The 16th-ranked Arizona State baseball team hosts Washington for its final three home games of the season Friday-Sunday at Packard Stadium. They face the Huskies at 6:.30 p.m. on Friday and Saturday night, and at 12:30 p.m. on Sunday.

Senior Day will be held prior to the final home game of the season on Sunday, May 20. Seniors Abe Ruiz and Joseph Lopez, as well as graduate student Adrian Gomez will be honored on the field.

Devils vs. Washington:

The Sun Devils are 28-14[^] all-time against Washington, with ASU taking two-of-three from the Huskies in last year's meeting in Seattle (W 6-0, W 12-0, L 0-3). ASU also won two-ofthree in the previous three-game series at Packard Stadium in 2010 (W 10-2, L 4-9, W 10-4). The last the Devils swept the series was in Seattle in 2009 (W 3-1, W 12-1, W 6-2).

50 Seasons Of Success:

The baseball program secured its 50th straight 30-win season over the weekend, which is the longest current streak in Div. 1 baseball. Florida State is close with 48 consecutive. The streak started with the 1963 season when ASU went 34-13. The team went 28-18 its first year in 1959, 32-13 in 1960, 36-13 in 1961 and 27-18 in 1962. The Sun Devils have never had a losing season in their 54 years, and three coaches (Jim Brock, Pat Murphy and Tim Esmay) have never won less than 30 games.

<u>Head Coach</u> Tim Esmay

Tim Esmay is in his third season as head baseball coach at Arizona State after taking over his alma mater in 2010 and leading them to a Pac-10 title and a berth in the College World Series. The 2010 Pac-10 Coach of the Year. Esmay is in his 12th overall season as a coach at Arizona State. He spent 2005 to 2009 as an assistant coach, including the last three as the assistant head coach. He played two seasons as an infielder under Jim Brock in 1986 and 1987. Esmay was the head baseball coach at the University of Utah from 1997 to 2004, winning a WAC title and WAC Coach of the Year honors in 1997. In eight seasons at Utah he compiled a 213-235-1 record. Following his playing days, Esmay served as an assistant coach at Arizona State under Jim Brock from 1988 to 1990, then again in Brock's final season of 1994.

Making A Habit Of Sweeping:

Following their three-game sweep over Gonzaga this past weekend, the Sun Devils have now swept at least five three-game series' in eight straight seasons. They have recorded three straight Pac-12 home series sweeps and have recorded at least three series sweeps over conference opponents in each of the past six seasons.

Making Them Earn It:

The Sun Devil pitching staff is first in the Pac-12 in walks allowed with 113 (Washington is second at 125) and right-hander **Trevor Williams** is first in the conference in walks allowed with 10. ASU is third in Div. I in walks allowed per nine innings at 2.16, their strikeout-to-walk ratio is tops in the Pac-12 and eighth-best in Div. I at 3.06, and their WHIP is second in the nation at 1.13. **Williams** and **Brady Rodgers** have conceded a combined 24 walks and 155 hits in 193.1 innings this season, putting them at 14th (0.9) and 24th (0.95), respectively, in Div. I in WHIP. They are the only pair of teammates ranked in the top-30 in Div. 1 in WHIP.

A Formidable One-Two Punch:

As of May 17, **Abe Ruiz** and **Joey DeMichele** ranked in the top 10 in the Pac-12 in slugging percentage, RBI and total bases. With a combined 119 hits, 83 RBI, 18 home runs and 215 total bases, the duo accounts for just under a third of the team's RBI and just under half of the team's home runs, and more than a fourth of the team's total bases and just under a fourth of the team's hits.

Separating From The Pac (On The Mound):

Williams and Rodgers rank second and fourth, respectively, in the conference in ERA, with Williams at 1.83 and Rodgers at 2.17. Rodgers is also second in innings pitched at 99.2, while Williams is sixth at 93.2 and is the only 10-game winner in the conference. Right-hander Jake Barrett is second in games finished at 27 and third in saves with 10.

He Doesn't See Three Strikes Often:

Andrew Aplin is ninth in Div. 1 in toughest to strikeout with a strikeout every 20.5 at-bats and is the only Pac-12 player ranked in the top 50. He has struck out just 11 times in 206 at-bats and has not struck out in 101 consecutive plate appearances in conference play, dating back to March 16 at UCLA. **Aplin** has struck out just 37 times in his three-year career at ASU.

