XC: Earned her third All-America honor with her 13th-place finish at nationals...is the only Sun Devil, male and female, to earn three national honors...led the team to its first Top 4 finish in school history...led the team to second place finish at the regional meet with her runner-up finish...earned All-West Region honors...placed second at the Pac-10 meet to lead team to second place while earning First Team All-Pac-10...won the Roy Griak Invitational...also was sixth at the Pre-National meet...selected as the team's MVP... 2005 Outdoor: Hampered by injury for much of the season...competed in four races...set the school record in the 10,000m run at the Stanford Invitational (33:19.32) to automatically qualify for nationals...started the 10,000m race at nationals but did not finish...won the 1,500m run at the Sun Angel Classic and placed second in the 5,000m run at the Oregon Invitational in her only other races... 2005 Indoor: Earned All-America honors in the 5,000m run, finishing fifth at the NCAA meet (16:06.62)...set the school record in the same event one month earlier to qualify for nationals as she clocked a 16:05.83 at the Husky Invitational...won the mile run at the Double Dual...also ran the second-fastest 3,000m circuit in ASU history while finishing fifth at the Alex Wilson Invite (9:25.72)... 2004 XC: Became the first Sun Devil to win the Pac-10 Cross Country Championship as she covered the Golden Gate Park course in 20:19...was NCAA West Region runner-up with a time of 20:14...Finished 22nd at NCAA Championships, earning her second All-American honor...tied the school record for career individual victories at four...also won the Dave Murray Invitational to open the season...earned her third allconference cross country honor....selected Women's Most Valuable Athlete at season banquet... 2004 Outdoor: Captured her first conference crown by winning the 3,000m steeplechase at the Pac-10 meet before placing eighth at the regional meet and 18th at nationals...also won the Double Dual...ran the third-fastest time in school and conference history at the Oregon Invitational...finished second at the Sun Angel Classic in her only 1,500m run of the season...her 1,500m time of 4:21.73 ranks fourth-best in school history while her 16:02.53 in the 5,000m run is the fourth-best at ASU...also scored at the Pac-10 meet in the 5,000m run, finishing fourth overall...selected as the Pac-10 Track Athlete of the Week (April 26) after the Oregon Invitational race... 2004 Indoor: Set the school record in the 5,000m run at the Pac-10 Invitational...earned All-America honors in the 5,000m run, placing 11th overall in the race but eighth among American athletes in the race...won the 800m run at the Double Dual in her race at that distance...2003 XC: Finished 25th at the NCAA Cross Country Championships to earn her first All-America honor...was the top team finisher in all six races she ran...won the Dave Murray and ASU Invites...her two race wins ties her for second on the single season wins list and third in career wins at ASU...became only the third woman to win multiple races in one season...took third at the Roy Griak and was fourth at the Pac-10 Championships...finished as the runner-up at the regional meet...member of the All-Pac-10 First and All-West Region First teams...also garnered Academic All-Pac-10 Honorable Mention honors... 2003 Track: Redshirted...set the USA Junior Championships meet record in the 5,000m run to win the event and qualify for the Pan Am Games in Barbados (did not compete)... 2002 XC: Was an immediate contributor to the success of the team...was top finisher for the squad at the NCAA Championships with a 69th place finish...also finished second on the team in five races...best finish was fifth at the adidas Invitational...top time was a 21:11.0 at the conference meet...second best was at nationals...placed 10th in her first Pac-10 Championship race to help the team to second place... named to the All-Pac-10 second team...finished the NCAA West Region race in 10th-place to earn all-region honors... qualified for the World Junior Cross Country Championships with a third-place finish at the US Junior Naitonal Championships... was the top American finisher (20th overall) at the World meet. High School: Claimed three Kansas state titles on her way to two school records...won the state cross country meet in 2001 and the 3,200m race in 2000 and '01...records include a 10:43 in the 3200m and a 5:06 time in the 1600...named to the Nike Honorable Mention team in 2001 and was invited to the run in the Golden West Invitational...captained the cross country team (2000-01) and the track team (2001). 




Aaron Aguayo 5-11 • RS Senior • Distance Phoenix, Ariz. (Mountain Pointe HS)

Arizona State: Enters his senior season as one of the most decorated distance runners in school history... is just the second male to earn All-America honors twice in a cross country career... holds the school record for highest male finish at an NCAA cross country meet by placing ninth... also ranks second on the highest finish list all-time at the national

meet... school record holder in the 3,000m steeplechase (8:35.04) after running the time to win his third Pac-10 title in a row, making him just the second male in conference history to win the event three times... also holds the school mark in the 5,000m run (13:40.18)... is a four-time All-American, including two in cross country and two on the track. 2006 XC: Became just the second Sun Devil male to earn two All-America honors in a career after placing a school-record ninth overall (previous best was 11th by Todd Lewis in 1991)... his finish is the second-best ever at ASU behind Lisa Aguilera's fifth-place showing in 2000... was the top finisher for ASU in six races he ran, never finishing higher than 16th overall and collecting four Top 4 finishes... took runner-up honors at the NCAA West Region Championships to earn All-Region honors... placed fourth at the Pac-10 Championships to earn First Team All-Pac-10 accolades... his Pac-10 finish also is tied for the thirdbest in program history (also holds the second-best mark)... took third place at the Dave Murray and Roy Griak Invites... also was 16th at the Pre-National meet... 2006 Outdoor: Won his third Pac-10 steeplechase title in a row with a school-record 8:35.04 mark... also placed sixth in the 5,000m run to score for the team.... Finished second in the steeple at the NCAA West Region meet... won his preliminary heat at the NCAA Championships before placing third overall to earn All-America honors... reset the school record in the 5,000m run at the Cardinal Classic (13:40.18)... competed at every distance between 800m and 5,000m... won the 800m run at the Baldy Castillo Invitational and took second in the mile (4:04.3) at the Sun Angel Classic... his mile time is the eighth-best in school history \dots after the season, represented the USA at the NACAC Under-23 Championships in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, and won the 5,000m run (14:54.55) ... 2006 Indoor: Competed in the mile run three times, finishing sixth at the MPSF Championships... also competed in the 3,000m run once... 2005 XC: Redshirted while recovering from injury sustained at 2005 NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships... 2005 Outdoor: Set the school record in the 3,000m steeplechase at 8:38.16 to finish 13th in the preliminaries of the NCAA meet before earning All-America honors in the event... captured his second Pac-10 title in the steeplechase for his second win of the season (won the Double Dual as well)... placed third at the west region meet... set school



record in the 5,000m run at 13:49.11 while placing fourth at the Oregon Invitational... won all three races at 1,500m with a personal best 3:44.04 at the Sun Angel Classic... 2005 Indoor: Competed in three races, placing second at the Double Dual in the mile and placing in the Top 8 in both runs of the 3,000m event... 2004 XC: Earned his first All-America honor by placing 22nd at the NCAA Champions... competed in six races, placing in the Top 10 five times... team's highest finisher in all six races he ran... led the team to second place finishes at Pac-10 and regional meets...highest finish of the season was third place both at Pac-10 and Dave Murray Invitational... selected as the men's Most Valuable Athlete at the team awards banquet... 2004 Outdoor: Won the 2004 Pac-10 Championship in the 3,000m steeplechase as well as securing the title in the same event at the NCAA West Region Championship meet... won the regional event in 8:42.79 to clock the second-fastest time in school history... also recorded the 10th-fastest mark in the 5,000m run... won the steeplechase three times on the season by taking the Double Dual, conference and regional meet titles... finished 17th at the NCAA Championships in the steeplechase...also competed twice in the 1,500m run, winning the event at the Bill Sawyer Invitational... 2004 Indoor: Did not compete... 2003 XC: Emerged as one of the top runners on the team, finishing first on the team in three of five races... was the race runner-up at the Dave Murray Invitational in Tucson to open the season... top team finisher at the Pac-10 (18th) and NCAA West Region (28th) meets... was second to finish on the team in other races, including 22nd overall at the Roy Griak Invitational... helped the men win the ASU Invitational with third-place finish... 2003 Track: Redshirted... 2002 XC: One of the top runners for the Sun Devils all year... made his presence known at first meet of the year by placing fifth at the adidas Invitational to lead the team... finished second on the squad at Pre-N



Arizona State: A two-time All-American on the track last year, Kingma was the top finisher for the cross country team most of the fall... ranks second in school history in the indoor 3,000m run (9:13.39) and sixth in the outdoor 5,000m run (15:59.15). **2006 XC:** Paced the team in five of the team's six races... placed 60th at the NCAA Championships after taking ninth at the NCAA West Region, where she earned
