Offensive Player of the Week Nominee:

Dustin Pedroia, Jr., SS, Woodland, Calif.

Junior shortstop Dustin Pedroia broke out of an uncharacteristic 0-for-10 slump by going 4-for-4 with a career-high five RBI in Saturday's 11-3 victory over No. 11 Tulane. He added two hits in Sunday's 5-1 win to finish the weekend against the Green Wave going 6-for-11 (.545) with five runs, two doubles, one home run and six RBI. He hit a leadoff home run in Saturday's victory and had a key two-out, run-scoring double in the seventh to cushion a 2-1 lead in Sunday's 5-1 series-clinching victory. For the season Pedroia leads ASU hitting .439 (36-for-82) with 32 runs scored, 12 doubles, four home runs and 22 RBI. He also had 10 multi-hit games and has recorded at least one hit in 17 of ASU's 20 games.

Pitcher of the Week Nominee:

Erik Averill, So., LHP, Orange, Calif.

Sophomore left-handed pitcher Erik Averill had two solid outings in the series victory over Tulane. Averill fired 4.2 perfect innings in the series opener and came back Sunday to record the win giving up one run in 2.1 innings. In his two outings against the nationally ranked Green Wave, Averill posted a 1.29 ERA giving up only two hits in 7.0 IP. For the season he is 2-0 with a 3.70 ERA in nine appearances and has maintained a stellar 2.01 ERA in 22.1 IP as a reliever.

Notes on ASU Baseball:

The Devils took two of three from No. 11 Tulane in a weekend series at Packard Stadium to improve to 17-3 overall and 11-1 against ranked opponents... ASU had to come back to win the series after dropping the opener 5-3 on Friday night... Friday's loss ended a nine-game win streak and snapped an overall 19-game win streak at Packard Stadium... Saturday's 11-3 victory marked the 2,000th during the varsity era of ASU Baseball (1959-P)... the Devils have a full slate of games on tap with a pair of midweek non-conference games against Oklahoma State (Mar. 16-17) before opening Pac-10 play against California this weekend... ASU hit .283 in the three-game series against the Green Wave and set the tone on the mound with a 2.33 staff ERA... Sunday's 11-3 victory marked the ninth time ASU has scored in double-digits this season... sophomore right fielder Travis Buck (Richland, Wash.) homered in his fifth straight game Friday and was 3-for-9 (.333) in the series... Buck leads the Devils in two of the three triple crown categories with six home runs and 31 RBI... the two-time defending Pac-10 Player of the Week is hitting .418 (28-for-67)... junior shortstop Dustin Pedroia (Woodland, Calif.) went 6-for-8 over the final two games of the series and is leading the team hitting .439 (36-for-82) with four home runs and 12 doubles... Pedroia has recorded 10 multi-hit games and has at least one hit in 17 of ASU's 20 games... with 12 doubles on the season he now has 59 in his career to rank fifth in the ASU record books... he is also sixth with a .387 (238-for-615) career batting average... junior left fielder Jeff Larish was 2-for-4 with three RBI and hit his second home run of the season on Saturday... the pitching staff had another solid weekend to lower the team ERA to 3.32... junior RHP Jason Urquidez (Simi Valley, Calif.) won his sixth straight start to improve to 6-0... he struck out five and gave up only one run in 5.2 innings on Saturday... Urquidez owns a 1.77 ERA and has struck out 33 in 35.2 IP this season... sophomore lefty Brett Bordes (Mesa) gave another solid start Sunday to help the Devils to the series victory... Bordes struck out six in 4.1 innings and now has 21 in 13.0 IP this season (14.54 per 9.0 IP)... freshman RHP Pat Bresnehan (Sherborn, Mass.) continued to dominate in the closer role with his fourth save of the season to seal Sunday's 5-1 victory... Bresnehan added two shutout innings and has not given up an earned run in his last seven appearances (17.1 IP)... in his last six outings (17.0 IP), Bresnehan is 2-0 with four saves and a 0.00 ERA while striking out 22... in nine appearances this season, Bresnehan is 3-0 with four saves and 23 strikeouts in 18.0 IP (1.50 ERA)...

Quoting Coach Murphy:

"It was a great weekend to bounce back after the way we opened up Friday. I thought we didn't have that fire Friday night and you can't play that way against a good team like Tulane. We fought back and really got some great performance over the last two games to win the series. After Friday's loss we won the next 18 innings and that is a big part of our philosophy as a program. It is a long season, but after 20 games I am happy with what I've seen. There is room for a lot of improvement, but we are off to a good start and need to just keep playing hard and playing focused."

HIGHLIGHTS: ASU had a pair of costly errors and squandered some early scoring opportunities as the No. 11 Tulane Green Wave held off the No. 5 Sun Devils 5-3 in a non-conference victory Friday night at Packard Stadium. The Devils had their season-high nine-game win streak come to an end to drop to 15-3 on the year. Additionally, ASU had a 19-game win streak at Packard Stadium snapped and lost for the first time in nine games to a ranked opponent this season. Jeff Mousser (1-1) took the loss and Erik Averill was impressive out of the bullpen with 4.2 perfect innings. Limited to only four hits, the Devils couldn't produce a timely hit by leaving seven of nine runners on base in scoring position. Travis Buck was 2-for-3 with a pair of walks to extend his hitting streak to seven games and hit a home run in his fifth straight game.

HIGHLIGHTS: Dustin Pedroia went 4-for-4 with a career-high five RBI to lead the No. 5 Sun Devils to a convincing 11-3 victory over No. 11 Tulane Saturday afternoon at Packard Stadium. The Devils never trailed in the game, as Pedroia (Woodland, Calif.) jump-started the ASU offense with a leadoff home run in the bottom of the first inning. Junior starting pitcher Jason Urquidez kept his perfect record intact to improve to 6-0. The right-hander allowed four hits and one run in five and two-thirds innings while striking out five. Four of his six wins have come against nationally ranked opponents.

HIGHLIGHTS: Dustin Pedroia and Nick Walsh each had two hits and four Sun Devil pitchers combined to limit the No. 11 Tulane Green Wave to only six hits in a 5-1 victory. The win sealed the series victory for the Sun Devils (17-3). Starting pitcher Brett Bordes struck out six in 4.1 innings and sophomore Erik Averill followed with 2.1 quality innings to pick up the win. Freshman RHP Pat Bresnehan sealed the win with two scoreless innings for his fourth save of the year. Pedroia and Walsh had back-to-back doubles in the seventh to extend a 2-1 lead. Pedroia finished 2-for-4 and Walsh was 2-for-3 with two RBI.
