**COUGAR DIAMOND NOTES****WSU OFF TO LCSC, THEN ASU:**

The Washington State Cougars, 12-22 overall and 4-5 in the Pacific-10 Conference, hit the road early Thursday morning for a three-game league series at Arizona State, with the opening game of the series set for Thursday at 7:00 p.m. at Packard Stadium on the ASU campus. Friday's second game is also set for 7:00 p.m., while Saturday's finale is slated for 1:00 p.m.

The Cougars are coming off a heart-breaking 10-7 loss at Lewis-Clark State Tuesday. The Warriors used a three-run home run in the bottom of the ninth to pull out the non-conference win.

WSU is expected to start Tony Banaszak (4-4), Justin Cayetano (2-1) and Zach Fisher (0-5) against the Sun Devils, although the order of starters has not been determined.

The Cougars have turned into one of the hottest hitting teams in the Pacific-10 in the last two weeks. Against UCLA two weeks ago, WSU hit .398 in three games, then came back last weekend against Arizona to hit .379. In their last six Pac-10 games WSU is hitting .389. Adrian Thomas, in those six games, hit .630 and Bookie Gates hit .609.

In WSU's nine conference games, the Cougars are hitting .354. Thomas is WSU's top hitter in league contests with a .581 average, while Gates is hitting .512. Tyson Boston and Stefan Bailie are each hitting .306 in Pac-10 action.

In three games against Arizona, Thomas hit .533 and Gates .500, while Bailie hit .429, Tyson Boston .385 and Mike Knight .357.

Adrian Thomas has taken over as the Cougars top hitter with a .361 average.

He is followed by Stefan Bailie at .359, Bookie Gates at .346, Mike Knight at .342 and Evan Hecker at .316.

Four Cougar pitchers have thrown 40 or more innings, headed by freshman Jamin Svendsen (40.1) with a 5.36 ERA and a 2-0 record. Zach Fisher (46.1), 0-5, has a 6.41 ERA, while Justin Cayetano (51.1), 2-1, has a 6.49 ERA. Tony Banaszak (48.1) is 4-4 with a 7.45 ERA.

**BAILIE KEEPS HOT PACE:** Stefan Bailie had an outstanding freshman season last year, hitting a school record 12 home runs while batting .315 and earning freshman All-America honorable mention honors...this year he has 10 home runs in 34 games and a .359 batting average...in two seasons he has 22 home runs, just three short of WSU's Top 10 list, and a .333 batting average, going 104-312.

**KNIGHT NEARLY DOUBLES**

**AVERAGE:** Senior Mike Knight, who joined WSU last year after stints at Odessa College and Laney College, has nearly doubled his batting average of a year ago...as a junior he hit .227 for the Cougs and had no home runs...this year he is batting .342 and has four home runs...he had five RBI last year and has 19 so far this season...after missing the UCLA games (bruised elbow), Knight returned against Arizona to hit .357.

**COUGS KEEP IT CLOSE:** In 34 games this year, only 19 have been determined by more than two runs...WSU is 5-6 in one-run games, 1-3 in two-run games, 2-8 in games determined by three or four runs and 4-5 in games determined by five or more runs.

**TOP OF ORDER HITS:** WSU's leadoff batters are hitting .338 and the number two spot hits .299, then 292 in the number three slot and .353 in cleanup...then the averages dip sharply, with the number five batters hitting .240...WSU hits .271 in the number six spot, then .242, .280 and .212 in the next three spots in the batting order...overall, the Cougs hit .321 through the top four spots in the order and .249 combined for the bottom five positions.

**TO START OR NOT TO START:**

Figure this one out...WSU batters, when starting, are hitting .277, while the non-starters are hitting .348...the opponents are more conventional, with their starters hitting .318 and the non-starters .300...on the mound, Cougar starters have an ERA of 7.82 and the non-starting pitchers are at 5.28...for opponents, the starters have a 5.26 ERA and the relief pitchers 6.49.

**HITTING STREAKS:** Adrian Thomas boasts the longest current hitting streak at nine games, equaling Stefan Bailie's nine-game streak earlier in the season...Tyson Boson, Mike Knight, Bookie Gates and Evan Hecker all have had seven-game hitting streaks this year...Gates and Bailie have 14 multiple-hit games, Knight 11 and Hecker 10...Bailie and Gates have had two or more RBI in eight games.

**WSU NEEDS TO START PLAYING**

**EARLIER:** WSU would be in much better shape if they opened up the offense earlier in the game...the Cougs have been outscored 119-80 over the first four innings, including 47-26 in the first frame...over the last five innings WSU has a 153-136 run advantage...the Cougs' best innings are the sixth with a 33-17 advantage, and the ninth at 30-23.

**GATES NAMED PAC-10 POW:**

Junior Bookie Gates was named the Pac-10's Player of the Week April 2 for his performance against UCLA...Gates hit 10-14, had seven RBI, scored five times, hit three doubles and one home run.

**ARIZONA SERIES REVIEW:** The Cougs pulled out of a four-game slump with a 17-4 win over Arizona after dropping the first two games (14-11 (10i) and 11-7...WSU hit .379 against Arizona, led by Adrian Thomas's .533 performance...other starters who hit over .300 included Bookie Gates .500, Stefan Bailie .429, Tyson Boston .385, Mike Knight .357 and Tanner Kahler .308...Arizona hit .364 against WSU pitching...the Cougar mound staff had a 9.96 ERA, less than Arizona's 10.00 ERA...Lanakila Niles had two brief trips to the mound, threw 1.2 innings and did not allow a run...at the plate WSU collected six doubles, including two each from Thomas and Gates, and four home runs, two by Mike Knight...Gates, in the final game, went 5-for-5, walked once and drove home six of WSU's 17 runs.

**HECKER HURT:** Evan Hecker, WSU's starting centerfielder, suffered a bruised back in the first game against Arizona while leaping into the centerfield wall and missed the final two contests. He is expected to be ready for the ASU series.

**LCSC REVIEW:** WSU lost to the LCSC Warriors on a ninth-inning three-run home run...Stefan Bailie was 3-5 and Adrian Thomas 2-3 in leading the Cougars, who used six pitchers.

**105 YEARS OF COUGAR BASEBALL:** Baseball, the first sport played at Washington State University in 1892, completed its 105th season of diamond action in 2000...during its first 105 seasons, WSU baseball teams won 64.9% of their games, posting a 2,246-1,237 record...the Cougars did not field baseball teams in 1893-94-95-97.
