On Josh Satow:

“He was on it tonight. That is what makes Josh [Satow] great. It was beautiful. We played great defense behind him. When we feel like our defense is good and we throw the ball across the plate, our hitters relax. And when we relax, our hitters are kind of good.”

On the coaching:
