PAC-10 CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFYING

In years past, student-athletes would have to meet qualification standards during the season in order to earn a berth into the Pac-10 Championships. Starting in 2005, that all changed. Prior to the meet, each team's head coach will select no more than 28 men and 28 women to represent his/her team. Although there is no limit to the number of events each athlete can enter, there is one limitation: each team may only enter up to eight athletes per event (or the number of athletes cannot exceed the number of scoring positions of the event).

THE SUN ANGEL TRACK CLASSIC

Arizona State's men's and women's track and field teams celebrate their 31st year at Sun Angel Stadium, which opened in time for the 1976 season at an estimated cost of \$3 million.

Sun Angel Stadium has hosted seven conference championship meets in its 30-year history. The 1979, 1991 and 1999 Pac-10 Championships were held at Sun Angel Stadium in addition to the 1986 Pacific West Conference Championships, the 1976 Western Athletic Conference Championships, the 1983 Big Sky Conference Championships and the 1978 Intermountain Conference meet.

The facility is also home to the Sun Angel Track Classic, now in its 28th season. Dozens of Olympians from numerous countries have competed at the previous 27 Sun Angel Track Classics, making the meet a world class event.

From its humble beginnings as the Sun Devil Relays, created by former ASU Senior Associate Athletic Director Herman Frazier and Charlie Wells, the Classic has seen the likes of Leroy Burrell, Tony Dees, Gail Devers, Tim Harden, Floyd Heard, Nick Hysong, Jackie Joyner Kersee, Jeff Laynes, Carl Lewis, Jud Logan, Mike Marsh, Inger Miller, Dennis Mitchell, Dan O'Brien, Anna Sorderberg, Lynda Tolbert-Goode and Quincy Watts, to name a few.

Joe Selleh Track underwent a facelift in 1996. The university budgeted \$500,000 for the project and an additional \$200,000 was raised by the athletic department through the Sun Devil Club. As a result, there are nine 48-inch lanes, dual long and triple jump runways, three throwing areas and two high jump pits.

The west side seating is constructed of pre-stressed concrete, 45 rows in height, with all seating equidistant to the finish line. The seating capacity exceeds 5,000, and the east side of the track has the space for an additional 4,000 seats with movable bleachers.

In 1999, a new scoreboard and timing system were put in place and a student-athlete clubhouse is scheduled to be added as part of Arizona State University's \$400-million Campaign for Leadership, which includes \$25 million for athletic facility improvements.



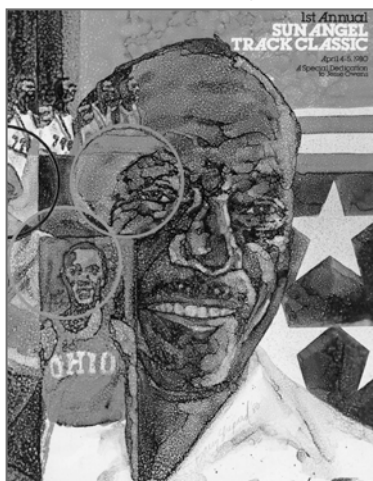

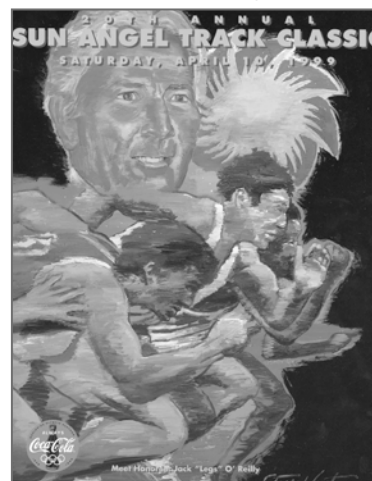

Joe Selleh Track has not only been the home of the Sun Devil track and field program, it also has been the home for several spectacular marks. Former Arizona State athletes hold 14 of the top times/marks. Most recently, Lisa Aguilera (2003) set the women's steeplechase mark. In 2004, New York Athletic Club's Erin Gilreath launched the hammer 72.12m (236-7 feet) to not only break the facility record, but also establish the American record in the event. In 2005, three records fell, including the men's 400m hurdles, women's 200m dash and women's pole vault, all during the Sun Angel Classic.

ASU'S PAC-10 CHAMPIONSHIP HIGH POINT AWARD

The Pac-10 Championship High Point Award, researched by the Arizona State coaching staff in 2002, annually recognizes the individual efforts of one male and one female athlete's performances at the conference's outdoor championship meet. The men, competing since 1979, and the women, competing in the event since 1987, have had several outstanding performers with two leading the pack.

Dwight Phillips, the 2004 Olympic long jump Gold Medalist, leads both genders with his 26.5 points accumulated in 2000. He entered four events, three as an individual, and placed in the Top 3 in each one. Phillips won the long jump title, finished as the runner-up in the 100-meter dash and was third in the triple jump. Along with LaVell Robinson-Blanchard, Jim McGee and Marcus Brunson, Phillips also walked away from the meet with a conference championship in the 4x100-meter relay.

At the 2006 meet, Jacquelyn Johnson reset the standard by scoring 29 points, four more than the previous record set by Maicel Malone in 1988. Her point total also is the most scored by a Sun Devil, male and female, at the championships meet. Johnson scored 10 points by winning the heptathlon before earning eight points for her second-place showing in the high jump, six points for finishing third in the 100m hurdles and three points for her sixth-place showing in the long jump. Johnson picked up her final two points by helping the 4x400m relay team to runner-up honors.

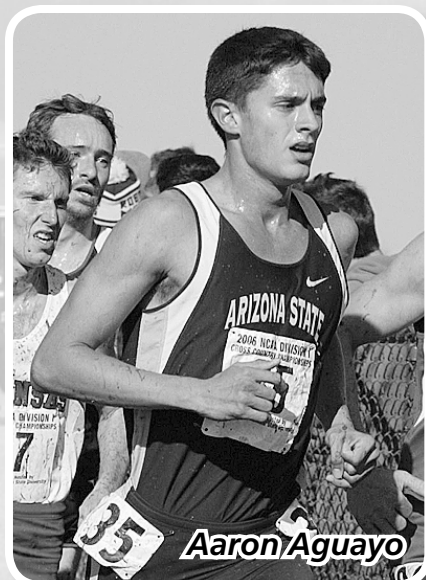

NCAA Success

Arizona State's cross country program has continued to shine in recent years, including another solid season in 2006. The women advanced to their ninth-consecutive NCAA Championships appearance, the sixth-longest active streak among women's programs nationally, where they finished 13th overall to mark the fourth year in a row the Sun Devils placed among the Top 15 nationally. On the men's side, Aaron Aguayo qualified for the national meet as an individual competitor after taking runner-up honors at the regional meet. In Terre Haute, Aguayo placed ninth overall to not only earn his second All-America honor in cross country, but also record the highest finish at the national meet in men's program history. All told, the Sun Devil program has accumulated six All-America honors, one trophy and six Top 20 team finishes in the past four seasons.
