Leading Off:

The 9th-ranked Sun Devils head to Tucson on Tuesday to face Arizona for a non-conference Territorial Cup game, with first pitch at 6 p.m., before they return home to host Valparaiso for a three-game non-conference set over the weekend.

Can't Make It?:

Tuesday's game against the Wildcats will be televised on the Pac-12 Networks with Ted Robinson and JT Snow on the call, and it will also be broadcast on NBC Sports Radio AM 1060 or through the All-Access player on thesundevils.com. Fans can also follow the team on Twitter at @ASU_Baseball for live scoring and updates from the weekend, and check thesundevils.com for stats, notes and more.

Devils vs. Arizona:

The Sun Devils are 187-120^ all-time against Arizona, and is 9-5 against Arizona in Tucson over the past six seasons. ASU won two vs. the Wildcats last season, including a 12-8 comeback win in Tempe and a 9-7 road victory in the second-to-last game of the season. The Devils trailed by three heading into the seventh inning and rallied to score seven runs in the frame to take the win at Packard, and right-handed pitcher Trevor Williams picked up his conference-leading 12th win after allowing four earned runs in eight innings in Tucson. Head coach Tim Esmay is 9-6 against the Wildcats in his three seasons at ASU, and the Sun Devils are 19-10 against Arizona in the past six seasons, including 9-5 in Tucson and 11-7 in conference games. ASU went 5-0 against the Wildcats in 2009, outscoring Arizona 63-19, including a 23-9 win at Packard Stadium and a 20-3 win in Tucson.

Head Coach Tim Esmay

Tim Esmay is in his fourth season as head baseball coach at Arizona State after taking over his alma mater in 2010 and leading them to a Pac-10 title and a berth in the College World Series. The 2010 Pac-10 Coach of the Year, Esmay is in his 13th overall season as a coach at Arizona State. He spent 2005 to 2009 as an assistant coach, including the last three as the assistant head coach. He played two seasons as an infielder under Jim Brock in 1986 and 1987. Esmay was the head baseball coach at the University of Utah from 1997 to 2004, winning a WAC title and WAC Coach of the Year honors in 1997. In eight seasons at Utah he compiled a 213-235-1 record. Following his playing days, Esmay served as an assistant coach at Arizona State under Jim Brock from 1988 to 1990, then again in Brock's final season of 1994.

Quick Hits:

- The Devils have seven wins this season over top-10 teams, with two coming against Arkansas, one at Oregon State on March 23, two against UCLA on March 28 and 29, and two against Oregon on April 5 and 6, which is the most in the Pac-12
- Nine of ASU's primary starting position players are local Arizona products for the first time in more than 30 years
- ASU has scored 47 percent of its runs (35 of its past 74) with two outs dating back to March 28 game against UCLA
- As of April 15, ASU is the only school in a power six conference and one of only two schools in Div. I to rank in the top 20 in both doubles and triples per game
- As of April 15, ASU ranks first in the Pac-12 in doubles (73) and home runs (20), and second in triples (16) and slugging percentage (.429)
- As of April 15, **James McDonald** leads the Pac-12 in doubles (13), **Trevor Allen** leads in both triples (5) and home runs (6), and **Kasey Coffman** is tied for lead in triples (5)
- As of April 15, **Trevor Williams** is first the Pac-12 with 65 innings pitched, is 5th in batters struck out (47) and is tied for 6th in the conference in walks allowed with nine
- As of April 15, ASU's pitching staff ranks 45th in Div. I in hits allowed per nine innings (8.17)
- As of April 15, ASU ranks 37th in Div. I in slugging percentage, 13th in triples per game, 18th in doubles per game and 48th in home runs per game
- As of April 15, **Trevor Allen** is the only player in the Pac-12 to rank in the top 3 in the conference in slugging percentage (3rd, .575), triples (T1st, 5) and home runs (T1st, 6)
- As of April 15, **Trevor Allen** and **Kasey Coffman** both rank 3rd in triples in Div. I, while **James McDonald** is 38th in doubles
- As of April 15, **Kasey Coffman** is one of just four players in the Pac-12 to rank in the top 4 in the conference in runs scored and the top 6 in slugging percentage (Dixon, Ariz.; Field, Ariz.; Healy, Ore.)
- ASU is 16th on the national average attendance list, and first in Pac-12 and No. 1 on the West Coast, with an average of 2,760 fans per game
- Four Sun Devils have been named Pac-12 Player of the Week: **RJ Ybarra** (4/8), **Ryan Kellogg** (3/26), **Trevor Williams** (3/12) and **Trevor Allen** (2/26)
- James McDonald** had 12 assists on April 5, 2013, vs Oregon, which is the most since Raoul Torrez had 11 against May 16, 2008, vs Washington
- ASU is 10-0 when not committing an error and three of those games have against top-5 teams (Arkansas, two vs UCLA)
- ASU was one-hit on both March 22 and April 12 by Oregon State and USC, respectively, and lost both road conference games 5-0
- Team went from unranked in three polls on March 25 to ninth in Baseball America poll, 11th in Perfect Game and 18th in USA Today/Coaches Poll.

