Leading Off:

The 16th-ranked Arizona State baseball team closes out the 2012 regular season with a three-game Pac-12 series against No. 13 Arizona in Tucson May 25-27. First pitch on Friday and Saturday is set for 6 p.m., while the season finale will begin at 12 p.m.

Can't Make It?:

You can listen to Tim Healey and Seth Dhaenens of the Sun Devil Sports Network as all three games will be broadcast live on the Fan AM 1060. Live, up-to-the-minute stats will also be available online through gametracker, which can be accessed on the baseball weekly release on the thesundevils.com or under the online baseball schedule. All three games will also be webcast on arizonawildcats.com to all-access subscribers, which requires a subscription.

Devils vs. Arizona:

The Sun Devils are 186-118^ all-time against Arizona after the 1959 season. ASU lost the teams' previous meeting this year, 10-2, after winning the first game, 12-8. Both were played at Packard Stadium. ASU took 4-of-5 against the Wildcats last season, including 2-of-3 in a Pac-10 series at Packard Stadium and both non-conference contests in Tucson. The Devils lost the series opener, 2-5, before winning the next two, 5-1 and 8-1. In Tucson, ASU won 10-5 and 4-3. The Devils have not ended the regular season against Arizona since 2008, when UA won 2-of-3 in Tucson (W 13-6, L 3-4 (11), L 4-7). Head coach **Tim Esmay** is 8-4 against the Wildcats in his three seasons at ASU after going 3-2 in 2010, 4-1 in 2011 and 1-1 so far in 2012.

State Farm Territorial Cup Series:

This weekend marks the final three games of the five-game State Farm Territorial Cup Series between the two schools. The Sun Devils and Wildcats split the first two contests at Packard Stadium. Arizona is currently atop the standings by six points, 11.5-5.5, with just three baseball games remaining in the State Farm Territorial Cup schedule. Head Coach Tim Esmay

Tim Esmay is in his third season as head baseball coach at Arizona State after taking over his alma mater in 2010 and leading them to a Pac-10 title and a berth in the College World Series. The 2010 Pac-10 Coach of the Year, Esmay is in his 12th overall season as a coach at Arizona State. He spent 2005 to 2009 as an assistant coach, including the last three as the assistant head coach. He played two seasons as an infielder under Jim Brock in 1986 and 1987. Esmay was the head baseball coach at the University of Utah from 1997 to 2004, winning a WAC title and WAC Coach of the Year honors in 1997. In eight seasons at Utah he compiled a 213-235-1 record. Following his playing days, Esmay served as an assistant coach at Arizona State under Jim Brock from 1988 to 1990, then again in Brock's final season of 1994.

Making A Habit Of Sweeping:

Following their three-game conference sweep over Washington this past weekend, the Sun Devils have now recorded four straight Pac-12 home series sweeps. This is the first time since 1988, and only the third time in program history, that ASU has swept four consecutive Pac-12 home series' (the other came in 1981). ASU has swept four Pac-10/12 opponents in a season just seven times since 1979, but have recorded at least three series sweeps over conference opponents in each of the past six seasons. ASU has swept at least five three-game series' in eight straight seasons.

An ESpecial Coach:

This is already the second time in three seasons **head coach Tim Esmay** has orchestrated six three-game series sweeps. Since 1979, **Pat Murphy** did it four times in 15 seasons and **Jim Brock** completed the feat six times in 23 seasons.

50 Seasons Of Success:

The baseball program has secured its 50th straight 30-win season, which is the longest current streak in Div. 1 baseball. Florida State is close with 48 consecutive. The streak started with the 1963 season when ASU went 34-13. The team went 28-18 its first year in 1959, 32-13 in 1960, 36-13 in 1961 and 27-18 in 1962. The Sun Devils have never had a losing season in their 54 years, and three coaches (Jim Brock, Pat Murphy and Tim Esmay) have never won fewer than 30 games.

Making Them Earn It:

The Sun Devil pitching staff is first in the Pac-12 in walks allowed with 119 (Washington is second at 140) and right-hander **Trevor Williams** is first in the conference in walks allowed with 11. ASU is sixth in Div. I in walks allowed per nine innings at 2.26, their strikeout-to-walk ratio is tops in the Pac-12 and 14th best in Div. I at 2.88, and their WHIP is second in the nation at 1.15. **Williams** and **Brady Rodgers** have conceded a combined 26 walks and 169 hits in 208.1 innings this season, putting them at 11th (0.89) and 23rd (0.97), respectively, in Div. I in WHIP. They are the only pair of teammates ranked in the top-25 in Div. I in WHIP.

More On Williams:

Trevor Williams is one of four players in Div. I to record 11 wins this season and his streak of 40 1/3 consecutive innings without issuing a walk ended on May 19 in an 8-4 win over Washington. It started on April 6 in an 8-2 win over Oregon State and stretched across seven starts, including consecutive starts without a walk.

