On the play of the team:

“This is our second regional we’ve been to and the people at Arizona State have been great to us. That’s a hell of a team we’ve played against tonight. We competed our butts off. I’m very proud of our young men, the way they competed. When you are going up against a team of this stature, with this history, our young men could have easily had an excuse to quit. And they didn’t. I’m extremely proud of Brian [Witkowski] and our entire team.”

On the pitching of Michael Barbot:

“[His pitching] was extremely impressive. As most seasons go, he has had an up and down one. Maybe more down than up. We asked him to come in, in a very tight situation. It has been a few weeks since he’s actually pitched. Certainly to come into a game like this and pitch like that, I give him a tremendous amount of credit for what he did for us tonight.”

On fighting back:

I felt real good. I thought that if could start pitching more like ourselves. What were doing offensively, I thought it could have really allowed things to go our way. For whatever reason we walked a couple people and we needed to tighten things up defensively, especially when you are playing an offensive team such as ASU. We needed those guys to keep coming back and coming back. We could have pitched a little bit and tightened up our defense, maybe we wouldn’t have been the position we would have been in despite our efforts offensively.
