### Leading Off:

The 24th-ranked Sun Devils head to Surprise, Ariz., for the 11th annual Coca-Cola Classic at Surprise Stadium. The Sun Devils will play No. 2 Arkansas twice on Feb. 28 and March 2, respectively, and will also face Pacific on March 1 and Gonzaga on March 3. All four games for the Sun Devils will follow a Major League Spring Training game and will begin at approximately 4 p.m. (MT) or 45 minutes after the conclusion of the preceding Spring Training game.

### Can't Make It?:

The Fan AM 1060 will be broadcasting its first game of the season on Saturday against Arkansas, with Jeff Munn and Seth Dhaenens on the call. The audio will be available both on the radio and online through thesundevils.com all-access player. Blaze radio will be broadcasting the other three games online. Fans can also get live updates from the team's Twitter account @ASU\_Baseball, and up-to-the-minute stats will also be available online with gametracker on thesundevils.com.

### Devils vs. Arkansas and the SEC:

The Sun Devils have won six of the teams' previous nine meetings, including once in the 2011 Regional in Tempe and twice at the 2010 Super Regional in Tempe, both of which went 12 innings. The Devils are 37-22-1^ all-time against the SEC.

### Devils vs. Gonzaga and the WCC:

ASU is 15-2^ all-time against Gonzaga after completing a three-game sweep last season in Spokane. Gonzaga is 8-7 at the Coca-Cola Classic, including 2-2 against ASU (W-2003, 07; L-2005, 06). The Devils are 138-29^ all-time against the West Coast Conference.

### Devils vs. Pacific and the Big West:

The Sun Devils have never faced Pacific and are 202-89^ all-time against the Big West.

## Head Coach Tim Esmay

Tim Esmay is in his fourth season as head baseball coach at Arizona State after taking over his alma mater in 2010 and leading them to a Pac-10 title and a berth in the College World Series. The 2010 Pac-10 Coach of the Year, Esmay is in his 13th overall season as a coach at Arizona State. He spent 2005 to 2009 as an assistant coach, including the last three as the assistant head coach. He played two seasons as an infielder under Jim Brock in 1986 and 1987. Esmay was the head baseball coach at the University of Utah from 1997 to 2004, winning a WAC title and WAC Coach of the Year honors in 1997. In eight seasons at Utah he compiled a 213-235-1 record. Following his playing days, Esmay served as an assistant coach at Arizona State under Jim Brock from 1988 to 1990, then again in Brock's final season of 1994.

## Quick Hits:

- Head coach **Tim Esmay** is two wins away from career win 350, and is 15 wins away from his 150th ASU win
- Coach **Esmay** is 57-13, including a perfect 22-0 in 2010, all-time against non-conference opponents since he was hired prior to the 2010 season
- ASU won their second series of the season and have now won 14 consecutive series in February, including all eight under coach **Esmay**
- ASU pitchers combined to strike out 29 batters over the weekend against Tennessee
- James McDonald** has a team-high six-game hitting streak
- Three Devils (**McDonald**, **Kasey Coffman** and **Max Rossiter**) have all reached base in six consecutive games
- Freshman LHP **Brett Lilek** will make his first career start against No. 2 Arkansas on Thursday
- Preseason All-America pitchers **Trevor Williams** (ASU), Ryne **Stanek** (Arkansas) and **Marco Gonzales** (Gonzaga) were teammates on Team USA this past summer

## Pac-12 Player of the Week:

Redshirt sophomore **Trevor Allen** led the Sun Devils to a pair of victories on the road at Tennessee with five RBI, four hits, four runs scored and two home runs. With a .833 slugging percentage, he accounted for seven of ASU's 11 runs over the weekend, and hit a three-run home run in game one to power ASU to a series-opening victory, and with ASU down one in game three, he battled through a 10-pitch at-bat to hit a two-run home run and put ASU ahead for good. It was Allen's first career Pac-12 Player of the Week honor and ASU's Conference-leading 102nd all-time selection.