Welcome To Mr. Rodgers' Neighborhood:

Brady Rodgers has three complete games this season and went the distance in back-to-back games after allowing one earned run in a win over Cal on March 23 and giving up one earned run in a loss to Oregon on March 31. He began the season with 23 consecutive scoreless innings, which is sixth-best in the school history, and has allowed 28 earned runs and just 15 walks in 106.2 innings this season. He also went nine innings in an extra-innings contest against UCLA. He has a career ERA of 2.43 in 277.2 total innings and is currently second on the school's career "Best Earned Run Average" list, behind **Floyd Bannister** (74-76), who had a 1.88 ERA in 396.2 innings pitched. He moved to 18-3 with 26 earned runs and 14 walks in 168.1 innings pitched in his three-year career at Packard Stadium.

A Formidable One-Two Punch:

As of May 24, **Abe Ruiz** and **Joey DeMichele** ranked in the top 10 in the Pac-12 in slugging percentage, RBI and total bases. With a combined 126 hits, 92 RBI, 19 home runs and 227 total bases, the duo accounts for just under a third of the team's RBI and

Sun Devil Of The Week:

Shortstop **Deven Marrero** hit .667 (8-for-12) with five RBI and four runs scored in a three-game Pac-12 series sweep over Washington. Half of his hits were extra-base knocks, including two doubles in Friday's 7-5 win, and he finished the weekend with a .529 on-base percentage and a .813 slugging percentage. He collected three hits, including an RBI single, and scored two runs in Saturday's 8-4 win. He went 3-for-4 from the plate, including a bases-clearing three-run double in the sixth inning to put ASU ahead by two runs, and fell a home run short of the cycle in Sunday's 9-6 win. He also scored a pair of runs, including his 100th career run scored at ASU.

just under half of the team's home runs, and more than a fourth of the team's total bases and just under a fourth of the team's hits.

Separating From The Pac On The Mound:

As of May 24, **Williams** and **Rodgers** rank second and sixth, respectively, in the conference in ERA, with **Williams** at 1.86 and **Rodgers** at 2.36. **Rodgers** is also second in innings pitched at 106.2, while **Williams** is sixth at 101.2 and is the only 11-game winner in the conference. Right-hander **Jake Barrett** is second in games finished at 29, third in saves with 11 and fifth in appearances with 29.

Doing The Extra (Base) Work:

The Sun Devils are tied for first in the Pac-12 in slugging percentage at .444 behind the bats of Abe Ruiz, Joey DeMichele, Deven Marrero and Andrew Aplin. Ruiz is tied for first in the conference in home runs at 13 and third in double at 17, while DeMichele is tied for tops in triples at seven, followed by Marrero in third with five and Aplin in sixth with four. DeMichele (114) and Ruiz (113) are fifth and sixth, respectively, in total bases.

A Deep Staff:

Arizona State has used 15 pitchers through 53 games of the season. The Devils only used 11 all season last year. Right-hander **Mark Lambson**, who appeared in 10 games and threw 23.2 innings in 2011, has not made an appearance yet this season. Eight pitchers have also made at least one start this season and 11 have registered either a win or a loss.

Joining The Century Club:

Head coach **Tim Esmay** recorded his 100th win as head coach at ASU with the Devils' 11-2 win over UC Riverside on Feb. 26. **Coach Esmay** collected 52 wins in his first season at the helm of the Devils en route to a 2010 Pac-10 Championship, a berth in the College World Series and Pac-10 Coach of the Year honors. He followed that up with 43 victories in 2011 and led the Devils to a spot in an NCAA Super Regional. He has five wins through six games this season, giving him a .775 winning percentage through 2-plus years in Tempe.

Washington Recap:

The Sun Devils continued their dominance at home with a three-game series sweep against Pac-12 conference opponent Washington over the weekend. ASU has won 13 consecutive Pac-12 games at Packard Stadium and finished the home season with a 23-6 record, including 14-1 in conference play. **Trevor Allen** drove in the go-ahead run in the sixth inning and the insurance run in the eighth inning, and **Ruiz** hit his 13th home run of the year to provide run support for **Brady Rodgers**, who earned the win in Friday's 7-5 win. **Beau Maggi** hit his first career collegiate home run and **Trevor Williams** recorded his NCAA-best 11th win in an 8-4 victory on Saturday. Seniors **Abe Ruiz** and **Joseph Lopez**, and graduate student **Adrian Gomez** were honored on the field as part of Senior Day prior to ASU's 9-6 win in Sunday's game.

Legacy Devils:

The 2012 Sun Devil team features four student-athletes with unique connections to Arizona State. Sophomore **Trevor Allen** is the son of **Jamie Allen**, who played three seasons at ASU, including the 1977 National Championship year. **Jamie** was a lifetime .333 hitter at ASU and he also went 6-2 on the mound. He was a two-time All-WAC team member and was a member of the 1977 All-College World Series team. Freshman INF/OF **Jake Wakamatsu** also has Maroon and Gold in his blood, as his father **Don** was a four-year letterwinner for Arizona State from 1982 to 1985. A three-year starter at catcher, **Don** was a three-time First Team All-Pac-10 selection and was a member of two Pac-10 Championships teams and twice played in the College World Series. **Don** played for the Chicago White Sox in 1991 and became the first

He is currently the bench coach of the Toronto Blue Jays. Joining **Wakamatsu** and **Allen** as Legacy Devils are redshirt freshman **Tucker Esmay** and sophomore **Michael Benjamin**. Esmay is the son of head coach **Tim Esmay** and **Benjamin** is the son of assistant coach **Mike Benjamin**. The elder **Esmay** and **Benjamin** were teammates on the 1986 and 1987 Sun Devils.