Welcome To Mr. Rodgers' Neighborhood:

Rodgers has three complete games this season and went the distance in back-to-back games after allowing one earned run in a win over Cal on March 23 and giving up one earned run in a loss to Oregon on March 31. He began the season with 23 consecutive scoreless innings, which is sixth-best in the school history, and has allowed 24 earned runs and just 14 walks in 99.2 innings this season. He also went nine innings in an extra-innings contest against UCLA. He has a career ERA of 2.36 in 270.2 total innings and is currently second on the school's career "Best Earned Run Average" list, behind **Floyd Bannister** (74-76), who had a 1.88 ERA in 396.2 innings pitched.

A Deen Staff:

Arizona State has used 15 pitchers through 50 games of the season. The Devils only used 11 all season last year. Right-hander **Mark Lambson**, who appeared in 10 games and threw 23.2 innings in 2011, has not made an appearance yet this season. Eight pitchers have also made at least one start this season and 11 have registered either a win or a loss.

Joining The Century Club:

Head coach Tim Esmay recorded his 100th win as head coach at ASU with the Devils' 11-2 win over UC Riverside on Feb. 26. Coach Esmay collected 52 wins in his first season at the helm of the Devils en route to a 2010 Pac-10 Championship, a berth in the College World Series and Pac-10 Coach of the Year honors. He followed that up with 43 victories in 2011 and led the Devils to a spot in an NCAA Super Regional. He has five wins through six games this season, giving him a .775 winning percentage through 2-plus years in Tempe.

Up Next:

The Sun Devils end the 2012 season with a three-game Pac-12 series against Arizona in Tucson May 25-27. The games on May 25 and 26 are set for 6 p.m., while the one on May 27 will start at 12 p.m.

Gonzaga/Arizona Recap:

The team swept Gonzaga in a three-game non-conference road series over the weekend and secured its 50th straight 30-win season with a 4-2 win on Friday night. Right-hander Trevor Williams became the first 10-game winner in the Pac-12 as the Sun Devils hit three home runs in a 10-1 win on Saturday night. Michael Benjamin added a career-high five RBI in the victory. Freshman Nathaniel Causey went 3-for-3 with a go-ahead two-run double to give ASU a 3-1 win in the series finale.

Sun Devil fans raised \$3,447 for the **Cory Hahn** Foundation in the second "Pass The Bucket Night, but ASU lost 10-2, tying the five-game baseball State Farm Territorial Cup Series at one game apiece. A solo home to right field by Abe Ruiz and three consecutive base hits, including an RBI single by **Beau Maggi**, in the ninth inning gave the Sun Devils their only two runs of the game. The Wildcats took a three-run lead in the first inning off starting right-hander Darin Gillies and never relinquished the advantage.

Legacy Devils:

The 2012 Sun Devil team features four student-athletes with unique connections to Arizona State. Sophomore Trever Allen is the son of Jamie Allen, who played three seasons at ASU, including the 1977 National Championship year. Jamie was a lifetime .333 hitter at ASU and he also went 6-2 on the mound. He was a two-time All-WAC team member and was a member of the 1977 All-College World Series team. Freshman INF/OF Jake Wakamatsu also has Maroon and Gold in his blood, as his father **Don** was a four-year letterwinner for Arizona State from 1982 to 1985. A three-year starter at catcher, **Don** was a three-time First Team All-Pac-10 selection and was a member of two Pac-10 Championships teams and twice played in the College World Series. **Don** played for the Chicago White Sox in 1991 and became the first former Sun Devil baseball player to be named a Major League Baseball manager when he was hired by the Seattle Mariners prior to the 2009 season. He is currently the bench coach of the Toronto Blue Jays. Joining Wakamatsu and Allen as Legacy Devils are redshirt freshman Tucker Esmay and sophomore Michael Benjamin. Esmay is the son of head coach Tim Esmay and Benjamin is the son of assistant coach Mike Benjamin. The elder Esmay and Benjamin were teammates on the 1986 and 1987 Sun Devils.

