Arizona State (17-3) enters the midweek series with Oklahoma State as a consensus top 10 team in the nation in all four national polls. ASU ranks as high as No. 5 by Collegiate Baseball and No. 6 by Sports Weekly/ESPN. The Devils also moved up two spots to No. 8 by Baseball America and remained No. 7 by NCBWA. The Sun Devils have now been ranked in the national polls for 85 consecutive polls. Oklahoma State (12-5) is ranked No. 33 by NCBWA and was the preseason No. 37 selection by Baseball America.

ASU improved to 10-1 against ranked opponents this year by winning two of three from No. 11 Tulane last weekend... Jason Urquidez is off to a 6-0, 1.77 ERA start to his ASU career... Dustin Pedroia ranks fifth in the ASU career record books with 59 doubles... Travis Buck became the first Sun Devil since 1984 to earn back-to-back Pac-10 Player of the Week awards (Oddibe McDowell).

STAT OF THE WEEK

Travis Buck became the first Sun Devil since Mitch Jones in 2000 to record a home run in five straight games. Buck had his streak ended in Saturday's 11-3 win over Tulane. He leads the team with six HR and 31 RBI.

What's On Tap:

The Sun Devil Baseball team (17-3) continues their 25-game homestand this week with a busy schedule of five games in six days. The Devils start the slate with a pair of non-conference tilts against Oklahoma State (12-5) on Tuesday (7 p.m.) and Wednesday (7 p.m. at Packard Stadium. After 20 games the Devils have 17 wins and are off to the second best start during the Pat Murphy era (1995-P). ASU's only better start was when they went 28-1 to begin the 2003 campaign. ASU is coming off a solid series win over No. 11 Tulane and are 10-1 against ranked opponents. ASU opens their 27th season of Pac-10 play this weekend with a three-game series against California.

Recapping The Tulane Series:

The Devils earned a key series win over the No. 11 Tulane Green Wave last weekend in impressive fashion to improve to 17-3 overall and 10-1 against ranked opponents. ASU bounced back from a tough 5-3 loss in the opener to take the next two games by decisive scores of 11-3 and 5-1. After losing Friday's opener the Devils won or tied the next 18 innings of baseball. Junior shortstop Dustin Pedroia ended an 0-for-10 slump by goin g 6-for-8 with six RBI in the last two games. Junior starting pitcher Jason Urquidez (6-0) and sophomore reliever Erik Averill (2-0) picked up the wins as the pitching staff tamed the Green Wave for a 2.33 ERA in the series.

- Junior shortstop Dustin Pedroia has hits in 17 of ASU's 120games and is hitting .439 with 12 2B, 4 HR and 22 RBI.
- Freshman relief pitcher Pat Bresnehan is 2-0 with four saves and 22 strikeouts in his last six appearances (17 IP). Jason Urquidez leads the team with a 6-0 record and a 1.77 ERA in his six starts. He has 33 K's in 35.2 IP.
- ASU picked up its 2.000th all-time varsity (1959-P) victory with Saturday's 11-3 win over Tulane.
- Travis Buck became the first Pac-10 player to earn back-to-back Player of the Week honors since 1998. Travis Buck leads the team in two of the three Triple Crown categories with six home runs and 31 RBI.
- The Devils have been ranked in 85 consecutive national polls dating back to the start of 2000.
- ASU features three freshman (Curtis, Bresnehan, Zinicola) that are among Baseball America's top 50 freshman.
- Sophomore LHP Brett Bordes is 1-0 with a 5.54 ERA and has 21 strikeouts in just 13.0 IP (14.54 K/9.0 IP)

Poll Mechanics:

Arizona State (17-3) remained the same in all three major college polls after going 2-1 to earn a series win over No. 11 Tulane. The Devils are ranked No. 5 in the recent *Collegiate Baseball* poll, No. 8 by *Baseball America* and No. 6 by *ESPN/Sports Weekly*. With a 10-1 record against ranked opponents, ASU is in its third week as a consensus top 10 team. The Devils have now been ranked for 85 consecutive weeks dating back to the start of the 2000 season. ASU entered the 2004 season ranked in all four of the national preseason polls (#7 CB, #10 SW, #11 NCBWA, #18 BA). ASU finished the 2003 season with a 54-14 record and earned a consensus top 10 ranking in all four national polls.

Preseason All-Americans:

Sun Devil juniors Dustin Pedroia and Jeff Larish earned preseason All-America honors from every publication. Pedroia earned first-team honors from the NCBWA, Collegiate Baseball, CollegeBaseballInsider.com, and was a third-team pick by Baseball America. He was also selected as the preseason pick for Pac-10 Player of the Year by Baseball America. Larish, who moves to the outfield for the 2004 season, was a first-team pick by Collegiate Baseball, Baseball America, CollegeBaseballInsider.com, and was a second-team pick by the NCBWA. Larish was also selected as the preseason College Baseball Player of the Year by Street & Smith's.