Territorial Cup:

ASU currently leads the Wildcats in the Territorial Cup standings, 6.5-5.5. ASU and UA sports teams will compete against one another in 18 common varsity intercollegiate sports, with each sport worth one point. For a school to be the winner of the Territorial Cup Series Trophy, they must accumulate 9.5 points. The baseball teams face each other five times this season, with two non-conference games in Tucson on April 16 and 30, and a three-game Pac-12 series at Packard Stadium May 17-19.

Past Week Recap (April 8-14):

ASU won three-of-four this past week, including a road series win against USC and a non-conference road win at UNLV...ASU lost the Friday night opener to USC before winning the next two to secure their third consecutive Pac-12 series win...this is the first time since 2007 against Washington that the Devils lost a conference series opener on the road and went on to win the three-game series...freshman left-handed pitcher **Ryan Kellogg** improved to 8-0 and fellow freshman **Ryan Burr** pitcher collected his seventh save of the season...Burr is in fourth place on the school's single-season freshmen saves list and Kellogg is one win away from tying for seventh on the school's single-season freshmen wins list.

1-2 Punch

Outfielders **Trevor Allen** and **Kasey Coffman** have combined for 10 RBI, 11 hits and eight runs over the past four games. The duo collected six extra-base hits, including three home runs, two doubles and a triple.

Allen went 5-for-14 with a .357 batting average and a .857 slugging percentage, and Coffman went 6-for-17 with a .353 batting average and a .706 slugging percentage. The two have a total of 25 multi-hit games and 11 multi-RBI games this season. Coffman's best weekend came against UCLA, when he collected six RBI, two home runs, two doubles and five runs scored, including a career-high five RBI and two homers in a Friday win. Allen has collected four RBI in two games this season (against Washington State March 17 and against UNLV April 10).

Close Games:

ASU is 7-3 in its 10 one-run games this season, they have played four extra-innings games and they have won four games this season in the ninth inning or later, with **Kasey Coffman** and **RJ Ybarra** each securing two game-winning hits. They have also lost a pair of games in the ninth inning or later, as RHP **Ryan Burr** walked in the game-winning run against Texas Tech in bottom of the ninth and UCLA won in the 10th inning. ASU has tied the game with a home run in the final inning twice, as **Trever Allen** hit a leadoff home run in the 8th inning in an eight-inning tie with Gonzaga and **Dalton DiNatale** hit a two-run home run with two outs to tie the game against UCLA before losing in extras.

Growing Up Fast:

ASU has played 12 true freshmen this season, including eight position players and four pitchers. This is the most among teams ranked in the top 25 and is tied for the seventh most in the NCAA (Tennessee leads with 17). Six freshmen have made a combined 39 starts, including 1B **David Graybill** (16), 1B/3B **Dalton DiNatale** (11), DH/C **RJ Ybarra** (10), CF **Johnny Sewald** (7), DH **Tony DiMartino** and SS **Jordan Aboites**. Seven freshmen have collected base hits, and six have recorded RBI to account for nearly 13 percent of the team's offense (54 H, 23 R, 29 RBI). A quartet of freshmen pitchers have combined to make 10 starts and throw 102.2 innings, or 38 percent of all innings this season.