## Growing Up Fast:

ASU has played 12 true freshmen through six games, including eight position players and four pitchers. Six freshmen have made starts, including DH **RJ Ybarra** (2), center fielder **Johnny Sewald** (2), 1B **David Graybill** (2), 3B **Dalton DiNatale**, DH **Tony DiMartino** and shortstop **Jordan Aboites**. Seven freshmen have collected base hits, and four have recorded RBI. A quartet of freshmen pitchers have combined to allow three runs on 10 hits with 21 strikeouts in 25 innings of relief, including LHP **Ryan Kellogg**, who is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in nine innings, RHP **Ryan Burr**, who has thrown five scoreless innings, LHP **Brett Lilek** and RHP **Eric Melbostad**.

## Offering Relief:

Through six games, the bullpen has allowed 15 hits and five earned runs in 28.2 innings of work. Relievers have given up just five extra-base hits (four doubles and a triple) and earned wins against B-CU on Feb. 15 and 16. LHP **Matt Dunber** and Lilek have led the way with three appearances each, while Lilek and RHP **Alex Blackford** have notched the most relief innings at eight and 6.2, respectively.

## New Faces On The Bases And In The Field:

Junior **James McDonald** will begin the 2012 season at second base after spending most of last season as the team's designated hitter and outfielder. There will be a new shortstop for the first time in three seasons as sophomore **Drew Stankiewicz** takes the place of departed three-year starter **Deven Marrero**. Sophomore **Rouric Bridgewater** will replace departed senior **Abe Ruiz**. In the outfield, junior **Kasey Coffman** moves over from right to center to replace departed two-year starter **Andrew Aplin**, while RS-sophomore **Trevor Allen**, will take over Coffman's spot in right. Sophomore **Jake Peevyhouse** will take over left field.

## Sun Devils On TV:

### Year Of The Snake:

In his three seasons at ASU, pitching coach **Ken "Snake" Knutson** has guided the pitching staff to two of the lowest single-season ERA marks in the Aluminum Bat Era in school history. His 2012 staff ranks third in ASU annals with a 3.19 season ERA, while his 2011 edition is fourth with a 3.22 ERA. The all-time low is 2.35 set in 1975, followed by a 2.90 set in 2009.

### Who's Back:

The Sun Devils welcome back 20 returners, headlined by preseason All-American RHP **Trevor Williams**. Also returning are 2011 All-Pac-10 Honorable Mention recipients INF **James McDonald** and C **Max Rossiter**. Other position players coming back include OF **Trevor Allen**, INF **Michael Benjamin**, INF **Kyle Bilbrey**, INF **Rouric Bridgewater**, C **Nate Causey**, OF **Kasey Coffman**, INF **Tucker Esmay**, OF **Jake Peevyhouse** and INF **Drew Stankiewicz**. Other pitchers returning include RHP **Alex Blackford**, LHP **Matt Dunbar**, RHP **Darin Gillies**, RHP **Mark Lambson**, RHP **Zak Miller**, RHP **Josh McAlister**, LHP **Adam McCreery** and RHP **Billy Young**.

### Who's New:

Arizona State welcomes 14 newcomers, all true freshmen, to Tempe as they begin their Sun Devil careers. Six of these freshmen were selected in the 2012 MLB Draft. The freshmen class features four local products, including INF **Emilio Torrez** (Phoenix/Brophy Prep), OF/RHP **David Graybill** (Phoenix/Brophy Prep), OF **Christopher Beall** (Phoenix/Brophy Prep) and RHP **Eric Melbostad** (Scottsdale/Pinnacle). INF **Dalton DiNatale** (Parkland, Fla.), C **RJ Ybarra** (Riverside, Calif.), **Johnny Sewald** (Las Vegas, Nev.), **Cullen O'Dwyer** (Albuquerque, N.M.), **Jordan Aboites** (Long Beach, Calif.), **Brett Lilek** (South Holland, Ill.), **Trey Kamachi** (Kapolei, Hawaii), **Ryan Burr** (Highlands Ranch, Colo.), **Tony DiMartino** (Danville, Calif.) and LHP **Ryan Kellogg** (Whitby, Ontario).