Travis Buck Continues Torrid Streak:

Sophomore right fielder Travis Buck could be the hottest hitter in college baseball. Buck is hitting .581 (18-for-31) over his last nine games with 11 runs scored, five doubles, five home runs, 21 RBI and a 1.226 slugging percentage. He had a stretch of hitting a home run in five straight games and earned back-to-back Pac-10 Player of the Week honors. During his torrid stretch he has raised his season batting average 140 points from .278 on Feb. 24 to its current team-leading mark of 418 (28-for-67). Buck leads the team in two of the three Triple Crown categories with six home runs and 31 RBI. He also has three outfield assists and is 5-for-5 stealing bases. He was named Pac-10 Player of the Week and the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week after going 10-for-12 (833) with 13 RBI in the three-game series against UConn (2/27-29).

Buck Repeats As Pac-10 Player of the Week:

After going 5-for-10 with home runs in all three games against East Carolina, Travis Buck earned his second consecutive Pac-10 Player of the Week award. With his third career Pac-10 POW award, he became the 16th conference player and first since 1998 to repeat since Cal's Xavier Nady earned the award in consecutive weeks in 1998 (Apr. 27, May 4). He is the first Sun Devil since Oddibe McDowell in 1984 to earn back-to-back conference honors.

Five Times The Fun:

Travis Buck had a recent string of hitting a home run in five straight games dating back to the Sunday victory over Connecticut (2/29). He is the first Sun Devil to hit homers in five straight since single-season home run record holder Mitch Jones cleared the fences in five straight games during that save 2000 season against Florida State (2/6), Duke (2/ 11-13) and LSU (2/18).

Bresnehan Inching Towards Freshman Saves Record:


Only 20 games into his ASU career, freshman Pat Bresnehan is on the fast track to demolish the ASU freshman record for saves in a season. Through 20 games, Bresnehan already has four saves to rank tied for third in the record books with Larry Eiler (1976). The hard-throwing right-hander has been especially hot with two wins and four saves in his last six games.

Pedroia Off To Another Torrid Start:

Junior shortstop Dustin Pedroia is off to a solid start leading the team hitting .439 (36-for-82) with 32 runs scored, 12 doubles, four home runs and 22 RBI. He has hits in 17 of ASU's 20 games, including 10 multihit affairs and four games with two or more doubles. Pedroia earned his second career Pac-10 Player of the Week award after hitting .688 during a four-game stretch against Gonzaga, Lamar, Memphis and Rice. He is coming off another solid weekend, going 6-for-11 (.545) with six RBI in the three-game series against Tulane. He recently ended an 0-for-10 slump by going 6-for-8 in the last two games of the series against the Green Wave, including a career-high five RBI while going 4-for-4 in Saturday's 11-3 victory. As a sophomore, Pedroia hit .404 (120-for-297) and was named the Pac-10 Co-Player of the Year. He led the NCAA with 34 doubles, setting the ASU and Pac-10 single-season record and tied for third all-time in the NCAA record books. With 12 doubles, he now has 59 in his career, ranking fifth in the ASU career record books. A career .387 (238-for-615) hitter. Pedroia ranks seventh in the ASU career record books. He has played and started all 146 games of his Sun Devil career and has recorded at least one hit in 124 games (85%). Additionally, the 2003 Collegiate Baseball Defensive Player of the Year has made only 17 errors in 628 total chances in the field for a career. 973 FLD%. He was a two-year starter for the USA Baseball National Team and was named to the all-tournament team in the 2003 Pan American Games in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic.

Urquidez Named To Clemens Award Watch List:

Arizona State starting pitcher Jason Urquidez is part of a list of 40 hurlers who are included in the first Roger Clemens Award Watch List. The list is comprised of all Division I pitchers who were named as pre-season All-Americans by either Baseball America or Collegiate Baseball, in addition to those pitchers who have been honored so far this season as National Pitchers of the Week. Urquidez earned national POW honors from *Collegiate Baseball*, NCBWA, Sports Weekly and CollegeBaseballInsider.com. He was also named the Pac-10 Pitcher of the Week after his complete-game three-hitter against No. 1 and defending national champion Rice Owls at Reckling Park in Houston last weekend. A junior college transfer from Central Arizona College, Urquidez is off to a perfect 6-0 start with a 1.77 ERA. He has 33 strikeouts in 35.2 IP and opposing hitters are batting only .194 off him. In its inaugural year, The Roger Clemens Award will be presented to the nation's top college pitcher at the conclusion of a gala dinner in Houston on July 15.

A Perfect Start For Urquidez:

Junior starting pitcher Jason Urquidez is perfect in a Sun Devil uniform. The right-hander has won each of his six starts to build a 6-0 record with a 1.77 ERA. He is the first Sun Devil since 2001 to win the first five appearances in a Sun Devil uniform since Andy Torres started 5-0 in 2001. Torres had four wins in starts and one win out of the bullpen to start his only year at ASU. The current Toronto Blue Jays minor leaguer finished the year 13-4 with a 4.30 ERA.

