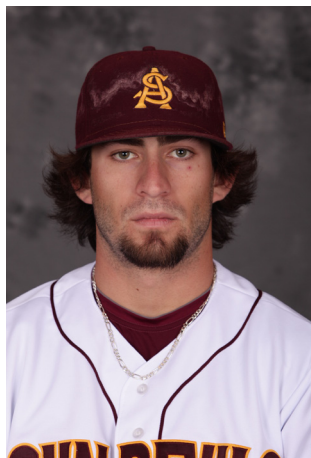


Andrew Aplin OF No. 21

Career:

- Earned Pac-12 All-Conference honorable mention recognition
- first on the team and fourth in the Pac-12 in runs scored (52)
- second on the team in home runs (6) and hits (72), and top five in batting average, slugging percentage and on base percentage
- set career highs in batting average, games played, runs, hits, RBI and walks
- recorded 20 multi-hit games and six multi-RBI games
- had a team-high 20 consecutive games in which he reached bases safely
- led the team with 230 at-bats
- selected by the New York Yankees in the 33rd round (#1,005 overall) in the 2009 Major League Baseball draft.
