ASU Track & Field Continues Home Slate with ASU Invite

The Sun Devils will welcome eight different universities and a number of strong post-collegiate competitors to Sun Angel Stadium on Saturday.

TEMPE -The Arizona State University track and field team will host its second consecutive home meet this season in the ASU Invitational, set to take place on Saturday, March 24 at the Sun Angel Stadium in Tempe, Ariz. While the outdoor season technically started last weekend, some might view this competition as the true season opener with a number of the Sun Devils prime contenders opening the season in their strongest events. The team will welcome competitors from Kansas State, Nebraska, Minnesota, Air Force, Iowa State, Northern Arizona, CSU Los Angeles and Western State in addition to a number of strong post-collegiate competitors for what should prove to be a solid early-season meet across the board. The men's hammer will open the event on Friday, March 23 at 1 p.m. PT and the remainder of the events will take place on Saturday starting with the women's discus at 11 a.m. PT. The running events will commence at approximately 5:15 p.m. PT.

OUT OF THE BLOCKS

- The Sun Devil men are coming off a trophy-earning fourth-place finish at the NCAA Indoor Championships in Boise earlier in March. The men saw two national champions crowned in Jordan Clarke in the shot put and Mason McHenry at 800 meters while Chris Benard (triple jump) and Bryan McBride (high jump) both earned first team All-America honors.
- The Sun Devil women return two first team outdoor All-Americans this season in Anna Jelmini (discus) and Christabel Nettey (long jump).
- Head coach Greg Kraft is in his 16th season at Arizona State, the third longest tenure of any of ASU's current sports coaches.
- For those into competitive sibling rivalries, be sure to check out the women's 1,500-meter run this weekend as ASU freshman phenom Shelby Houlihan will take on her sister Shayla, a post-collegiate competitive runner for Brooks.
- Jordan Clarke is the NCAA's returning shot put champion outdoors and will be the returning champion when the team reaches the 2013 indoor season as well after his performance in Boise earlier this year.

IN THE RANKINGS: USTFCCCA TOP 25

The USTFCCCA released its preseason computer rankings on Thursday and both the Sun Devil men and women find themselves ranked in the top-20 nationally heading into the bulk of the outdoor season. The men, fresh of a fourth-place finish at the NCAA indoor meet, will open the season at No. 20 in the country while the women sit at No. 17. The preseason rankings take data from the previous season and use a series of mathematical formulae to determine the team with the most potential to do well at the NCAA Outdoor Championships. As the season goes on, results from the current season will be taken into account until later in the year when ONLY mark from the current season will count towards the computer rankings.

IN THE RANKINGS: USTFCCCA WEST REGION

The USTFCCCA will release its 2012 regional rankings within the next two weeks.

FOLLOW LIVE

HEAD COACH GREG KRAFT

Greg Kraft is in his 16th year with the Sun Devil program and has built it into a national power. During the 2008 season, his men and women captured the NCAA Indoor Championships, only the second time in the history of the event that the same school swept both titles. The title was the second in a row for the women and their third overall (2007 outdoor) and the first for the men. Dating back to the 2006 seasons, the Sun Devil women have won the Pac-10 three times, the MPSF twice, the NCAA indoor twice, the NCAA outdoor once and the NCAA West Region outdoor once. The men have added one NCAA indoor and one NCAA West Region outdoor crown to that collection as well.

Individually, athletes have excelled under the 2008 Men's and Women's USTFCCCA National Indoor Coach of the Year, including seven-time NCAA multi-event champion Jacquelyn Johnson, who also advanced to the Olympic Games in the heptathlon after winning her fourth NCAA heptathlon title. In 2009, two men captured three NCAA titles, including Ryan Whiting sweeping in the indoor and outdoor shot put crown and Jason Lewis won the indoor weight throw. In 2010, Whiting swept the shot put once again and added a discus crown before being named a finalist for the Bowerman Award. Jordan Clarke followed Whiting's footsteps in 2011, winning the NCAA outdoor shot put crown himself.