Tuff Behind the Plate:

Junior catcher Tuffy Gosewisch is the epitome of his named behind the dish... tough. In his second year as a full-time starter, Gosewisch has taken ASU's young pitching staff by the reigns to help lead the Devils to success with a 17-3 record and 3.32 ERA. Additionally, he is to a great start at the plate, hitting .343 (24-for-70) with 14 runs, six doubles, one home run and 12 RBI. He has recorded at least one hit in 15 of ASU's 120 games, including going 7-for-21 (.333) over his last six games. The Johnny Bench Catcher of the Year candidate has thrown out eight of 18 attempted base stealers and has not recorded a passed ball this season.

Victory No. 2.000 In The Books:

With the 11-3 victory on Saturday over No. 11 Tulane, ASU recorded its 2,000th for the program since officially adopting the program as a varsity sport in 1959. Baseball has been played at ASU since 1907, but was not officially recognized as a varsity program until Bobby Winkles took over the program in 1959. The Devils have an all-time varsity record of 2,001-794-1 and is sixth in the NCAA with an all-time 2,334-1,139-6 record dating back to 1907.

Pedroia And Buck Lead It Off:

Dustin Pedroia and Travis Buck have hit No. 1 and No. 2 in the lineup in 16 of ASU's 20 games this year and have been the catalyst behind ASU's quick starts. The Devils have scored in the first inning in 11 of those games for 30 total runs. Pedroia and Buck have reached base in successive order in their first at-bats in 10 of those 16 games, including both getting hits in five games. Against FSU (2/8) and Cal State Northridge (2/13), Buck and Pedroia each led off the game hitting doubles to plate a run each time. Pedroia has a knack for getting on base while leading off a game (11 of 20), while Buck has reached base in 16 of his 20 first at-bats (9 hits, 2 HR).

Hitting Streaks:

Four Sun Devils are currently riding hitting streaks of two or more games heading into the midweek series against Oklahoma State. Junior shortstop Dustin Pedroia recently had his team-high 10-game hitting streak snapped going 0-for-5 against ECU (3/7). Pedroia hit .475 (19-for-40) during his steak. Pat Murphy



Since inheriting the Sun Devil program in August of 1994, Arizona State Baseball Head Coach Pat Murphy has carefully nurtured the tradition of excellence in Tempe, at the same time establishing

himself as one of the top collegiate head coaches in the nation. He has guided Arizona State to top-12 national rankings in four of the past seven seasons, including an appearance in the 1998 College World Series national championship game. Murphy has combined to go 377-181-1 in his 10 seasons in Tempe and posts an all-time 28-20 record in NCAA Tournament action. He has a career 750-352-4 record in 19 seasons as a head coach. Murphy recorded his 600th career Division 1 victory in 2002 and recorded his 700th career coaching victory (all levels) with a 14-8 come-from-behind win over No. 11 Notre Dame (2/23/03). ASU has been in 85 straight national polls under Murphy. The Sun Devils also set an NCAA record scoring in 506 straight games.

Throwbacks Are Classic:

The Sun Devils unveiled a new 'Throwback' uniform for the 2004 season and it has gotten rave reviews. Originally slated to be the designated Sunday uniform, the Devils have worn the classic threads in 17 of the 20 games this season and gone 15-2. The off-white uniform features a baggier look and an old-school 'Devils' script across the chest. The Devils wear black spikes and high socks to compliment the 'old school' look. ASU is also 2-0 in the all white uniforms and 0-1 in the road gray sleeveless jersey.

Bresnehan On Fire On The Mound:

Freshman pitcher Pat Bresnehan (Sherborn, Mass.) has been impressive in his last six outings picking up a pair of wins and four saves. The hard-throwing right-hander has recorded 22 strikeouts and allowed only eight hits in his last six appearances. During that stretch of 17.0 innings he has not given up an earned run. He picked up the win with a career high seven strikeouts in five innings against Gonzaga (2/16) and recorded the save against Arizona (2/24) with five strikeouts in three scoreless innings. He also had a pair of saves against No. 18 East Carolina and closed out ASU's series win over No. 11 Tulane with a save (2.0 IP, 1 H, 2 K). For the season, Bresnehan is 3-0 with four saves and leads the team with a 1.50 ERA in nine appearances. He has recorded 23 strikeouts in 18.0 IP and has limited opposiing batters to a .158 batting average. He was 23rd round draft pick of the Kansas City Royals out of Dover-Sherborn High School and played for the USA Baseball Junior National Team during his prep career.

Tough Against Ranked Teams:

The Sun Devils are off to an impressive 17-3 start after the series victory over No. 11 Tulane, but also hold an even more impressive 10-1 record against ranked opponents. ASU is scheduled to play 22 non-conference games before heading into conference play against California (Mar. 19-21) and will have played 13 of those games against teams that have appeared in the national rankings. ASU has already swept No. 18 Florida State (Feb. 6-8) to open the season and also beat No. 1 Rice (3-1, Feb. 22), No. 16 Arizona (4-0, Feb. 26), swept No. 18 ECU (Mar. 5-7) and took two of three from No. 11 Tulane. Both of ASU's losses have also come against teams that have appeared in at least one top 25 polls this year (Oklahoma and Lamar). ASU is also 11-2 against teams with a record above .500. ASU checked in at No. 4 on Boyds World.com projected RPI last week.


