All three games of the Arizona series can be heard on KDUS 1060 AM. **Tim Healey** and **Bob Eger** will call the action. Mondays with Murph airs every Monday on ESPN Radio 860 AM beginning at 7:05 PM. The show is aired live from Macayo's in Tempe.

Leading Off:

The Sun Devils hit the road for the final road trip of the 2006 regular season as they head to Tucson for a three-game Pac-10 series with the Arizona Wildcats. The Sun Devils took two of three from Pac-10 leader Oregon State over the weekend, while Arizona dropped two of three to Washington State in Tucson.

The Sun Devils vs. The Wildcats:

ASU holds a 167-108 edge over their in-state rivals since Arizona State began varsity baseball in 1959. Arizona won the first meeting this season 12-8 in the Challenge at Chase on April 2nd, but the Devils took the May 2nd meeting 22-8 in Tempe. Both of those games were non-conference tilts, while this weekend will be a Pac-10 series.

Now Appearing, Brett Bordes:

With his two appearances against the Beavers over the weekend, senior LHP **Brett Bordes** passed **Kendall Carter** for the school record of 102 career appearances. **Bordes** has now pitched in 104 games as a Sun Devil, eclipsing the mark that **Carter** set from 1981 to 1984. Of the 104 appearances, 92 of them have come in relief, including all 26 of his games this season. **Bordes** leads the team with six victories and has four saves.

RB-Ike! RB-Ike!:

On the strength of his four RBI weekend against the Beavers, freshman **Ike Davis** has tied **Casey Myers** for the most runs batted in by a Sun Devil freshman in ASU history. **Myers** knocked in 58 runs in 1998, and **Davis** has 58 with six regular season games remaining. **Davis** currently leads the Pac-10 in RBI, something no freshman has ever done.

Rankings:

The Sun Devils are ranked #13 by *Baseball America*, up five spots from last week. They are ranked #14 by *Collegiate Baseball*, who had them 20th a week ago. ASU rose to #12 in the *USA Today*/ESPN Coaches Poll, a five spot jump. They also rose six spots to #12 in the NCBWA Poll.

Since inheriting the Sun Devil program in August of 1994, **Pat Murphy** has carefully nurtured the tradition of excellence in Tempe, while at the same time establishing himself as one of the top collegiate head coaches in the nation. He has guided Arizona State University to Top 12 rankings in five of the past nine seasons, including last season's third place finish at the 2005 College World Series. In his eleven seasons in Tempe, **Murphy** owns a record of 475-238-1. In his 18 seasons at the Division I level, **Murphy** has a record of 793-354-2. He has led ASU to CWS berths in 1998 and 2005, was the *Baseball America* Coach of the Year in 1998 and was the Pac-10 Coach of the Year in 2000.

OSU Wrap-Up:

Tony Barnette got the starting nod on Friday night, matching up with Beavers ace **Dallas Buck**. **Barnette** was magnificent, allowing only two runs in his seven innings of work while striking out ten to pick up his fourth win of the year. He kept the game close, allowing the ASU offense to break out in the seventh inning. The Devils scored eight times in the inning to give Arizona State a 10-3 victory...Saturday night saw another fine pitching performance, this time by **Josh Satow**, who went seven plus innings, holding OSU to three runs. ASU once again used a big inning to beat the Beavers, scoring five times in the eighth. **Seth Dhaenens** hit a bases loaded double to center, knocking in three and propelling ASU to a 6-3 win...The Devils defense was their undoing on Sunday, as four ASU errors accounted for five unearned runs, including the difference maker in the ninth as the Beavers salvaged the finale 9-8.

30 Win Mark:

2006 is the 44th straight season Arizona State has surpassed the 30-win total, and 46th time in school history. Head Coach **Pat Murphy** has won over 30 games every season since he began coaching Division I baseball at Notre Dame in 1988.

Frank Mesa, College Graduate:

Senior infielder **Frank Mesa** has earned his degree in sociology from Arizona State University. Mesa and the rest of the class of 2006 picked up their diplomas on May 10th.

Mr. Versatility:

Eric Sogard has proved so far this season that he could hit, but what he proved against Stanford is that he can be an outfielder too. **Sogard**, who played in 27 games as an infielder prior to the Stanford series, flashed his outfield leather against the Cardinal. He made two diving catches, saving four runs, and ultimately the game. He has started in the outfield for the past seven contests.

For Starters:

Head Coach **Pat Murphy** has used 11 different starting pitchers this season after using only eight a season ago. **Ike Davis** leads ASU with 11 games started, yet he has started only once in the past 23 games. In all, 16 different Sun Devils have climbed the hill this year. **Zechry Zinicola** began the season as a starter, was moved to the closer role, sat out after being suspended, then returned to the starting rotation, and is now back in the closer position.

Facing The Best:

Arizona State has been in Pac-10 Conference play for six weeks, and three times in those six weeks the Sun Devils have faced a pitcher who would go on to be named Pac-10 Pitcher of the Week. Washington's **Tim Lincecum** was named after his win on April 7 against ASU, UCLA's **Dave Huff** picked up the honor after his win over the Devils on April 22, and Stanford's **Greg Reynolds** was given the award after his April 28 win over ASU.

Road Trips: Proceed With Caution:

The ASU baseball team has been through some tempestuous times on their road trips this season. On the trip to Waco, Texas, they battled a sinkhole that caused an evacuation of their hotel due to a feared gas leak. They also went through a rain out that led to a doubleheader and a flooded bus. The flight to Austin, Texas for the Whataburger College Classic and match-up with Texas was a bumpy, turbulent ride that made everyone on-board appreciate a relatively calm three-hour bus trip to

Walk This Way:

Sun Devil hitters have displayed a keen eye so far in 2006. As a team, they have drawn 216 walks, third most in the Pac-10. **Willy Fox** and **Preston Paramore** are among the conference leaders in bases on balls.

