# NCAA CHAMPIONS



Lynda Tolbert Outdoor 4x100m Relay – 1988 Outdoor 100m Hurdles – 1988 & 1990 Indoor 55m Hurdles – 1990

Prior to Maicel Malone's winnings over the next three years, Tolbert's four national titles was the most decorated Sun Devil track & field athlete in program history. Tolbert ranks second all-time in Sun Devil history with four crowns as well as three individual titles.

One of the fastest

Herman Frazier Outdoor 4x400m Relay – 1976 Outdoor 400m Dash – 1977

Frazier, a US Olympic Champion as well, anchored the 4x400m relay team to gold at the 1976 meet, marking the first relay title in program history. One year later, Frazier won the 400m dash in 45.51 to help the Sun Devils to the 1977 NCAA Team Championship.

### Alex Henderson 2 Mile Run – 1959

Henderson was the first NCAA Champion in program history when he won the two mile race in 8:46.8 at the meet held in Berkeley, Calif.

Outdoor Pentathlon – 1977
Collins was the first overall national champion and individual national champion for the women's program, capturing the pentathlon with 4,092 points.





## Victoria Jackson Outdoor 10,000m Run – 2006

The latest national champion for the Sun Devils, Jackson covered the course in 32:54.72, a school record, to capture a title in the longest race in program history, surpassing the two-mile run in 1959 by Alex Henderson and the 400m dash by Maicel Malone in 1992.



### **1977 Men's Team Champions**

The team boasted two individual national champions in Herman Frazier (400m) and Kyle Arney (high jump) while seven individuals and two relays earned All-America status. The title was won with 64 points as the Sun Devils edged out UTEP by 14 points for the gold.


Donn Kinzle was the head coach of the Sun Devil track team from 1946-52 and also served as the school's athletic director. Mr. Kinzle passed away in 2006




Dwight Phillips won gold at the 2004 Athens Games marking the third Olympiad in a row that a Sun Devil track athlete won gold.

## 1977 NCAA Track & Field Champion

In 1977, 13 Arizona State student-athletes traveled to Champaign, Ill., for the NCAA Track and Field Championships. Entering as underdogs to finish in the Top 3 and returning to the Valley of the Sun as the top team in the nation, nine student-athletes earned All-America honors with Herman Frazier (400m) and Kyle Arney (High Jump) winning individual national titles. The Sun Devils accumulated 64 points to win the title by 14 points with UTEP taking second after scoring 50 points.




