ASU T&F Heads to Texas for NCAA West Regionals

Several Sun Devils will look to seal their bids for an NCAA Finals berth this weekend as the team takes part in the first round of the NCAA Championships.

AUSTIN - The Arizona State University track and field team will open up the first rounds of NCAA Championships this weekend as the squad heads to Austin, Texas for the NCAA West Preliminaries. The Sun Devils will be in action beginning Thursday, May 24 and continuing through Saturday, May 26. Events will run over the course of the day on all three days. The NCAA Preliminaries are in essence the qualifying or advancement rounds of the NCAA Championships, which are set to take place in Des Moines, Iowa, beginning June 6, 2012.

The top 48 student-athletes per event per regions (East and West) advance to the NCAA Preliminaries where the fields will face off in an elimination format until only 12 student-athletes per event in each region are remaining. Those 24 final student-athletes will converge in Des Moines for the NCAA Finals. The lone exception to the rule is the relay events, where only the top 24 relays per region have advanced to the preliminaries with 12 eventually advancing to the finals.

OUT OF THE BLOCKS

- The Sun Devil men are coming off a trophy-earning fourth-place finish at the NCAA Indoor Championships in Boise earlier in March. The men saw two national champions crowned in Jordan Clarke in the shot put and Mason McHenry at 800 meters.
- The Sun Devil women return two first team outdoor All-Americans this season in Anna Jelmini (discus) and Christabel Nettey (long jump).
- Head coach Greg Kraft is in his 16th season at Arizona State, the third-longest tenure of any of ASU's current sports coaches.
- Junior Jordan Clarke is currently ranked in the NCAA top-25 in both the shot put (4th) and the hammer throw (11th) heading into the weekend
- Jordan Clarke is the NCAA's returning shot put champion outdoors and will be the returning champion when the team reaches the 2013 indoor season as well after his performance in Boise earlier this year.
- Sophomore Anna Jelmini is on a bit of a hot streak of late, sweeping the Pac-12 shot put and discus titles and currently ranking in the top-10 in the nation in both this year.
- The Sun Devil men took third at the Pac-12 Championships while the women were fifth. The teams combined for five individual champions and a sweep of the men's relays over the course of the competition.
- Chris Benard enters the weekend as the top-ranked triple jumper in the nation and has set school records in the event indoors and outdoors on the year.
- Entering the weekend, the Sun Devils have 13 student-athletes in 16 different events ranked in the top 25 in those respective events in the nation as well as two relays on the men's side.

IN THE RANKINGS: USTFCCCA TOP 25

The Arizona State men will enter the weekend in 14th in the USTFCCCA Computer Rankings, remaining static in last week's spot. The ASU women dropped two positions to No. 12 after a relative bye weekend for the teams. The computer rankings utilize mathematical formulae to determine which NCAA teams have the best *potential* of scoring well at the NCAA Championships meet.

IN THE RANKINGS: USTFCCCA WEST REGION

The ASU men finished the 2012 campaign second in the USTFCCCA West Region rankings with 673.00 points, just over 14 points behind Oregon with 687.72. The ASU women finished fourth overall with 561.01 points behind Oregon, Stanford and Arizona.

HEAD COACH GREG KRAFT

Greg Kraft is in his 16th year with the Sun Devil program and has built it into a national power. During the 2008 season, his men and women captured the NCAA Indoor Championships, only the second time in the history of the event that the same school swept both titles. The title was the second in a row for the women and their third overall (2007 outdoor) and the first for the men. Dating back to the 2006 seasons, the Sun Devil women have won the Pac-10 three times, the MPSF twice, the NCAA indoor twice, the NCAA outdoor once and the NCAA West Region outdoor once. The men have added one NCAA indoor and one NCAA West Region outdoor crown to that collection as well.

Individually, athletes have excelled under the 2008 Men's and Women's USTFCCCA National Indoor Coach of the Year, including seven-time NCAA multi-event champion Jacquelyn Johnson, who also advanced to the Olympic Games in the heptathlon after winning her fourth NCAA heptathlon title. In 2009, two men captured three NCAA titles, including Ryan Whiting sweeping in the indoor and outdoor shot put crown and Jason Lewis won the indoor weight throw. In 2010, Whiting swept the shot put once again and added a discus crown before being named a finalist for the Bowerman Award. Jordan Clarke followed Whiting's footsteps in 2011, winning the NCAA outdoor shot put crown himself.

At the conference level, the Sun Devils have dominated on the women's side with three titles in a row (2006-08) while the men have finished as the meet runner-up three straight years from 2008-10. His athletes have collected 66 individual titles and added another 14 relay crowns in the Pac-10 before going on to collect 171 All-America honors individually and another 25 in relays.

