The Sun Devils travel to Kansas to take on Wichita State for a pair of midweek non-conference tilts on Tuesday and Wednesday. First pitch is at 6:30 p.m. (CT) for both games.

Devils vs. Wichita State:

The Sun Devils are 13-7 all-time against Wichita State, with ASU winning the last meeting, 6-1, in Wichita on May 7, 2008. The Devils also won both games the last time the two teams played a two-game series in Kansas April 27-28, 2004.

UCLA Recap:

Head coach **Tim Esmay** collected his 13th win over a top-10 team and is 40-30 against ranked teams in three-plus years at ASU. RHP **Trevor Williams** pitched seven shutout innings on Thursday night and OF **Kasey Coffman** hit two home runs on Friday to lead the team to wins in the first two games of the series. The Devils tied a season-high with 19 hits on Saturday and freshman **Dalton DiNatale** hit a two-run homer with two outs in the ninth to push the game into extra innings, but the Devils fell in 10 in the series finale ASU's 10 runs and 19 hits are the most in a conference game this season, but its 10 walks tied a season high on Saturday.

Head Coach Tim Esmay

Tim Esmay is in his fourth season as head baseball coach at Arizona State after taking over his alma mater in 2010 and leading them to a Pac-10 title and a berth in the College World Series. The 2010 Pac-10 Coach of the Year, Esmay is in his 13th overall season as a coach at Arizona State. He spent 2005 to 2009 as an assistant coach, including the last three as the assistant head coach. He played two seasons as an infielder under Jim Brock in 1986 and 1987. Esmay was the head baseball coach at the University of Utah from 1997 to 2004, winning a WAC title and WAC Coach of the Year honors in 1997. In eight seasons at Utah he compiled a 213-235-1 record. Following his playing days, Esmay served as an assistant coach at Arizona State under Jim Brock from 1988 to 1990, then again in Brock's final season of 1994.

- The Devils have five wins this season over top-10 teams, with two coming against Arkansas, one at Oregon State on March 23 and two against UCLA on March 28 and 29
- As of March 31, **Ryan Kellogg** ranks 2nd in WHIP (0.65), 3rd in victories (6), ninth in Div. I in hits allowed per nine innings (4.89), 28th in walks allowed per nine innings (0.98) and 47th in ERA (1.37)
- As of March 31, **Kellogg** ranks 4th in the Pac-12 in ERA (1.37) and second among starting pitchers, first in opposing batting average (.154), ninth in innings pitched (46) and is tied for first with six wins. He also ranks fifth, including second among starting pitchers, in walks allowed with five
- All nine of ASU's primary starting position players are local Arizona products
- As of March 31, **Trevor Williams** is first the Pac-12 with 49.2 innings pitched, is 4th in batters struck out (42) and is tied for 9th in the conference in walks allowed with eight.
- As of March 31, ASU's pitching staff ranks 7th in Div. I in hits allowed per nine innings (6.94) and 30th in WHIP (1.2)
- As of March 31, ASU is one of three teams in the Pac-12 to have multiple players rank in the top 11 in slugging percentage (No. 6, **Trever Allen**, .561; No. 9 **Kasey Coffman**, .529)
- As of March 31, ASU ranks in the top 35 in slugging percentage (32), and doubles (32), triples (31) and home runs (33) per game
- As of March 31, Coffman ranks in the top 11 in the conference in slugging percentage, runs scored and on-base percentage
- ASU is 17th on the national average attendance list, and first in Pac-12 and No. 1 on the West Coast, with an average of 2,650 fans per game.
- Three Sun Devils have been named Pac-12 Player of the Week: **Ryan Kellogg** (3/26), **Trevor Williams** (3/12) and **Trever Allen** (2/26)

Growing Up Fast:

ASU has played 12 true freshmen this season, including eight position players and four pitchers. This is the most among teams ranked in the top 25 and is tied for the seventh most in the NCAA (Tennessee leads with 17). Six freshmen have made a combined 30 starts, including 1B **David Graybill** (14), CF **Johnny Sewald** (7), INF **Dalton DiNatale** (4), DH **RJ Ybarra** (3), DH **Tony DiMartino** and SS **Jordan Aboites**. Seven freshmen have collected base hits and six have recorded RBI to account for nearly 13 percent of the team's offense (33 H, 12 R, 17 RBI). A quartet of freshmen pitchers have combined to make eight starts and throw 83.2 innings, or 38 percent of all innings this season.