Saturday Starter Ryan Kellogg:

- Held a 16 consecutive scoreless-inning streak from 2nd inning against Washington St. on March 16 to 2nd inning against UCLA on March 29
- Is the first freshman at ASU in more than 13 years to begin his career 8-0 (leads the Pac-12)
- Went 20 consecutive innings without issuing a walk, including two consecutive starts, from 6th inning vs. Washington St. on March 16 to 2nd inning vs. Oregon on April 6
- As of April 15, he ranks 30th in WHIP (0.89) in Div. I and 2nd in victories (8),
- As of April 10, he ranks 8th in the Pac-12 in ERA (2.28), 5th in opposing batting average (.202), ninth in innings pitched (59.1) and is tied for sixth in walks allowed with nine

A New Closer In Town:

RHP **Ryan Burr** has allowed six earned runs in 24.2 innings, and has recorded seven saves this year to move into fourth on the school's freshman saves list. He has 33 strikeouts to go with 10 hits, including three doubles, and 14 walks. His 24.2 innings of relief lead the team and his 17 appearances are tied for second the team. He also has earned one win and has blown one save opportunity.

- **Kasey Coffman** (.371, 13 hits, 16 RBI, double, triple, home run), **Peevyhouse** (.357, 15 hits and 15 RBI) and **Stankiewicz** (.353, 12 hits and 15 RBI) lead the team with runners in scoring position
- **Stankiewicz** (.444, 8 hits, 4 RBI, double, triple), **RJ Ybarra** (.444, 4-for-9, 3 RBI, 2 doubles) and **James McDonald** (.409, 9 hits, 5 RBI, 4 doubles) lead the team with runners on base and two outs
- **Stankiewicz** (.333, 4 hits, 3 RBI, double), **McDonald** (.333, 5 hits, 4 RBI, double) and **Coffman** (.333, 5 hits, 6 RBI, home run) lead the team with runners in scoring position and two outs

Year Of The Snake:

In his three seasons at ASU, pitching coach **Ken "Snake" Knutson** has guided the pitching staff to two of the lowest single-season ERA marks in the Aluminum Bat Era in school history. His 2012 staff ranks third in ASU annals with a 3.19 season ERA, while his 2011 edition is fourth with a 3.22 ERA. The all-time low is 2.35 set in 1975, followed by a 2.90 set in 2009.

Who's Back:

The Sun Devils welcome back 20 returners, headlined by preseason All-American RHP **Trevor Williams**. Also returning are 2011 All-Pac-10 Honorable Mention recipients INF **James McDonald** and C **Max Rossiter**. Other position players coming back include OF **Trever Allen**, INF **Michael Benjamin**, INF **Kyle Bilbrey**, INF **Rouric Bridgewater**, C **Nate Causey**, OF **Kasey Coffman**, INF **Tucker Esmay**, OF **Jake Peevyhouse** and INF **Drew Stankiewicz**. Other pitchers returning include RHP **Alex Blackford**, LHP **Matt Dunbar**, RHP **Darin Gillies**, RHP **Mark Lambson**, RHP **Zak Miller**, RHP **Josh McAlister**, LHP **Adam McCreery** and RHP **Billy Young**.

Who's New:

Arizona State welcomes 14 newcomers, all true freshmen, to Tempe as they begin their Sun Devil careers. Six of these freshmen were selected in the 2012 MLB Draft. The freshmen class features four local products, including INF **Emilio Torrez** (Phoenix/Brophy Prep), OF/RHP **David Graybill** (Phoenix/Brophy Prep), OF **Christopher Beall** (Phoenix/Brophy Prep) and RHP **Eric Melbostad** (Scottsdale/Pinnacle). INF **Dalton DiNatale** (Parkland, Fla.), C **RJ Ybarra** (Riverside, Calif.), **Johnny Sewald** (Las Vegas, Nev.), **Cullen O'Dwyer** (Albuquerque, N.M.), **Jordan Aboites** (Long Beach, Calif.), **Brett Lilek** (South Holland, Ill.), **Trey Kamachi** (Kapolei, Hawaii), **Ryan Burr** (Highlands Ranch, Colo.), **Tony DiMartino** (Danville, Calif.) and LHP **Ryan Kellogg** (Whitby, Ontario).