Along with Johnson, other impressive names that have been coached by Kraft include 2004 Olympic Long Jump Champion Dwight Phillips and 2008 U.S. Long Jump Champion Trevell Quinley.

A LOOK BACK - Pac-12 Championships

The Arizona State men took second at the Pac-12 Championships in Eugene, Ore. It was the best conference finish for the ASU men since 2008, where they also finished second overall. The Sun Devil women took fifth overall and it was the 13th consecutive top-five conference finish for the team. Over the course of the weekend, team posted five individual championships and two relay champions. Anna Jelmini swept the shot put and discus competitions while Constance Ezugha had her best competition of the year to win the long jump. Chris Benard continued his impressive season with a win in the triple jump while Jordan Clarke took the shot put crown. The men's relays swept the competition, doing so for the first time since 2005 and just the third time in Pac-12 history. Clarke also notched a second-place finish in the hammer throw and took third in the discus for 24 total points on the weekend, which earned him the Pac-12 Men's Athlete of the Meet honor. It was the third highest individual conference points total in ASU history.

LOOKING EVER FURTHER BACK - 2011 NCAA West Regional

The Sun Devils sent 13 student-athletes beyond the regional into the NCAA Championships last year at the event in Eugene, Ore. Anna Jelmini advanced in both the shot out and discus events last season while Jordan Clarke advanced in the shot put. Ryan Milus moved to the 100-meter semifinals as a freshman and Chris Benard moved on in the triple jump in his first season as a Sun Devil. Cj Navarro (hammer), Christabel Nettey (long jump), Keia Pinnick (heptathlon), Kayla Sanchez (400m hurdles) were the other current Sun Devils who advanced beyond the Regional last season.

NETTEY POT

Christabel Nettey looked up to snuff with her outdoor long jumping self that earned first-team All-America honors last season as she soared 6.58m (21-07.25) in the team's season opener at the Baldy Castillo Invitational for a new career best and improved her second-place hold on ASU's all-time list in the event. The mark is also good for the seventh-best jump in the nation this year and the top mark in the conference heading into the weekend. Nettey also moved into second all-time at ASU in the triple jump with her leap of 12.80m (42-00.00) at the ASU Invite.

RUNNING RELAY FAST

The ASU men's relay teams strutted their stuff at the Sun Angel Classic with the men's 4x100m of Daniel Auberry, Chris Burrows, Rashad Ross and Ryan Milus clocking a time of 39.12 that ranks seventh in the country thus far. The 4x400m team of Kelsey Caesar, Chris Burrows, John Kline and Will Henry currently sits 15th as well with their season opening time of 3:05.29. Both those squad swept the Pac-12 titles in their respective events in Eugene - the first sweep of the relays since 2005 and just the third in ASU Pac-10/12 history.

I'VE GOT A HINCH

Before the 2012 season even got underway, head coach Greg Kraft said that Derrick Hinch, a junior college pole vault transfer out of Cuesta College in California, would be one of the team's dark horse as it fights for Pac-12 dominance this year. Hinch looked to be playing the part at the ASU Invite as he soared 5.50m (18-00.50) for the second-best jump in school history and the current sixth-best pole vault in the nation and the second-best in the conference. Hinch took second at the Pac-12 Championships in the event.

Awards / Notes

IT'S ALL HER VAULT

Shaylah Simpson is not suffering any sort of sophomore slump in 2012 in the pole vault. After setting the freshman record in the event last season, Simpson set personal record in three consecutive competitions this year, cumulating in a new career-best of 4.30m (14-01.25) for the ninth-best jump in the nation this year and the second-best jump in ASU history - less than an inch behind April Kubishta's school record in the event. Simpson took third at the Pac-12 Championships.

PINNICK BASKET

Keeping track of Keia Pinnick at a track meet isn't always an easy task. The junior does just about everything for the Sun Devils and showed it at the Pac-12 Combined Events in last weekend as she set a career best in the heptathlon with a score of 5,703. That score sits sixth in the nation in 2012 and would have been good for fifth at the NCAA Championships in 2011. Not only that, but it moves Pinnick to third on ASU's all-time descending order list in the event.

KEIA TO THE CITY

Pinnick is proving herself to be one of the most pivotal pieces on the ASU squad outside of the heptathlon as demonstrated by her new career-best run of 57.34 to win the open section of the Mt. SAC Relays. The time is good for the 16th-best time in the nation and also moved her to sixth on ASU's all-time list in the event. Pinnick was fourth in the event at the Pac-12 Championships and was also fourth in the 100-meter hurdles. With the Championships season underway though, Pinnick will turn her attention solely to the long jump this weekend, where she has already gone over six meters this season.

