**2003 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:** Recorded one of the best single-season offensive and defensive performances in ASU history... named Pac-10 co-Player of the Year with Stanford's Ryan Garko and was nearly a consensus first-team All-American... selected as a first-team All-American by Collegiate Baseball, ESPN/ Sports Weekly, ABCA, NCBWA and CollegeBaseballInsider.com... a second-team pick by Baseball America and was the District IX Player of the Year (NCBWA)... selected for second straight year to play for the USA Baseball National Team... set ASU and Pac-10 single-season record with 34 doubles and led the NCAA... the old ASU record for doubles was 30 set by Sal Bando (1978) and the Pac-10 record was previously held by

former WSU Cougar and current Los Angeles Dodger Mike Kinkade (31, 1994)... also ranked 31st in the NCAA in batting and was the fourth toughest to strikeout (1 K every 22.8 at-bats)... finished the season hitting .404 (120-for-297), marking the 16th time a Sun Devil has finished the season hitting over .400... his 120 hits are fourth most in ASU single-season history and his 297 at-bats are fourth most... finished second in the Pac-10 in hitting (.404), sixth in on-base percentage (.472), first in runs scored (83), first in hits (120), second in total bases (172) and sixth in walks (36)... finished the season at .404 despite going 0-for-13 in the super regional against Cal State Fullerton... named the Tempe Regional Most Outstanding Player after going 8-for-16 (.500)... also named MVP of the Coca-Cola Classic hitting .417 (5-for-12) and was named to the all-tournament team at the Bob Schaefer Memorial Classic... named one of 25 players on the initial Golden Spikes Award Watch List ... recorded 41 multi-hit games and went hitless in only seven games all year... was the only Sun Devil to play and start in all 68 games... of his 41 multi-hit games, 15 were with three or more hits... he recorded four separate hitting streaks of 10 or more games and five streaks of eight or more games... started the season with an 11-game streak going 20-for-45 (.444)... also had a 17-game streak in February and early March in which he went 34-for-72 (.472)... defensively did not make an error in his last 26 games (124 total chances) and finished the year with a .975 fielding percentage... named Pac-10 Player of the Week (5/19) after going 10-for-23 (.435) in a five-game stretch at Oregon State and Washington... in addition to his 34 doubles, also had three triples and four home runs to lead the team with 41 extra base hits... led the Sun Devils hitting .478 (43-for-90) with runners in scoring position... ASU was 52-11 when Pedroia hit in the leadoff position... will enter his junior season with a career .379 batting average (202-for-533), ranked 11th in ASU history... he has played and started every game of his ASU career (126 games)... the heart and soul of the Sun Devils on and off the field as a team leader... described by UNLV head coach as the "Pete Rose of College Baseball"... repeated as team member of USA Baseball National team... hit .294 (30-for-102) for Team USA with five doubles, one home runs and 12 RBI... started 28 of 29 games and helped lead Team USA to a 27-2 record and a silver medal in the 2003 Pan Am Games in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic... named to the Pan Am Games All-Tournament Team... named a first-team Summer All-American by Baseball America.



**2003 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:** Had a breakthrough year in 2003 earning First-Team All-Pac-10 honors and several All-America honors... named second-team All-American by Collegiate Baseball, Baseball America and CollegeBaseballInsider.com... also picked up third-team honors from the NCBWA and the ABCA... named co-Offensive MVP at ASU Baseball Awards Banquet... selected with teammate Dustin Pedroia to play on the USA Baseball National Team... hit .372 with 80 runs scored, 18 doubles, two triples, 18 home runs and 95 RBI... ranked 51st in the NCAA in home runs per game (0.28), sixth in RBI (1.46), 18th in runs (1.23), 38th in slugging percentage (.697), and led the nation in walks (1.2 per

**2003 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:** Named All-Pac-10 Honorable Mention and was ASU's co-Freshman Newcomer of the year with Erik Averill... also earned freshman All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball and Baseball America (2nd team)... named to Baseball America's midseason freshman All-America team... hit .326 (78-for-239) with 13 doubles, three triples and four home runs... played in 66 games during his freshman campaign, making 65 starts... made 33 starts in left field, 31 in right field and one at designated hitter... also recorded 46 RBI and scored 59 runs... tabbed 22 multi-hit games, including 14 two-hit games, seven three-hit games and one five-hit contest... also had eight multi-RBI games... had 11 bunt base hits and also had five sacrifice hits to lead the team... longest hitting streak of the year