Notable Connections:

Freshman LHP **Brandon Bonilla's** father Bobby played 16 seasons in the Major Leagues (1986-2001) for eight different teams, including the Chicago White Sox, New York Mets, Los Angeles Dodgers, Atlanta Braves and St. Louis Cardinals. He was a six-time All-Star and won the 1997 World Series as a member of the Florida Marlins. **Brandon** is also the godson of former Sun Devil legend and MLB Home Run King **Barry Bonds**, who was teammates with his father on the Pittsburgh Pirates... Fellow freshman INF **Drew Stankiewicz's** father Andy also played in the Major Leagues, spending seven seasons with the New York Yankees, Houston Astros, Montreal Expos and Arizona Diamondbacks. Andy was an assistant coach at Arizona State from 2007-09, collecting two Pac-10 titles and a trip to the 2009 College World Series, and is currently the head baseball coach at Grand Canyon University... Redshirt sophomore catcher **Beau Maggi** is the brother of **Drew Maggi**, who starred at ASU in 2009 and 2010... Sophomore RHP **Mark Lambson** is the brother of **Mitchell Lambson**, who made 102 appearances for ASU from 2009-11, tied for the second most in school history... Sophomore shortstop **Deven Marrero** is the cousin of Chris Marrero, a first baseman for the Washington Nationals.

2012 Preseason Honors:

Deven Marrero was the sole unanimous First Team selection in Baseball America's Preseason All-American poll and was one of just six repeat recipients (Second Team in 2011). He was also named a Preseason First Team All-American by Collegiate Baseball, CollegeBaseballInsider.com, Perfect Game and College Baseball Daily, and earned a spot on College Sports Madness' Second Team. He was joined on both NCBWA's Third Team and College Sports Madness' All-Conference First Team by **Brady Rodgers** and **Joey DeMichele**, who were both also named honorable mentions by CollegeBaseballInsider.com. **Rodgers** was selected to the Second Team by Collegiate Baseball and was a Third Team choice by both Baseball America and Perfect Game, while **DeMichele** was named to Perfect Game's Second Team and College Sports Madness' Fourth Team. **Jake Barrett** was a Second Team pick by Baseball America. Head coach **Tim Esmay** was selected as the Pac-12 Coach of the Year by College Sports Madness.

2011 Pac-10 Awards:

Arizona State, after finishing second in the Pac-10, took home a litany of conference accolades, headlined by Defensive Player of the Year recipient **Deven Marrero**. ASU had five First Team All-Pac-10 performers: **Austin Barnes**, **Joey DeMichele**, **Marrero**, **Johnny Ruettiger** and **Riccio Torrez**. **Alex Blackford**, **Kramer Champlin**, **Mitchell Lambson**, **Zack MacPhee**, **Matt Newman**, **Brady Rodgers**, **Trevor Williams** and **Zach Wilson** all earned Honorable Mentions. **DeMichele** joined **Andy Workman** on the Academic All-Pac-10 first team. **Marrero** and **Torrez** earned a spot on the Second Team, and



Xorge Carrillo and **Newman** were Honorable Mentions.

Inter-Conference Battles:

In addition to facing the schools in the Pac-12, which now includes Utah, the Devils will also take on teams from nine different conferences in 2011. ASU will face three teams from the Big West (Long Beach State, Cal State Fullerton, UC Riverside), two from the Mid-American (Northern Illinois, Western Michigan), two from the West Coast (Gonzaga, Saint Mary's) and one each from the Atlantic 10 (Saint Louis), Big 12 (Texas Tech), Big South (Winthrop), Great West (Utah Valley), Mountain West (New Mexico) and Western Athletic (UNLV).

Feeling The Draft:

There are 13 members of the 2012 Sun Devils who have had their name called during the annual Major League Baseball draft, including five freshmen. Everyone except for **Max Rossiter**, who was drafted following two successful seasons at Central Arizona College, was selected after high school but opted to attend ASU.

Pac-12 Picks:

Arizona State was picked to finish third in the 2012 Preseason Pac-10 Coaches' Poll and received one first-place vote. Stanford was picked to finish first, receiving 10 first-place votes, with Arizona in second.

Tough Schedule:

The Sun Devils will play 19 games this season against teams ranked in the Preseason Top 30, including 10 at Packard Stadium and nine on the road. ASU will host a three-game series against both No. 26 Cal (March 23-25) and No. 22 Oregon State (April 5-7), and will welcome No. 18 Arizona for two separate single-game sets on April 17 and May 16, respectively. No. 19 Cal State Fullerton will also come to Tempe for a two-game tilt March 27-28. The Devils travel to Los Angeles March 16-18 to face No. 20 UCLA and will play No. 2 Stanford in Palo Alto, Calif., April 20-22. They finish the season with a three-game series against the Wildcats in Tucson, Ariz., May 25-27.
