Carrick Felix has posted 13 double-doubles which leads Pac-12

Jahii Carson has 16 20-point games and is top freshman scorer in the nation (18.3 ppg.)

MORE GAMES TO PLAY: The Sun Devil men's hoops team (21-12; 9-9 and tied for sixth in the Pac-12 Conference) meets Horizon League Player of the Year Ray McCallum and Detroit (20-12) in the opening round of the National Invitational Tournament on Wednesday, March 20, at 7 p.m. PT on ESPNU. The Sun Devils went 4-5 against the top five teams in the Pac-12 this year, with a sweep of Colorado and single wins over UCLA (1-2) and California (1-0). ASU has notched its fourth 20-win season under Coach Sendek in his seven years, something that ASU did just three times in the prior 25 seasons to his arrival in spring of 2006. ASU is 2-1 vs. Detroit, with the last meeting taking place Dec. 30, 1995, and Detroit winning 71-66 in Tempe. The winner of Detroit/ASU will take on the winner of Baylor/Long Beach State, with date, site and time TBD. The Sun Devils were picked 11th in the preseason media poll but will try and win 22 games for just the tenth time in school history. Jahii Carson, with 16 20-point games (including three 30-pointer), is the nation's top freshman scorer at 18.3 points per game. His 16 20-point games leads the Pac-12 and is tied for the freshman record with the Beard from 2007-08. After going 15-17 at home the past two seasons, ASU went 15-4 in Tempe this season, one win shy of the school record for home wins set in 2009-10 when it was 16-4.

HONORS: Hometown Jahii Carson earned Pac-12 Co-Freshman of the Year honors with Shabazz Muhammad of UCLA, joining Sun Devils Ike Diogu (2002-03), Jamal Faulkner (1990-91) and Byron Scott (1979-80) to earn the honor. He also earned first-team All-Pac-12. Carson then grabbed Pac-12 All-Tournament honors after exploding for 55 points in two games and adding 11 assists, including a Pac-12 Tournament freshman record 34 against Stanford. He made all eight free throws in the two games... senior Carrick Felix earned second-team All-Pac-12 and earned a spot on the five-man Pac-12 All-Defensive Team along with junior Jordan Bachynski, who has set the Pac-12 and Sun Devil season record with 116 blocks on the year.

WHAT HAPPENED IN VEGAS BEEN HAPPENING ALL YEAR: Jahii Carson numbers are simply amazing this year, and here are some of them...posted three 30-point games, no other Sun Devil freshmen posted more than one...averaging a Pac-12 best 37.2 minutes, the best mark by a freshman in Sun Devil history (the Beard lighting up NBA averaged 34.1 in 2007-08)...has set the school freshman mark for assists with 165, breaking the 28-year old mark of 114 set by Bobby Thompson in 1983-84....has 16 20-point games tied with James Harden (2007-08) for most by freshmen in Sun Devil history.

PAC-12 STATS: Jahii Carson averaged 20.8 points in 38.4 minutes and shot .514 (75-of-146) from the floor and had six 20-point games in nine Pac-12 road games. He led Pac-12 with 38.3 minutes per game in 18 league games while Carrick Felix was second (37.7) and Jon Gilling seventh (34.8).

JAHII'S DIGITS: Jahii Carson is averaging 18.3 points and 5.0 assists and only one freshman in the past sixteen years has averaged 17 points and five assists, as Ben Woodside produced those digits in 2005-06 for North Dakota State (17.5 points and 5.1 assists). Previous to Woodside, the last freshmen to notch those digits was Shaheen Holloway of Seton Hall back in 1996-97, when he finished at 17.3 ppg./6.3 apg.

REMINDER JUST HOW MUCH CARRICK IMPROVED: Last season, Carrick Felix had zero double-doubles. This year, he leads the league with 13 on the year and in Pac-12 regular season games he had a league-best nine...in Pac-12 regular season games he averaged 13.9 points and 8.7 rebounds. Only Stanford's Dwight Powell (15.6 ppg. and 8.8 rpg.) was equal in those numbers...Carrick is shooting .497 from the field this year after shooting .411 in his first two seasons...he averaged 2.8 rebounds in his first two seasons but is at 8.2 this season...he shot .284 from the three-point stripe his first two years but is at .367 this season...he earned second-team All-Pac-12, Pac-12 All-Defensive Team and Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year honors.

BLOCK PARTY: ASU has a Pac-12 and ASU record 203 blocks this season (6.2 pg), topping UCLA's 2010-11 Pac-12 record of 199. In Coach Sendek's first six seasons (197 games) at ASU, the Sun Devils had nine blocks four times. It has had at least nine blocks nine times this season. An overlooked statistic for junior Jordan Bachynski is keeping it in play. Of his Pac-12 record 116 blocks, 72 have resulted in possession for ASU. He has 177 career blocks and the Sun Devil career record is 191, held by Mario Bennett from 1991-95. The Pac-12 career record is 278 held by Arizona's Anthony Cook from 1986-89.