RUNNING FOR MILUS AND MILES

If there is such a thing as a sophomore slump, Ryan Milus is showing no symptoms of it in the 2012 outdoor season. The second-year runner broke the meet record at the ASU invite with a career-best time of 10.21 in the 100-meter dash and followed it up with a then-career-best 20.86 in the 200-meter dash later in the event. Milus currently sits 17th in the nation at 100 meters and was fourth in the event at the Pac-12 Championships. Milus also ran the anchor leg for the Pac-12 Championship 4x100-meter relay team.

GRAND MASON

Another student-athlete not looking at any dropoff is Mason McHenry at 800 meters. After winning the 2012 NCAA Indoor Championship in the event, McHenry clocked a new outdoor best of 1:47.60 at the ASU Invite for the 13th-fastest time in the country and second-fastest in school history. McHenry was third in the event at the Pac-12 Championships.

SHELBY GT800

Freshman Shelby Houlihan is fast becoming one of the top middle-distance runners to ever come through Tempe and she's only competed in just a handful of races. Competing against several potential Olympians at the Sun Angel Classic, Houlihan clocked a freshman record and the eighth-fastest time in the country in 2:03.85 for the third-best time in school history in just her second outdoor 800-meter run and took fourth in the event at the Pac-12 Championships.

THROWING THEIR WEIGHT

Over the past 10 years, David Dumble has continued to bring in top talent and build the throws program at Arizona State, which has collected 13 total national titles, including the shiny new trophy earned by Jordan Clarke at the NCAA Indoor Championships just two weeks ago. With Clarke the defending indoor AND outdoor national champion and Anna Jelmini the top returning discus thrower in the nation, the ASU throws team looks to continue their perennial dominance of the event into the outdoor season.

A MAN OF MANY DIFFERENT HATS

Jordan Clarke has wasted little time establishing himself as one of the top all-around throwers in the country with his recent performances. Clarke ranks in the top 15 in both the shot put and discus events, sitting fourth and 11th, respectively. Clarke took the 2012 Pac-12 title in the shot put, was second in the hammer and nabbed a third-place finish in the discus to give him 24 points towards Arizona State's team title and garnering him Pac-12 Athlete of the Meet accolades.

EVERYTHING IS JEL-ING

Clarke isn't the only Sun Devil turning it on in the throws. Sophomore Anna Jelmini finds herself ranked second in the discus and eighth in the shot put events and she swept the two events at the Pac-12 Championships. It was the second consecutive Pac-12 discus title for the sophomore and the first shot put crown of her career.

FLYING HIGH

Bryan McBride has come on strong in his sophomore campaign and finds himself fast rising the ASU all-time ranks in the process. McBride currently ranks 18th in the nation with his career outdoor best of 2.20m (7-02.50) in both outdoor contests he has competed in this year, good for seventh on ASU's all-time list.

TRIPLE THE EXCITEMENT

Chris Benard is now the proud owner of two school records after knocking off Deon Mayfield's 30-year-old school record at the Mt. SAC Relays with a new career-best of 16.74m (54-11.25). The mark moved Benard into the top spot in the nation at the NCAA level in 2012 and earned him Pac-12 Field Athlete of the Week honors for the second time this season. Benard won the triple jump championship at the Pac-12 Championships in Eugene.

IN THE TOP 10 ALL-TIME - OUTDOORS

The Sun Devils are starting to get into the swing of things and, as such, the record book is starting to need some re-writing. Thus far in 2012, five student-athletes have etched their names in the record books for the first time while 14 athletes in 18 events have all improved upon prior record book marks. Derick Hinch, Andrea Crook, Chris Benard, Alex Hartig and Shelby Houlihan are the newest additions to the list, with Hinch moving to second all-time in the pole vault, Crook seventh in the triple jump, Benard taking the school record in the triple jump, Hartig ninth in the shot put and Houlihan ninth in the 1,500-meter run and third in the 800m. Christabel Nettey is pacing the way for the returners, as she has improved to second in both the long jump and triple jump. Ryan Milus (100m), Mason McHenry (800m), Bryan McBride (high jump), Shaylah Simpson (pole vault), Linda Kuenzi (pole vault), Jordan Clarke (shot put/hammer), Ashley Lampley (hammer), Anna Jelmini (shot put/hammer), Cj Navarro (hammer), Constance Ezugha (long jump), Kauren Tarver (steeplechase), Lindsey Prescott (10,000m) and Keia Pinnick (heptathlon/400m hurdles) have all also improved upon marks they already held within the top 10.