Career Weekend For Coffman

OF **Kasey Coffman** went 5-for-14 (.357) with six RBI, two home runs, two doubles and five runs scored to help the Sun Devils to a series win over UCLA. He had a three-run and a two-run homer, respectively, for a career-high five RBI in a 7-4 win on Friday, and is the first Sun Devil to hit two home runs in a game since Abe Ruiz on March 18, 2012 (at UCLA, W 4-3). He also registered three hits, including two doubles, and scored a pair of runs as the team lost in extra innings on Sunday to finish the series with a .929 slugging percentage and a .400 on-base percentage.

More On Kellogg:

- He has given up just five earned runs in the past 32 innings dating back to the sixth inning of his start against then-No. 2 Arkansas on March 2
- Held a 16 consecutive scoreless-inning streak from 2nd inning against Washington St. on March 16 to 2nd inning against UCLA on March 29
- Is the first freshman in more than 13 years to begin his career 6-0
- 19 consecutive innings without issuing a walk, including two consecutive starts, dating back to the 6th inning against Washington St. on March 16

A New Closer In Town:

RHP **Ryan Burr**, who has allowed three earned run in 19.2 innings, has recorded the team's only five saves this year. He moved into a tie for fifth on the school's all-time freshman saves list and is six behind the record. He has 26 strikeouts to go with five hits, including two doubles, and 12 walks.

Year Of The Snake:

In his three seasons at ASU, pitching coach **Ken "Snake" Knutson** has guided the pitching staff to two of the lowest single-season ERA marks in the Aluminum Bat Era in school history. His 2012 staff ranks third in ASU annals with a 3.19 season ERA, while his 2011 edition is fourth with a 3.22 ERA. The all-time low is 2.35 set in 1975, followed by a 2.90 set in 2009.

Who's Back:

The Sun Devils welcome back 20 returners, headlined by preseason All-American RHP **Trevor Williams**. Also returning are 2011 All-Pac-10 Honorable Mention recipients INF **James McDonald** and C **Max Rossiter**. Other position players coming back include OF **Trevor Allen**, INF **Michael Benjamin**, INF **Kyle Bilbrey**, INF **Rouric Bridgewater**, C **Nate Causey**, OF **Kasey Coffman**, INF **Tucker Esmay**, OF **Jake Peevyhouse** and INF **Drew Stankiewicz**. Other pitchers returning include RHP **Alex Blackford**, LHP **Matt Dunbar**, RHP **Darin Gillies**, RHP **Mark Lambson**, RHP **Zak Miller**, RHP **Josh McAlister**, LHP **Adam McCreery** and RHP **Billy Young**.

Who's New:

Arizona State welcomes 14 newcomers, all true freshmen, to Tempe as they begin their Sun Devil careers. Six of these freshmen were selected in the 2012 MLB Draft. The freshmen class features four local products, including INF **Emilio Torrez** (Phoenix/Brophy Prep), OF/RHP **David Graybill** (Phoenix/Brophy Prep), OF **Christopher Beall** (Phoenix/Brophy Prep) and RHP **Eric Melbostad** (Scottsdale/Pinnacle). Freshman LHP Ryan Kellogg Tosses No-Hitter

Freshman left-hander **Ryan Kellogg** threw the ninth no-hitter in school history in a complete-game shutout on the road against No. 3 Oregon State on March 23.

He did not allow a walk in 110 pitches as OSU's only two base runners of the game reached on Sun Devil errors. His perfect game was broken up with one out in the seventh inning when shortstop Drew Stankiewicz made an error that allowed the second batter of the frame to reach first. A dropped fly ball by right fielder Trever Allen in the eighth inning put another Beaver on base, but neither made it past first.