DON'T WANT TO FORGET THIS: In ASU's Feb. 2 96-92 loss at Washington, Jahii Carson gave the Huskies 32 points, tied for fourth-most by a freshmen in a Pac-12 road game. Only O.J. Mayo (twice) and Roberto Nelson of Oregon State have had more. Jahii had 22 points in the second half (8-of-14 from floor) with three assists, two steals and no turnovers and his stats in the final 5:01 were ridiculous: 12 points, two assists, one steal and perfect in two three-pointers and four free throws and he had his first dunk.

NIT HISTORY: ASU has appeared in the NIT 11 times (1983, 1990, 1992-94, 1998, 2000, 2002, 2005, 2008 and 2010) and is 5-11 all-time....five current Pac-12 members have won the NIT, as Colorado (1940), Utah (1944), UCLA (1985), Stanford (1991 and 2012) and California (1999)... under Coach Sendek the Sun Devils are 2-2 in the event, beating Alabama State and Southern Illinois in 2008 before falling to Florida and losing to Jacksonville in 2010.

JAHII: Jahii Carson, with 20 points at Oregon State (Jan. 10) and at Oregon (Jan. 13), became the first Sun Devil freshman to get back-to-back 20-point games on a Pac-12 road trip since Steve Beck in the Bay Area on March 1-3, 1984. Beck had four 20-point games in Pac-12 road games, as did James Harden (2007-08), Ike Diogu (2002-03) and Jamal Faulkner (1990-91), but none of that trio did it on the same Pac-12 road weekend. Jahii ended the season with six 20-point games in nine Pac-12 road games.

HERB: Herb Sendek, 119-108 (.524) at ASU, is in his 20th season as a head coach in 2011-2012 and has averaged 18.6 wins. He led the NC State Wolfpack to five straight NCAA appearances from 2002-06 and is now 373-266 (.584) and was 191-132 (.591) at NC State. The 49-year-old (born Feb. 22, 1963) Pittsburgh, Pa., native is the fourth-youngest coach in the Pac-12. Only Duke posted more ACC wins (regular season and ACC Tournament) than NC State's 53 from 2002-2006. Here is an overlooked note is his 10-year stay at NC State: since Pac-12 expanded to 10 teams in 1978-79, only seven coaches have coached at their schools for a decade: Lute Olson (24/UA), Ralph Miller (19/OSU), Mike Montgomery (18/Stanford), Ernie Kent (13/UO), Ben Braun (12/Cal), Lorenzo Romar (11th at UW) and Ben Howland (10th at UCLA).

COACH SENDEK NOTES...

FREE THROWS: NC State under Herb Sendek led the nation and set an ACC record for free throw shooting (.799) in 2003-2004. That mark is tied for tenth-best mark in NCAA history.

POINTS: NC State's 74.5 ppg. in 2005-2006, Coach Sendek's final team in Raleigh, would have been third-highest in Pac-12 last year.

NBA READY: Herb Sendek was one of just three coaches who had a NBA first-round draft pick in 2005 and 2006. Julius Hodge was the No. 20 (Denver Nuggets) in 2005. Cedric Simmons was No. 15 (New Orleans) in 2006.

HISTORY: Herb Sendek was the first coach to knock off the No. 1 seed in the ACC Tournament in consecutive years. NC State beat Maryland (2002) and Wake Forest (2003). Maryland was ranked second while Wake Forest was ninth.

DEFENSE: In Herb Sendek's 10 seasons, NC State led the ACC in scoring defense four times and held opponents to just 54.7 points per game in 1996-97, an ACC record.

FINAL FOURS: Herb Sendek has coached in two Final Fours (1987 Providence and 1993 Kentucky).

THREE: NC State averaged nine threes in 2005-06, best in the ACC and ninth in nation.

YOUNG TALENT: NC State placed seven players on the All-ACC freshman team under Coach Sendek, and James Harden (2007-08, Trent Lockett (2009-10) and Jahii Carson (2012-13) have continued the trend in Tempe.

ASU: After posting just three 20-win seasons in the previous 25 seasons, ASU has posted four 20-win seasons under Herb Sendek in his seven years.

HOME REVIEW: After going 15-17 at home the past two seasons, ASU went 15-4 in Tempe this season, one win shy of the school record for home wins set in 2009-10 when it was 16-4.

JAHII A FINALIST: Jahii Carson was named one of eight finalists for the Integris Wayman Tisdale Freshman of Year Award which was won by Oklahoma State's Marcus Smart. He was joined as finalist by Anthony Bennett (UNLV), Garry Harris (Michigan State), Ben McLemore (Kansas), Shabazz Muhammad (UCLA), Nerlens Noel (Kentucky) and Rasheed Sulaimon (Duke).