No. 34 On The Stirrups - The Cory Hahn Story:

The Sun Devils wear the No. 34 on their stirrups to honor former student-athlete and current student coach Cory Hahn, who was paralyzed from the chest down sliding into second base in the third game of his college career in 2011. Hahn was California's Mr. Baseball and Orange County Player of the Year, led Mater Dei to a CIF title, played on the United States' first gold medal 18U team alongside Bryce Harper and Manny Machado, and was a 26th round pick by the San Diego Padres in the 2010 MLB Draft.

An ESpecial Coach:

In his three seasons at the helm of the Sun Devil baseball team, head coach **Tim Esmay** has guided ASU to the highest regular-season winning percentage in the Pac-12 since 2010. His record of 131-48 (.732) is ahead of UCLA (128-55, .699) and Oregon State (111-61, .645). He is the second-fastest coach in ASU history to reach 100 wins after passing the century mark this past season in an 11-2 win over UC Riverside on Feb. 26, and has the second-highest winning percentage among ASU head coaches at the 100-win mark (100-29, .775). Coach Esmay has posted a winning record in the 65 games he has played against top-25 teams, and also has a winning record against four of the top teams in the Pac-12, including Arizona, Oregon State, Oregon and UCLA.

Today's Devils Are Tomorrow's Major Leaguers:

Arizona State produced an NCAA-best 10 selections in the 2012 MLB First-Year Player Draft, including five in the first five rounds for the first time in program history since 1984. Thirty-one Sun Devils have been taken in the MLB Draft in coach Esmay's three seasons at ASU, which is the most of any Div. I school in that time span. ASU's 101 Major Leaguers since 1959 is the most in the nation.

50 Seasons Of Success:

The baseball program secured its 50th straight 30-win season, which is the longest current streak in Div. 1 baseball. Florida State is close with 48 consecutive. The streak started with the 1963 season when ASU went 34-13.

Legacy Devils:

The 2013 Sun Devil team features four student-athletes whose fathers also played baseball at Arizona State. Redshirt sophomore **Trevor Allen** is the son of **Jamie Allen**, who played three seasons at ASU, including the 1977 National Championship year. Jamie was a lifetime .333 hitter at ASU and he also went 6-2 on the mound. A two-time All-WAC honoree and a member of the 1977 All-College World Series team, Jamie spent one season in the MLB with the Seattle Mariners ... Freshman **David Graybill** is a third-generation Sun Devil. His grandfather, **Dave Graybill Sr.**, is one of only seven three-sport letterman in ASU school history after playing baseball, football and basketball during the mid-50s, and his father, **Dave Graybill Jr.**, starred as a pitcher for the baseball team from 1982-84...redshirt sophomore **Tucker Esmay** is the son of head coach **Tim Esmay**...junior **Michael Benjamin** is the son of assistant coach **Mike Benjamin**. The elder Esmay and Benjamin were teammates on the 1986 and 1987 Sun Devils.

Notable Connections:

Freshman **Emilio Torrez** is the younger brother of Raoul and Riccio, who both played for the Sun Devils and became the first set of brothers to start alongside one another in school history (sixth all-time to suit for ASU at the same time). **Raoul** was an infielder from 2007-2010 and was drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 21st round of the 2010 MLB draft. **Riccio** was an infielder



from 2009-2011 and was drafted by the Tampa Bay Rays in the fourth round of the 2011 MLB draft...Sophomore **Drew Stankiewicz**'s father Andy also played in the Major Leagues, spending seven seasons with the New York Yankees, Houston Astros, Montreal Expos and Arizona Diamondbacks. **Andy** was an assistant coach at Arizona State from 2007-09, collecting two Pac-10 titles and a trip to the 2009 College World Series, and is currently the head baseball coach at Grand Canyon University...Fellow sophomore **Nate Causey** is the cousin of current New Mexico All-American infielder **DJ Peterson**...Redshirt sophomore **Mark Lambson** is the brother of **Mitchell**, who made 102 appearances for ASU from 2009-11, tied for the second most in school history.