At the conference level, the Sun Devils have dominated on the women's side with three titles in a row (2006-08) while the men have finished as the meet runner-up three straight years from 2008-10. His athletes have collected 66 individual titles and added another 14 relay crowns in the Pac-10 before going on to collect 171 All-America honors individually and another 25 in relays.

Along with Johnson, other impressive names that have been coached by Kraft include 2004 Olympic Long Jump Champion Dwight Phillips and 2008 U.S. Long Jump Champion Trevell Quinley.

A LOOK BACK: 2011 NCAA Indoor Championships

The Arizona State track and field team had just one first-team All-American at last year's NCAA Championships in Anna Jelmini, who took fifth in the shot put last season. Jasmine Cheney (200m) and the 4x400-meter relay of Sarah Geren, Keia Pinnick, Kayla Sanchez and Cheney all earned second-team honors for the women. On the men's side, the team did not score and Jordan Clarke was the only individual in action, finishing ninth overall in the shot put and earning second-team All-America honors.

THROWING THEIR WEIGHT

Over the past 10 years, David Dumble has continued to bring in top talent and build the throws program at Arizona State, which has collected 13 total national titles, including the shiny new trophy earned by Jordan Clarke at the NCAA Indoor Championships just two weeks ago. With Clarke the defending indoor AND outdoor national champion and Anna Jelmini the top returning discus thrower in the nation, the ASU throws team looks to continue their perennial dominance of the event into the outdoor season.

NETTEY POT

Christabel Nettey looked up to snuff with her outdoor long jumping self that earned first-team All-America honors last season as she soared 6.58m (21-07.25) in the team's season opener at the Baldy Castillo Invitational for a new career best and improved her second-place hold on ASU's all-time list in the event.

RUNNING RELAY FAST

The ASU relay teams wasted no time making their presence known at the Baldy Castillo Invitational. The men's 4x100-meter team of Daniel Auberry, Kelsey Caesar, Justin Freeman and Chris Burrows clocked a season-opening time of 40.05 without Ryan Milus before Caesar and Burrows teamed with John Kline and Will Henry to clock the second-quickest 4x400-meter relay of the early season in 3:05.29. The women's 4x400-meter relay also opened strong as Kayla Sanchez, Alycia Herring, Keia Pinnick and Brianna Tate teamed up to post a time of 3:38.48 for another top-10 mark nationally.

IN THE TOP 10 ALL-TIME - OUTDOORS

With the low-scale nature of competition at the Baldy Castillo Invitational, only one Sun Devil improved upon her standing in the ASU record books as Christabel Nettey improved her hold on second in the all-time long jump list. That number is sure to rise as more Sun Devils continue to open up their 2012 outdoor seasons.

IN THE TOP 10 ALL-TIME - INDOORS

With the indoor season in the books, 31 ASU student-athletes in 41 events moved into or improved upon their prior top-10 marks in school history. The newcomers include Cameron Taylor (60mH, second), Derick Hinch (Pole Vault, fifth), Shelby Houlihan (800m, third/Mile, first), Asiah Gooden (60m, seventh), Alycia Herring (60m, eighth/200m, ninth), Rashad Ross (200m, fourth), Nick Happe (Mile, first), Brian Pierre (3000m, eighth/5000m, first), Mason McHenry (Mile, seventh), Chris Burrows (200m, fifth), Bryan McBride (triple jump, ninth), Chris Benard (long jump, seventh), Alex Hartig (shot put) and Daniel Auberry (60m, fifth/200m 10th). Ryan Milus (60m), Chris Benard (triple jump/long jump), Bryan McBride (high jump), Ashley Lampley (weight throw), Cj Navarro (weight throw) Jordan Clarke (shot put/weight throw), Keia Pinnick (60m hurdles), John Kline (800m), Nick Happe (3000m/5000m), Darius Terry (mile), Kayla Sanchez (60m/200m) Jamie Sandys (heptathlon), Austin Prince (heptathlon/pole vault), Jeremy Marcinko (heptathlon/pole vault), Lindsay Prescott (5000m) Keia Pinnick (pentathlon) and Asiah Gooden (60m) all improved upon marks they already held in the top-10 in their respective events.