### No. 34 On The Stirrups - The Cory Hahn Story:

The Sun Devils wear the No. 34 on their stirrups to honor former student-athlete and current student coach Cory Hahn, who was paralyzed from the chest down sliding into second base in the third game of his college career in 2011. Hahn was California's Mr. Baseball and Orange County Player of the Year, led Mater Dei to a CIF title, played on the United States' first gold medal 18U team alongside Bryce Harper and Manny Machado, and was a 26th round pick by the San Diego Padres in the 2010 MLB Draft.

### An ESpecial Coach:

In his three seasons at the helm of the Sun Devil baseball team, head coach **Tim Esmay** has guided ASU to the highest regular-season winning percentage in the Pac-12 since 2010. His record of 131-48 (.732) is ahead of UCLA (128-55, .699) and Oregon State (111-61, .645). He is the second-fastest coach in ASU history to reach 100 wins after passing the century mark this past season in an 11-2 win over UC Riverside on Feb. 26, and has the second-highest winning percentage among ASU head coaches at the 100-win mark (100-29, .775). Coach Esmay has posted a winning record in the 65 games he has played against top-25 teams, and also has a winning record against four of the top teams in the Pac-12, including Arizona, Oregon State, Oregon and UCLA.

### Today's Devils Are Tomorrow's Major Leaguers:

Arizona State produced an NCAA-best 10 selections in the 2012 MLB First-Year Player Draft, including five in the first five rounds for the first time in program history since 1984. Thirty-one Sun Devils have been taken in the MLB Draft in coach Esmay's three seasons at ASU, which is the most of any Div. I school in that time span. ASU's 101 Major Leaguers since 1959 is the most in the nation.

### 50 Seasons Of Success:

The baseball program secured its 50th straight 30-win season, which is the longest current streak in Div. I baseball. Florida State is close with 48 consecutive. The streak started with the 1963 season when ASU went 34-13.

### Legacy Devils:

The 2013 Sun Devil team features four student-athletes whose fathers also played baseball at Arizona State. Redshirt sophomore **Trevor Allen** is the son of **Jamie Allen**, who played three seasons at ASU, including the 1977 National Championship year. Jamie was a lifetime .333 hitter at ASU and he also went 6-2 on the mound. A two-time All-WAC honoree and a member of the 1977 All-College World Series team, Jamie spent one season in the MLB with the Seattle Mariners ... Freshman **David Graybill** is a third-generation Sun Devil. His grandfather, **Dave Graybill Sr.**, is one of only seven three-sport letterman in ASU school history after playing baseball, football and basketball during the mid-50s, and his father, **Dave Graybill Jr.**, starred as a pitcher for the baseball team from 1982-84...redshirt sophomore **Tucker Esmay** is the son of head coach **Tim Esmay**...junior **Michael Benjamin** is the son of assistant coach **Mike Benjamin**. The elder Esmay and Benjamin were teammates on the 1986 and 1987 Sun Devils.

### Notable Connections:

Freshman **Emilio Torrez** is the younger brother of Raoul and Riccio, who both played for the Sun Devils and became the first set of brothers to start alongside one another in school history (sixth all-time to suit for ASU at the same time). **Raoul** was an infielder from 2007-2010 and was drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 21st round of the 2010 MLB draft. **Riccio** was an infielder from 2009-2011 and was drafted by the Tampa Bay Rays in the fourth round of the 2011 MLB draft...Sophomore **Drew Stankiewicz's** father Andy also played in the Major Leagues, spending seven seasons with the New York Yankees, Houston Astros, Montreal Expos and Arizona Diamondbacks. **Andy** was an assistant coach at Arizona State from 2007-09, collecting two Pac-10 titles and a trip to the 2009 College World Series, and is currently the head baseball coach at Grand Canyon University...Fellow sophomore **Nate Causey** is the cousin of current New Mexico All-American infielder **DJ Peterson**...Redshirt sophomore **Mark Lambson** is the brother of **Mitchell**, who made 102 appearances for ASU from 2009-11, tied for the second most in school history.