Summer Lovin':

Fourteen members of the 2013 Arizona State baseball team participated in summer collegiate baseball this past summer, including **Trevor Williams**, who competed for Team USA and the Cotuit Kettleers of the Cape Cod League. 2012 Pac-12 Awards:

Arizona State had nine All-Pac-12 honorees, which was the most total selections in the conference. They had four first team performers in **Joey DeMichele**, **Deven Marrero**, **Brady Rodgers** and **Trevor Williams** (returning). **Andrew Aplin**, **Jake Barrett**, **James McDonald** (returning), **Max Rossiter** (returning) and **Abe Ruiz** all earned Honorable Mentions. Five Devils were named to the Academic All-Pac-12 team, including **Marrero** (second team), and honorable mentions **Kasey Coffman** (returning), **DeMichele**, **Joseph Lopez** and **Rossiter**. A total of four current Devils have earned all-conference honors and **Williams** is the sole two-time honoree as **Alex Blackford** (returning) and **Williams** both earned all-conference recognition in 2011.

2012 All-Americans:

Brady Rodgers and **Trevor Williams** both earned second team honors from Collegiate Baseball and took home third team honors from the NCBWA. **Abe Ruiz** was named to the Collegiate Baseball Third Team.

Inter-Conference Battles:

In addition to facing the schools in the Pac-12, the Devils will also take on teams from 10 different conferences in 2013. ASU will face two each from the Mid-American (Northern Illinois, Western Michigan), Mountain West (New Mexico, Pacific), SEC (Arkansas, Tennessee), and West Coast (BYU, Gonzaga), and one each from the Big 12 (Texas Tech), Big West (Long Beach State), Mid-Eastern Athletic (Bethune-Cookman), Missouri Valley (Wichita State), The Summit (Valparaiso) and Western Athletic (UNLV).

Feeling The Draft:

There are 12 members of the 2013 Sun Devils who have had their name called during the annual Major League Baseball draft, including six freshmen. Everyone except for **Max Rossiter**, who was drafted (for the second time) but returned to ASU for his senior year, was selected after high school but opted to attend ASU. Tough Schedule:

The Sun Devils will play 19 games this season against teams ranked in the Preseason Top 20, including 12 at Packard Stadium, five on the road and two at a neutral site. ASU's first ranked opponent is No. 1 Arkansas, which they face in Surprise, Ariz., at the College Classic. The Sun Devils host a three-game series against four ranked Pac-12 opponents at Packard Stadium, including three in the top 10, as they take on No. 5 UCLA (March 28-30), No. 6 Oregon (April 4-7), No. 9 Stanford (May 3-5) and No. 18 Arizona (May 17-19). ASU goes to Corvallis, Ore., March 22-24 to play No. 10 Oregon State, and they also travel to Tucson for two separate non-conference single-game sets against the Wildcats on April 16 and April 30, respectively.

Freshman LHP Ryan Kellogg Tosses No-Hitter

Freshman left-hander **Ryan Kellogg** threw the ninth no-hitter in school history in a complete-game shutout on the road against No. 3 Oregon State on March 23.

He did not allow a walk in 110 pitches as OSU's only two base runners of the game reached on Sun Devil errors. His perfect game was broken up with one out in the seventh inning when shortstop Drew Stankiewicz made an error that allowed the second batter of the frame to reach first. A dropped fly ball by right fielder Trever Allen in the eighth inning put another Beaver on base, but neither made it past first.

Kellogg has now defeated two top-5 teams this season as he beat No. 2 Arkansas on March 2 in Surprise, Ariz.