Kellogg has now defeated two top-5 teams this season as he beat No. 2 Arkansas on March 2 in Surprise, Ariz.

Kellogg Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week honors, and received National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) National Pitcher of the Week recognition as well as Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week honors.

He is the first Sun Devil to earn NCBWA National Player of the Week recognition since Zack MacPhee on Feb. 23, 2010, and the seventh since 2002, including the fifth pitcher.

No. 34 On The Stirrups - The Cory Hahn Story:

The Sun Devils wear the No. 34 on their stirrups to honor former student-athlete and current student coach Cory Hahn, who was paralyzed from the chest down sliding into second base in the third game of his college career in 2011. Hahn was California's Mr. Baseball and Orange County Player of the Year, led Mater Dei to a CIF title, played on the United States' first gold medal 18U team alongside Bryce Harper and Manny Machado, and was a 26th round pick by the San Diego Padres in the 2010 MLB Draft.

An ESpecial Coach:

In his three seasons at the helm of the Sun Devil baseball team, head coach **Tim Esmay** has guided ASU to the highest regular-season winning percentage in the Pac-12 since 2010. His record of 131-48 (.732) is ahead of UCLA (128-55, .699) and Oregon State (111-61, .645). He is the second-fastest coach in ASU history to reach 100 wins after passing the century mark this past season in an 11-2 win over UC Riverside on Feb. 26, and has the second-highest winning percentage among ASU head coaches at the 100-win mark (100-29, .775). Coach Esmay has posted a winning record in the 65 games he has played against top-25 teams, and also has a winning record against four of the top teams in the Pac-12, including Arizona, Oregon State, Oregon and UCLA.

Today's Devils Are Tomorrow's Major Leaguers:

Arizona State produced an NCAA-best 10 selections in the 2012 MLB First-Year Player Draft, including five in the first five rounds for the first time in program history since 1984. Thirty-one Sun Devils have been taken in the MLB Draft in coach Esmay's three seasons at ASU, which is the most of any Div. I school in that time span. ASU's 101 Major Leaguers since 1959 is the most in the nation.

50 Seasons Of Success:

The baseball program secured its 50th straight 30-win season, which is the longest current streak in Div. I baseball. Florida State is close with 48 consecutive. The streak started with the 1963 season when ASU went 34-13.

Legacy Devils:

The 2013 Sun Devil team features four student-athletes whose fathers also played baseball at Arizona State. Redshirt sophomore **Trevor Allen** is the son of **Jamie Allen**, who played three seasons at ASU, including the 1977 National Championship year. Jamie was a lifetime .333 hitter at ASU and he also went 6-2 on the mound. A two-time All-WAC honoree and a member of the 1977 All-College World Series team, Jamie spent one season in the MLB with the Seattle Mariners... Freshman **David Graybill** is a third-generation Sun Devil. His grandfather, **Dave Graybill Sr.**, is one of only seven three-sport letterman in ASU school history after playing baseball, football and basketball during the mid-50s, and his father, **Dave Graybill Jr.**, starred as a pitcher for the baseball team from 1982-84... redshirt sophomore **Tucker Esmay** is the son of head coach **Tim Esmay**... junior **Michael Benjamin** is the son of assistant coach **Mike Benjamin**. The elder Esmay and Benjamin were teammates on the 1986 and 1987 Sun Devils.

Notable Connections:

Freshman **Emilio Torrez** is the younger brother of Raoul and Riccio, who both played for the Sun Devils and became the first set of brothers to start alongside one another in school history (sixth all-time to suit for ASU at the same time). **Raoul** was an infielder from 2007-2010 and was drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 21st round of the 2010 MLB draft. **Riccio** was an infielder from 2009-2011 and was drafted by the Tampa Bay Rays in the fourth round of the 2011 MLB draft... Sophomore **Drew Stankiewicz's** father Andy also played in the Major Leagues, spending seven seasons with the New York Yankees, Houston Astros, Montreal Expos and Arizona Diamondbacks. **Andy** was an assistant coach at Arizona State from 2007-09, collecting two Pac-10 titles and a trip to the 2009 College World Series, and is currently the head baseball coach at Grand Canyon University... Fellow sophomore **Nate Causey** is the cousin of current New Mexico All-American infielder **DJ Peterson**... Redshirt sophomore **Mark Lambson** is the brother of **Mitchell**, who made 102 appearances for ASU from 2009-11, tied for the second most in school history.