IN THE TOP 10 ALL-TIME - INDOORS

With the indoor season in the books, 31 ASU student-athletes in 41 events moved into or improved upon their prior top-10 marks in school history. The newcomers include Cameron Taylor (60mH, second), Derick Hinch (Pole Vault, fifth), Shelby Houlihan (800m, third/Mile, first), Asiah Gooden (60m, seventh), Alycia Herring (60m, eighth/200m, ninth), Rashad Ross (200m, fourth), Nick Happe (Mile, first), Brian Pierre (3000m, eighth/5000m, first), Mason McHenry (Mile, seventh), Chris Burrows (200m, fifth), Bryan McBride (triple jump, ninth), Chris Benard (long jump, seventh), Alex Hartig (shot put) and Daniel Auberry (60m, fifth/200m 10th). Ryan Milus (60m), Chris Benard (triple jump/long jump), Bryan McBride (high jump), Ashley Lampley (weight throw), Cj Navarro (weight throw) Jordan Clarke (shot put/weight throw), Keia Pinnick (60m hurdles), John Kline (800m), Nick Happe (3000m/5000m), Darius Terry (mile), Kayla Sanchez (60m/200m) Jamie Sandys (heptathlon), Austin Prince (heptathlon/pole vault), Jeremy Marcinko (heptathlon/pole vault), Lindsay Prescott (5000m) Keia Pinnick (pentathlon) and Asiah Gooden (60m) all improved upon marks they already held in the top-10 in their respective events.

RETURNING ALL-AMERICANS

ASU returns three first team All-Americans and most of a second-team All-America relay team to the outdoor roster this year. Jordan Clarke return as the defending NCAA Champion in the shot put while Anna Jelmini was the runner-up in the discus competition last year and Christabel Nettey earned first-team recognition in the

long jump. Alycia Herring, Keia Pinnick and Kayla Sanchez all return as members of the 4x400-meter relay team that earned second-team honors last season. In addition, Clarke and Jelmini earned indoor All-America honors this year as well in addition to Mason McHenry (800m), Chris Benard (triple jump) and Bryan McBride (high jump) - all of whom earned first-team accolades - and second-team honorees Ryan Milus (60m) and Nick Happe (mile). Netley also earned second-team long jump honors indoors.

LAST HURRAH

The season marks the final runs of the careers of several Sun Devil seniors. On the men's side, Daniel Auberry, Allante Battle, Chris Benard, Kelsey Caesar, John Kline, Mason McHenry, Marc Peck, Brian Pierre, Austin Prince, and Jamie Sandys enter their final campaign in the Maroon and Gold while Ashley Lampley, Cj Navarro, Kayla Sanchez, Lindsay Prescott and Kauren Tarver will compete in their last competitions as Sun Devils this year.

WHO'S THE NEW KID?

Twenty-three athletes, including 12 women and 9 men, have joined the Sun Devil program for the first time in 2012. The true freshmen include Edmond Baker, Domenic D'Acquisto, Ryan Herson, Cody Moore, William Taylor, Daniel Wong and Heyden Wooff on the men's side and Macy Bricks, Taylor Conway, Shaina Corbin, Monica Danielson, Shelby Houlihan, Mackenzie Maki, Carly Paracholski, Payton Schutte, Brianna Tate and Brierra Winfrey for the women. Junior college transfers Derick Hinch (Cuesta College) and Chris Burrows (Lake Erie College) join the men's side. The women also picked up a huge addition in All-American hammer thrower Chelsea Cassulo from UNLV this season, though she will redshirt until next year.

BACK ON SCHEDULE

In 1996, Pal Arne Fagernes won the men's javelin title at the NCAA Championships. It was not until 2004 that Arizona State had another national champion as Jacquelyn Johnson won the outdoor heptathlon as a true freshman. Starting in 2005, ASU had at least one returning NCAA champion on its roster for six years in a row, a streak that came to an end last season because of graduation. The 2010 and 2009 rosters featured two returning individuals each (Ryan Whiting and Jason Lewis in 2010, Whiting and Sarah Stevens in 2009) while the 2008 roster featured four returning champions in Johnson, Stevens, Jessica Pressley and April Kubishta, all who won titles in 2007. The Sun Devils had no returning champions in 2011 but rectified that for the 2012 season with junior Jordan Clarke returning as the 2011 NCAA outdoor shot put champion this season and guaranteed that they will return a national champion next year as well after winning the indoor shot put title this year.