Just Keep On Using Me...:

Righty **Brady Martinez** is tied for third in the Pac-10 this season with 27 appearances. The school record for appearances in a season is 39, set by **Noah Peery** in 1994. **Brett Bordes** had 38 appearances a year ago and is second on the team this season with 26 appearances.

Beep Beep:

Colin Curtis has set a new career high this season with 20 stolen bases. The junior outfielder stole 17 last season and 12 in his freshman season. The ASU record for stolen bases in a season? 59 by **Kevin Romine** in 1982.

Honors:

Sophomore second baseman **Eric Sogard** was named Pac-10 Player of the Week for his play vs. USC and Texas Tech...Sophomore shortstop **Andrew Romine** was named to the College Baseball Foundation's Honor Roll and was named Pac-10 Player of the Week for his performance against Washington State and Arizona...Freshman lefty **Jeff Urlaub** was named to the College Baseball Foundation's Honor Roll for the week of February 21st...**Ike Davis** earned a spot on the Honor Roll for the week of March 7th, the same week he earned National Player of the Week and Pac-10 Player of the Week honors.

Lone Star Record:

Arizona State played 12 games against teams from Texas this season, finishing with a 9-3 record, including a 5-3 mark in Texas. ASU has a perfect 4-0 mark against Conference USA teams (Houston, Rice), and finished with a 4-4 mark in the Big XII (Baylor, Texas Tech, Texas, Oklahoma).

Ranked Opponents:

The Sun Devils have played 12 games against teams ranked in the *Collegiate Baseball* Top 25. They have also played two teams ranked in the top five in various polls. Oregon State was ranked as high as #2 when the Devils played them in Surprise, and Rice was the top ranked team in the NCBWA Poll when ASU defeated them in the Whataburger College Classic. Oregon State was ranked fourth by *Baseball America* and fifth by *Collegiate Baseball* over the weekend when the Devils took two of three. In this week's *Baseball America* poll, six of the 25 times that are ranked have played the Devils in 2006 (Rice, Texas, Oregon State, Oklahoma, Houston, Baylor).

Two Out Blues:

Arizona State has allowed 133 two-out runs this season, 44% of the 300 runs they have allowed this year. They have scored 127 times with two away, 35% of their 363 runs scored.

TV Games:

The Sun Devils are 7-2 in televised games this season, including a 6-1 record when they play on AZ-TV. They have two televised games left this year, both against Cal.

Big League Devils:

Arizona State has six former Sun Devils currently in the Major Leagues. **Barry Bonds** (San Francisco), **Willie Bloomquist** (Seattle), **Paul LoDuca** (NY Mets), **Chris Duffy** (Pittsburgh)

and **Ian Kinsler** (Texas) were joined by **Andre Ethier**, who became the 84th Sun Devil to play in the big leagues. He made his debut with the Los Angeles Dodgers against the Diamondbacks in his hometown of Phoenix on May 2nd. ASU trails only USC and Texas for the most Major Leaguers in NCAA baseball history.

Honoring '81:

Prior to the Sun Devils game with the Beavers on Sunday, May 14th, Arizona State University retired the numbers of **Alvin Davis** (#9) and **Kevin Romine** (#12) who were both members of the 1981 National Championship team. **Davis** and **Romine** became the 15th and 16th players to have their numbers retired by the baseball program.

Johnny Bench Award Watch:

Freshman catcher **Preston Paramore** has been named to the 2006 Coleman Company-**Johnny Bench** Award Watch List, the award given to the best collegiate catcher. The list features 26 catchers from 15 conferences, with **Paramore** one of only two backstops from the Pac-10 on the list. **Paramore** is also the only freshman on the list. This is the third straight season in which ASU has had a catcher on the Watch List, as **Tuffy Gosewisch** was a semi-finalist for the award in each of the last two seasons.

Stopper of the Year Watch:

Junior RHP **Zechry Zinicola** was named to the Stopper of the Year Watch List, the award given to the best relief pitcher in college baseball. **Zinicola** has made 19 appearances this year, 17 of them in relief. He leads the team with six saves and is third in school history with 18 career saves.

Gene Autry Winner:

On March 20th, **Colin Curtis** was honored as a recipient of the **Gene Autry** Courage Award at a banquet in Tempe. For 13 years the awards have been presented to athletes who have overcome obstacles. **Curtis** was diagnosed with testicular cancer as a freshman at Issaquah High School, but has now been cancer-free for more than five years. Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim manager **Mike Scioscia** presented **Colin** with the award, which is named for the legendary actor and cowboy who once owned the Angels franchise. **Dr. Jim Brock** received an **Autry** Award posthumously in 1995.

Colin Curtis, All-American:

Junior OF **Colin Curtis** was named a First Team Preseason All-American by *Baseball America*, as well as a Preseason All-Pac-10 selection. **Curtis** hit .342 last season, knocking in 45 runs and stealing 17 bases. He was named to the All-College World Series Team and the All-Tempe Regional Team.

Coaches Vote Devils Third in Pre-Season Pac-10 Poll:

Arizona State has been picked to finish in a tie with Stanford for third in the Pac-10 according to the Annual Pac-10 Preseason Coaches Poll. Oregon State, who won the Pac-10 last season, has been picked to win it again this season.

Up Next:

The Sun Devils will close out the regular season by hosting the California Golden Bears at Winkles Field-Packard Stadium at Brock Ballpark. Friday night will start at 7 PM, Saturday at 6 PM and Sunday's finale will get underway at 1 PM.