### Summer Lovin':

Fourteen members of the 2013 Arizona State baseball team participated in summer collegiate baseball this past summer, including **Trevor Williams**, who competed for Team USA and the Cotuit Kettleers of the Cape Cod League. Other Devils who played in summer leagues include **Adam McCreery**, also on the Cotuit Kettleers; **Trevor Allen**, **Michael Benjamin** and **Drew Stankiewicz** on the Maknato Moondogs, Northwoods League; **Kasey Coffman** and **James McDonald** on the Newport Gulls, New England Collegiate; **Tucker Esmay**, **Darin Gillies** and **Josh McAlister** on the Bend Elks, West Coast; **Rouric Bridgewater**, **Nate Causey** and **Jake Peevyhouse** on the Bellingham Bells, West Coast; and **Kyle Bilbrey** on Team Vegas Baseball Club, California Collegiate.

### 2012 Pac-12 Awards:

Arizona State had nine All-Pac-12 honorees, which was the most total selections in the conference. They had four first team performers in **Joey DeMichele**, **Deven Marrero**, **Brady Rodgers** and **Trevor Williams** (returning). **Andrew Aplin**, **Jake Barrett**, **James McDonald** (returning), **Max Rossiter** (returning) and **Abe Ruiz** all earned Honorable Mentions. Five Devils were named to the Academic All-Pac-12 team, including **Marrero** (second team), and honorable mentions **Kasey Coffman** (returning), **DeMichele**, **Joseph Lopez** and **Rossiter**. A total of four current Devils have earned all-conference honors and **Williams** is the sole two-time honoree as **Alex Blackford** (returning) and **Williams** both earned all-conference recognition in 2011.

### 2012 All-Americans:

**Brady Rodgers** and **Trevor Williams** both earned second team honors from Collegiate Baseball and took home third team honors from the NCBWA. **Abe Ruiz** was named to the Collegiate Baseball Third Team.

### Inter-Conference Battles:

In addition to facing the schools in the Pac-12, the Devils will also take on teams from 10 different conferences in 2013. ASU will face two each from the Mid-American (Northern Illinois, Western Michigan), Mountain West (New Mexico, Pacific), SEC





(Arkansas, Tennessee), and West Coast (BYU, Gonzaga), and one each from the Big 12 (Texas Tech), Big West (Long Beach State), Mid-Eastern Athletic (Bethune-Cookman), Missouri Valley (Wichita State), The Summit (Valparaiso) and Western Athletic (UNLV).

### Feeling The Draft:

There are 12 members of the 2013 Sun Devils who have had their name called during the annual Major League Baseball draft, including six freshmen. Everyone except for **Max Rossiter**, who was drafted (for the second time) but returned to ASU for his senior year, was selected after high school but opted to attend ASU. There were 13 on last year's team.

### Pac-12 Picks:

Arizona State was picked to finish sixth in the 2012 Preseason Pac-10 Coaches' Poll. Stanford was picked to finish first, receiving 10 five-place votes, with UCLA in second and Oregon State in third. ASU was also picked to finish sixth in the conference by Perfect Game and Baseball America.

### Tough Schedule:

The Sun Devils will play 19 games this season against teams ranked in the Preseason Top 20, including 12 at Packard Stadium, five on the road and two at a neutral site. ASU's first ranked opponent is No. 1 Arkansas, which they face twice in the Coca-Cola Classic in Surprise, Ariz. Feb. 28-March 3, both of which will be preceded by a Cactus League Spring Training game. The Sun Devils host a three-game series against four ranked Pac-12 opponents at Packard Stadium, including three in the top 10, as they take on No. 5 UCLA (March 28-30), No. 6 Oregon (April 4-7), No. 9 Stanford (May 3-5) and No. 18 Arizona (May 17-19). ASU goes to Corvallis, Ore., March 22-24 to play No. 10 Oregon State, and they also travel to Tucson for two separate non-conference single-game sets against the Wildcats on April 16 and April 30, respectively.