Awards / Notes

RETURNING ALL-AMERICANS

ASU returns three first team All-Americans and most of a second-team All-America relay team to the outdoor roster this year. Jordan Clarke return as the defending NCAA Champion in the shot put while Anna Jelmini was the runner-up in the discus competition last year and Christabel Netthey earned first-team recognition in the long jump. Alycia Herring, Keia Pinnick and Kayla Sanchez all return as members of the 4x400-meter relay team that earned second-team honors last season. In addition, Clarke and Jelmini earned indoor All-America honors this year as well in addition to Mason McHenry (800m), Chris Benard (triple jump) and Bryan McBride (high jump) - all of whom earned first-team accolades - and second-team honorees Ryan Milus (60m) and Nick Happe (mile). Netthey also earned second-team long jump honors indoors

LAST HURRAH

The start of the 2012 represents the beginning of the end for 16 Sun Devils entering the season. On the men's side, Daniel Auberry, Allante Battle, Chris Benard, Kelsey Caesar, John Kline, Mason McHenry, Marc Peck, Brian Pierre, Austin Prince, Joe Riccio and Jamie Sandys enter their final campaign in the Maroon and Gold while Ashley Lampley, Cj Navarro, Kayla Sanchez, Lindsay Prescott and Kauren Tarver will compete in their last competitions as Sun Devils this year.

WHO'S THE NEW KID?

Twenty-three athletes, including 12 women and 9 men, have joined the Sun Devil program for the first time in 2012. The true freshmen include Edmond Baker, Domenic D'Acquisto, Ryan Herson, Cody Moore, William Taylor, Daniel Wong and Heyden Wooff on the men's side and Macy Bricks, Taylor Conway, Shaina Corbin, Monica Danielson, Shelby Houlihan, Mackenzie Maki, Carly Paracholski, Payton Schutte, Brianna Tate and Brierra Winfrey for the women. Junior college transfers Derick Hinch (Cuesta College) and Chris Burrows (Lake Erie College) join the men's side. The women also picked up a huge addition in All-American hammer thrower Chelsea Cassulo from UNLV this season, though she will redshirt until next year.

BACK ON SCHEDULE

In 1996, Pal Arne Fagernes won the men's javelin title at the NCAA Championships. It was not until 2004 that Arizona State had another national champion as Jacquelyn Johnson won the outdoor heptathlon as a true freshman. Starting in 2005, ASU had at least one returning NCAA champion on its roster for six years in a row, a streak that came to an end last season because of graduation. The 2010 and 2009 rosters featured two returning individuals each (Ryan Whiting and Jason Lewis in 2010, Whiting and Sarah Stevens in 2009) while the 2008 roster featured four returning champions in Johnson, Stevens, Jessica Pressley and April Kubishta, all who won titles in 2007. The Sun Devils had no returning champions in 2011 but rectified that for the 2012 season with junior Jordan Clarke returning as the 2011 NCAA outdoor shot put champion this season and guaranteed that they will return a national champion next year as well after winning the indoor shot put title this year.

SAME TEAMMATE, DIFFERENT TEAM

As the season begins, there are incredible 23 Sun Devils on the roster that were teammates before they came to Arizona State, including transfers from two colleges and five high schools represented. Daniel Auberry and Chris Benard return to the Sun Devils this season after competing together at Riverside Community College just two years ago. Thrower Joe Riccio attended Mesa Community College with Hailey Hanna. Teammates have been reunited from five high schools as well, including four from the Valley. Sophomores Asia Gooden and Alycia Herring are both entering their second years with ASU after running together at Ranch Verde HS in California and freshmen Monica Danielson and Tanner Greeley both come to ASU out of Edison HS in Huntington Beach, Calif. Will Henry and newcomer Chris Burrows were teammates at Trotwood Madison HS in Dayton, Ohio for a couple of seasons. Ryan Herson and Brierra Winfrey are both products of Trabuco Hills HS in Mission Viejo, Calif. Locally, Desert Vista is represented by Edmond Baker, Allante Battle, Matt Boughton, John Kline, Cory Kraft and Shaylah Simpson; Sandra Day O'Connor is represented by Lindsay Prescott and Bryan McBride; Corona del Sol has Garrett Baker-Slama and Josh Walker; Jared Gonzales and Andrew Hagler ran together at Chandler High.