Notable Connections:

Freshman LHP Brandon Bonilla's father Bobby played 16 seasons in the Major Leagues (1986-2001) for eight different teams, including the Chicago White Sox, New York Mets, Los Angeles Dodgers, Atlanta Braves and St. Louis Cardinals. He was a six-time All-Star and won the 1997 World Series as a member of the Florida Marlins. **Brandon** is also the godson of former Sun Devil legend and MLB Home Run King Barry Bonds, who was teammates with his father on the Pittsburgh Pirates...Fellow freshman INF Drew Stankiewicz's father Andy also played in the Major Leagues, spending seven seasons with the New York Yankees,

Andy was an assistant coach at Arizona State from 2007-09, collecting two Pac-10 titles and a trip to the 2009 College World Series, and is currently the head baseball coach at Grand Canyon University...Redshirt sophomore catcher **Beau Maggi** is the brother of **Drew Maggi**, who starred at ASU in 2009 and 2010...Sophomore RHP Mark Lambson is the brother of **Mitchell Lambson**, who made 102 appearances for ASU from 2009-11, tied for the second most in school history...Sophomore shortstop **Deven Marrero** is the cousin of Chris Marrero, a first baseman for the Washington Nationals.

2012 Preseason Honors:

Deven Marrero was the sole unanimous First Team selection in Baseball America's Preseason All-American poll and was one of just six repeat recipients (Second Team in 2011). He was also named a Preseason First Team All-American by Collegiate Baseball, CollegeBaseballInsider.com, Perfect Game and College Baseball Daily, and earned a spot on College Sports Madness' Second Team. He was joined on both NCBWA's Third Team and College Sports Madness' All-Conference First Team by **Brady Rodgers** and **Joey DeMichele**, who were both also named honorable mentions by CollegeBaseballInsider. com. **Rodgers** was selected to the Second Team by Collegiate Baseball and was a Third Team choice by both Baseball America and Perfect Game, while **DeMichele** was named to Perfect Game's Second Team and College Sports Madness' Fourth Team. **Jake Barrett** was a Second Team pick by Baseball America. Head coach **Tim Esmay** was selected as the Pac-12 Coach of the Year by College Sports Madness.

2011 Pac-10 Awards:

Arizona State, after finishing second in the Pac-10, took home a litany of conference accolades, headlined by Defensive Player of the Year recipient **Deven Marrero**. ASU had five First Team All-Pac-10 performers: **Austin Barnes**, **Joey DeMichele**, **Marrero**, **Johnny Ruettiger and Riccio Torrez**. **Alex Blackford**, **Kramer Champlin**, **Mitchell Lambson**, **Zack MacPhee**, **Matt Newman**, **Brady Rodgers**, **Trevor Williams** and **Zach Wilson** all earned Honorable Mentions. **DeMichele** joined **Andy Workman** on the Academic All-Pac-10 first team. **Marrero** and **Torrez** earned a spot on the Second Team, and **Xorge Carrillo** and **Newman** were Honorable Mentions.

Inter-Conference Battles:

In addition to facing the schools in the Pac-12, which now includes Utah, the Devils will also take on teams from nine different conferences in 2011. ASU will face three teams from the Big West (Long Beach State, Cal State Fullerton, UC Riverside), two from the Mid-American (Northern Illinois, Western Michigan), two from the West Coast (Gonzaga, Saint Mary's) and one each from the Atlantic 10 (Saint Louis), Big 12 (Texas Tech), Big South (Winthrop), Great West (Utah Valley), Mountain West (New Mexico) and Western Athletic (UNLV).

Feeling The Draft:

There are 13 members of the 2012 Sun Devils who have had their name called during the annual Major League Baseball draft, including five freshmen. Everyone except for **Max Rossiter**, who was drafted following two successful seasons at Central Arizona College, was selected after high school but opted to





attend ASU.

Pac-12 Picks:

Arizona State was picked to finish third in the 2012 Preseason Pac-10 Coaches' Poll and received one first-place vote. Stanford was picked to finish first, receiving 10 first-place votes, with Arizona in second.

Tough Schedule:

The Sun Devils will play 19 games this season against teams ranked in the Preseason Top 30, including 10 at Packard Stadium and nine on the road. ASU will host a three-game series against both No. 26 Cal (March 23-25) and No. 22 Oregon State (April 5-7), and will welcome No. 18 Arizona for two separate single-game sets on April 17 and May 16, respectively. No. 19 Cal State Fullerton will also come to Tempe for a two-game tilt March 27-28. The Devils travel to Los Angeles March 16-18 to face No. 20 UCLA and will play No. 2 Stanford in Palo Alto, Calif., April 20-22. They finish the season with a three-game series against the Wildcats in Tucson, Ariz., May 25-27.