Arizona State returns to Packard Stadium to host a three-game series against Long Beach State March 8-10. First pitch is at 6:30 p.m. (MT) on Friday and Saturday, and at 12:30 (PT) on Sunday. Friday and Sunday's games will be Internet-only broadcasts and can be found on thesundevils.com.

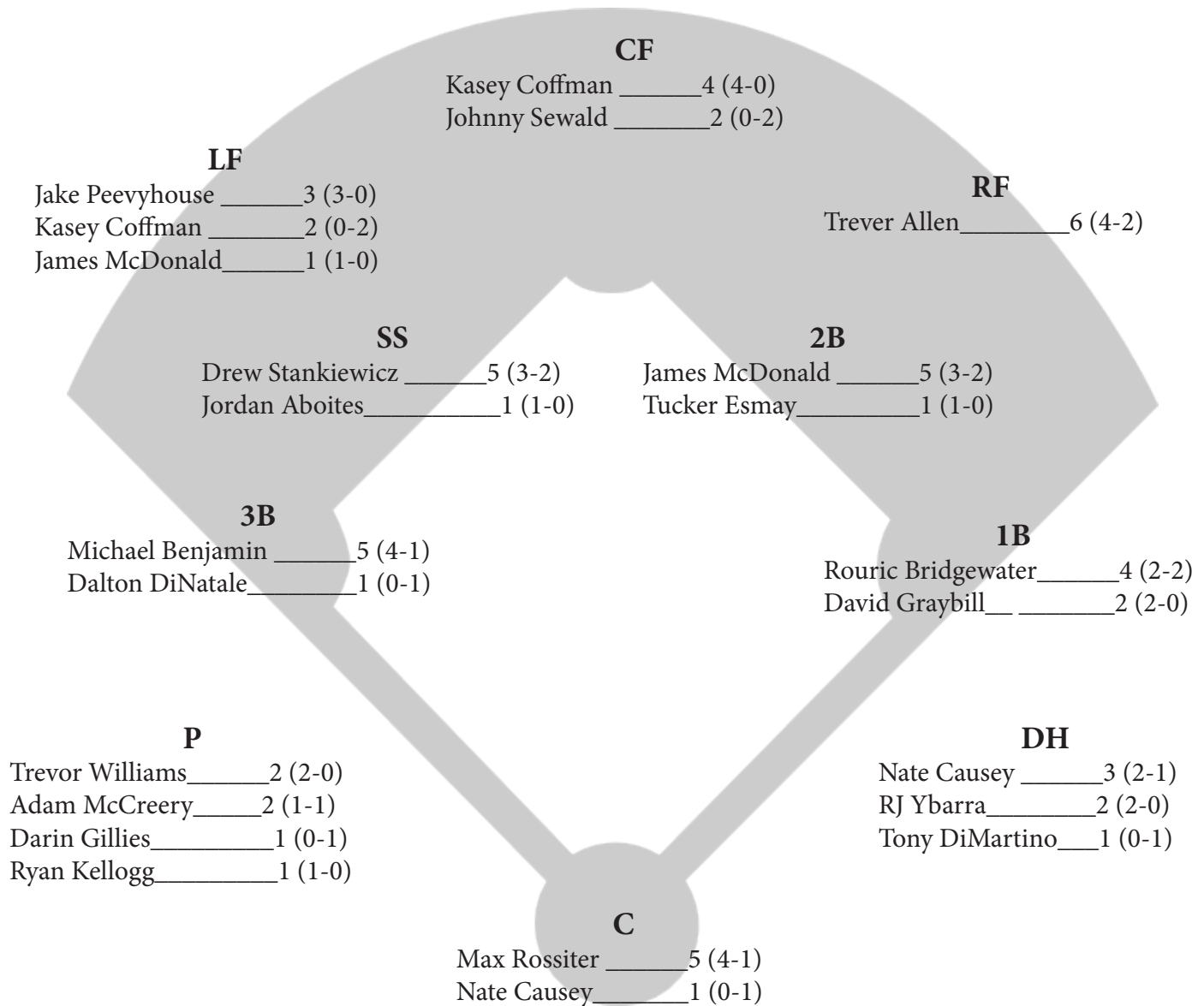