RECAP: 2012 NCAA Indoor Championships

The Sun Devils wrapped up the 2012 Indoor Season in Boise, Idaho, just two weeks ago as the men's team posted a fourth-place finish and brought home two individual national champions in the process. Jordan Clarke launched a monster of a final throw of 20.86m (65-05.25) to earn his second national title in the shot put and first indoors while Mason McHenry clocked a time of 1:47.87 at 800 meters for his first career national title. Chris Benard broke his own school record in the triple jump with a leap of 16.50m (54-01.75) to take second overall while Bryan McBride was sixth in the high jump to also earn All-America accolades. On the women's side, sophomore Anna Jelmini earned her second career indoor All-America honor with an indoor personal record of 17.15m to finish fifth overall. Ryan Milus (60m), Nick Happe (mile) and Christabel Netthey (long jump) all earned second-team All-America accolades.

A REWARDING YEAR

It was a big year for the Sun Devils in the awards category during the 2012 indoor season. The ASU men took home their first MPSF title in school history, scoring 131.5 points for a 50-point margin of victory over second place Stanford - both landmarks sitting as the best in the past decade in MPSF competition. Greg Kraft was awarded the MPSF Men's Coach of the Year as well as the USTFCCCA West Region Men's Coach of the Year. Chris Benard took home USTFCCCA West Region Field Athlete of the Year honors courtesy of his school-record setting year in the triple jump and 18 points scored at the MPSF Championships.

KRAFT LEADS THE WAY

Head Coach Greg Kraft is entering his 16th year as the leader of the Sun Devil program, a tenure that has brought Arizona State back to the top of the standings in both the NCAA and Pac-12 events. Since his hiring, the program has continued to evolve into one of the more well-rounded in the nation with strength on the track and in the field as well as in cross country. Kraft and his staff have worked diligently to reach their goals of championships and success in education and that has not been more clearly seen than in the past five years as the hardware has continued to roll in. His program has annually produced some of the top individuals in the nation with 25 of the program's 58 individual and relay national titles won since 2004 while both his teams and individual student-athletes have garnered national academic acclaim. Prior to his arrival, the program boasted one NCAA Championship (men's outdoor track & field, 1977) and one Pac-10 Championship (men's outdoor track & field, 1981). In the last six years, his Sun Devils have captured four national crowns (2007 women's indoor and outdoor track & field, 2008 men's and women's indoor track & field) and added three Pac-10 Championships (women's outdoor track & field, 2006-08). Kraft's teams have finished in the Top 10 of the NCAA Track & Field Championships on 22 occasions in 16 years while the program had done so just 14 times prior to his arrival in Tempe.

LONG TENURE IN TEMPE

As he begins his 16th year at Arizona State, Kraft's tenure ranks as the second-longest in Sun Devil track & field history and the fourth-longest active streak among all current ASU head coaches. The only coach that has led the track & field program longer than Kraft is legendary coach Senon 'Baldy' Castillo, who led the way for 26 years (1954-79). Among current Sun Devil head coaches, Kraft's 16th year ranks behind John Spini, who is in his 32nd year with gymnastics and Sheila McInerney, who is in her 28th year with women's tennis.

NEXT TIME OUT

The Sun Devils will have a mostly off week as the team prepares for the Sun Angel Classic in April. The team will send its multi-events down to Tucson next weekend for the Jim Click Combined Events on Friday and Saturday, March 29-30.