SAME TEAMMATE, DIFFERENT TEAM

As the season begins, there are incredible 23 Sun Devils on the roster that were teammates before they came to Arizona State, including transfers from two colleges and five high schools represented. Daniel Auberry and Chris Benard return to the Sun Devils this season after competing together at Riverside Community College just two years ago. Thrower Joe Riccio attended Mesa Community College with Hailey Hanna. Teammates have been reunited from five high schools as well, including four from the Valley. Sophomores Asia Gooden and Alycia Herring are both entering their second years with ASU after running together at Ranch Verde HS in California and freshmen Monica Danielson and Tanner Greeley both come to ASU out of Edison HS in Huntington Beach, Calif. Will Henry and newcomer Chris Burrows were teammates at Trotwood Madison HS in Dayton, Ohio for a couple of seasons. Ryan Herson and Brierra Winfrey are both products of Trabuco Hills HS in Mission Viejo, Calif. Locally, Desert Vista is represented by Edmond Baker, Allante Battle, Matt Boughton, John Kline, Cory Kraft and Shaylah Simpson; Sandra Day O'Connor is represented by Lindsay Prescott and Bryan McBride; Corona del Sol has Garrett Baker-Slama and Josh Walker; Jared Gonzales and Andrew Hagler ran together at Chandler High.

RECAP: 2012 NCAA Indoor Championships

The Sun Devils wrapped up the 2012 Indoor Season in Boise, Idaho, just two weeks ago as the men's team posted a fourth-place finish and brought home two individual national champions in the process. Jordan Clarke launched a monster of a final throw of 20.86m (65-05.25) to earn his second national title in the shot put and first indoors while Mason McHenry clocked a time of 1:47.87 at 800 meters for his first career national title. Chris Bernard broke his own school record in the triple jump with a leap of 16.50m (54-01.75) to take second overall while Bryan McBride was sixth in the high jump to also earn All-America accolades. On the women's side, sophomore Anna Jelmini earned her second career indoor All-America honor with an indoor personal record of 17.15m to finish fifth overall. Ryan Milus (60m), Nick Happe (mile) and Christabel Nettey (long jump) all earned second-team All-America accolades.

A REWARDING YEAR

It was a big year for the Sun Devils in the awards category during the 2012 indoor season. The ASU men took home their first MPSF title in school history, scoring 131.5 points for a 50-point margin of victory over second place Stanford - both landmarks sitting as the best in the past decade in MPSF competition. Greg Kraft was awarded the MPSF Men's Coach of the Year as well as the USTFCCCA West Region Men's Coach of the Year. Chris Bernard took home USTFCCCA West Region Field Athlete of the Year honors courtesy of his school-record setting year in the triple jump and 18 points scored at the MPSF Championships.

KRAFT LEADS THE WAY

Head Coach Greg Kraft is entering his 16th year as the leader of the Sun Devil program, a tenure that has brought Arizona State back to the top of the standings in both the NCAA and Pac-12 events. Since his hiring, the program has continued to evolve into one of the more well-rounded in the nation with strength on the track and in the field as well as in cross country. Kraft and his staff have worked diligently to reach their goals of championships and success in education and that has not been more clearly seen than in the past five years as the hardware has continued to roll in. His program has annually produced some of the top individuals in the nation with 26 of the program's 60 individual and relay national titles won since 2004 while both his teams and individual student-athletes have garnered na-

tional academic acclaim. Prior to his arrival, the program boasted one NCAA Championship (men's outdoor track & field, 1977) and one Pac-10 Championship (men's outdoor track & field, 1981). In the last six years, his Sun Devils have captured four national crowns (2007 women's indoor and outdoor track & field, 2008 men's and women's indoor track & field) and added three Pac-10 Championships (women's outdoor track & field, 2006-08). Kraft's teams have finished in the Top 10 of the NCAA Track & Field Championships on 22 occasions in 16 years while the program had done so just 14 times prior to his arrival in Tempe.

LONG TENURE IN TEMPE

As he begins his 16th year at Arizona State, Kraft's tenure ranks as the second-longest in Sun Devil track & field history and the fourth-longest active streak among all current ASU head coaches. The only coach that has led the track & field program longer than Kraft is legendary coach Senon 'Baldy' Castillo, who led the way for 26 years (1954-79). Among current Sun Devil head coaches, Kraft's 16th year ranks behind John Spini, who is in his 32nd year with gymnastics and Sheila McNerney, who is in her 28th year with women's tennis.

NEXT TIME OUT

The Sun Devils will close out the season at the NCAA Championships in Des Moines, Iowa, in June.