Other Devils who played in summer leagues include **Adam McCreery**, also on the Cotuit Kettleers; **Trevor Allen**, **Michael Benjamin** and **Drew Stankiewicz** on the Maknato Moondogs, Northwoods League; **Kasey Coffman** and **James McDonald** on the Newport Gulls, New England Collegiate; **Tucker Esmay**, **Darin Gillies** and **Josh McAlister** on the Bend Elks, West Coast; **Rouric Bridgewater**, **Nate Causey** and **Jake Peevyhouse** on the Bellingham Bells, West Coast; and **Kyle Bilbrey** on Team Vegas Baseball Club, California Collegiate.

2012 Pac-12 Awards:



Arizona State had nine All-Pac-12 honorees, which was the most total selections in the conference. They had four first team performers in **Joey DeMichele**, **Deven Marrero**, **Brady Rodgers** and **Trevor Williams** (returning). **Andrew Aplin**, **Jake Barrett**, **James McDonald** (returning), **Max Rossiter** (returning) and **Abe Ruiz** all earned Honorable Mentions. Five Devils were named to the Academic All-Pac-12 team, including **Marrero** (second team), and honorable mentions **Kasey Coffman** (returning), **DeMichele**, **Joseph Lopez** and **Rossiter**. A total of four current Devils have earned all-conference honors and **Williams** is the sole two-time honoree as **Alex Blackford** (returning) and **Williams** both earned all-conference recognition in 2011.

2012 All-Americans:

Brady Rodgers and **Trevor Williams** both earned second team honors from Collegiate Baseball and took home third team honors from the NCBWA. **Abe Ruiz** was named to the Collegiate Baseball Third Team.

Inter-Conference Battles:

In addition to facing the schools in the Pac-12, the Devils will also take on teams from 10 different conferences in 2013. ASU will face two each from the Mid-American (Northern Illinois, Western Michigan), Mountain West (New Mexico, Pacific), SEC (Arkansas, Tennessee), and West Coast (BYU, Gonzaga), and one each from the Big 12 (Texas Tech), Big West (Long Beach State), Mid-Eastern Athletic (Bethune-Cookman), Missouri Valley (Wichita State), The Summit (Valparaiso) and Western Athletic (UNLV).

Feeling The Draft:

There are 12 members of the 2013 Sun Devils who have had their name called during the annual Major League Baseball draft, including six freshmen. Everyone except for **Max Rossiter**, who was drafted (for the second time) but returned to ASU for his senior year, was selected after high school but opted to attend ASU. There were 13 on last year's team.

Tough Schedule:

The Sun Devils will play 19 games this season against teams ranked in the Preseason Top 20, including 12 at Packard Stadium, five on the road and two at a neutral site. ASU's first ranked opponent is No. 1 Arkansas, which they face in Surprise, Ariz., at the College Classic. The Sun Devils host a three-game series against four ranked Pac-12 opponents at Packard Stadium, including three in the top 10, as they take on No. 5 UCLA (March 28-30), No. 6 Oregon (April 4-7), No. 9 Stanford (May 3-5) and No. 18 Arizona (May 17-19). ASU goes to Corvallis, Ore., March 22-24 to play No. 10 Oregon State, and they also travel to Tucson for two separate non-conference single-game sets against the Wildcats on April 16 and April 30, respectively.

Arizona State hosts No. 11 Oregon for a three-game series April 5-7 at Packard Stadium. First pitch on Friday and Saturday is at 6:30 p.m., and Sunday's game will begin at 12:30 p.m. All three conference games can be heard on The Fan AM 1060 or through the All-Access player on thesundevils.com, while the games on April 5 and 7 will be live streamed through Pac-12.com/live/thesundevils.