CLOSE GAMES STAT: Thirteen of ASU's 20 games against Pac-12 teams were two-possession games (six points or less)...in the 18 Pac-12 regular season games, the scoring margin is exactly 0.1 per game in favor of ASU as the Sun Devils average 66.7 points per game and the opponents 66.6...here is an every crazier one...Six of ASU's eight Pac-10 road games had margins of one point (twice), five points (twice), four points (twice) and three points (once).

ABOUT THE LINEUP: After using 23 starting lineups in the past two seasons and having 14 Sun Devils make a start in that time, ASU was one of six teams to have used the same starting lineup in every game this season...until Feb. 16 at Colorado. Chris Colvin started in place of Evan Gordon. How did Gordon do off the bench? If you consider 14 points, four three-pointers in 30 minutes and hitting a game-winner at the buzzer a good day, he did quite well. ASU has used four starting lineups on the season.

YOUNG COACHES: Herb Sendek, who turned 50 on Feb. 22, earned the Miami of Ohio job in the spring of 1993 at age 30. Three years later he took over the NC State program at age 33. Some 20 years later he ranks near the top of the youngest coaches with at least 350 career Division I wins, as he turned 50 on Feb. 22, 2013. Next up on the list: Greg Marshall at Wichita State (329 wins and born Feb. 27, 1963) and Ron Hunter at Georgia State (311 wins and born on March 7, 1964).

GILLING AND ABLE: Sophomore Jonathan Gilling has 206 rebounds (6.2 pg) after posting 54 last season. He posted a career high 22 at UW on Feb. 2 (including a career-best six threes). Gilling also had 18 points at UCLA on Feb. 27 (including six three-pointers) and at Texas Tech on Dec. 22. He has three double-doubles with 13/11/6 vs. USC on Jan. 24, 12/10 against CU on Jan. 6 and 13/15 vs. Florida A&M on Nov. 18. He leads the Pac-12 at 2.39 three-pointers made per game (79 in 33 games).

ONE POINT: After the Feb. 16 63-62 win at Colorado, the 57-56 loss at USC on March 2 and the 89-88 Pac-12 Tournament overtime win over Stanford on March 13, ASU is 7-6 in one-point games under Coach Sendek, including a 3-1 mark this year as it also beat Utah 55-54 in overtime on Jan. 2. ASU is 4-1 in overtime this year and 10-5 under Coach Sendek in his seven seasons.

2 FIRST NAMES; 3 PAC-12 PLAYER OF WEEKS: Carrick Felix (B.S., Communications 2012) has posted a double-double in eight of the past 15 games. He did not commit a turnover in the 44-minute overtime 98-93 track meet vs. USC on Jan. 24, in the road win at WSU on Jan. 31, in the 40-minute effort vs. Stanford on Feb. 9 or in the grinder OT win at Colorado on Feb. 16. He earned his third Pac-12 Player of the Week award following the UCLA/USC home sweep and had nine double-doubles in 18 Pac-12 games, the most in the league. Twice he has posted a 20-point/10 rebound effort, with 23/11 vs. Washington State on Feb. 20 and 23/11 vs. UCLA on Jan. 26. He was also named the Pac-12 Men's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

COLVIN: Senior Chris Colvin posted his best Pac-12 scoring night of the year at Utah on Feb. 13 with 10 points and matched his season high with six boards, and then also had 10 points at USC on Mar. 2 along with four steals. He has four double-figure scoring games on the year and played a career-high 43 minutes in the Pac-12 Tournament overtime win against Stanford.

NBA=NEW BASKETBALL ASSISTANTS: A three-time conference Coach of the Year entering his 20th season, 49-year old Coach Sendek went the NBA route to fill his staff in August, as he named Eric Musselman and Larry Greer as assistants, the first time since the spring of 2008 Coach Sendek had to hire an assistant. Greer spent the past five seasons working with Nate McMillan at the Portland Trail Blazers as an assistant coach (2011-12) and advance scout (2007-2011). Musselman just recently finished earning league Coach of the Year honors with the Los Angeles D-Fenders of the NBA D-League. His squad had eight NBA call-ups and won the regular season title with a 38-12 record, including wins in 21 of the final 23 games. He coached the Venezuela National Team in 2011 and 2012 at the Pre-Olympics in Argentina while his 2011 team averaged a tournament-best 94.8 points. His NBA experience includes leading the Sacramento Kings to a 101.3 points per game mark in 2006-07, eighth-best in the league as the Kings sold out every home game. In 2002-03 he was second in NBA Coach of the Year voting as he led the Golden State Warriors to their two best seasons in ten years, including a 51-31 (.622) home record. The Warriors were the most improved team in the league with 17 more wins and the second-leading scoring team in the league at 102.4 points per game. He has served as an assistant under Mike Fratello (Memphis), Lon Kruger (Atlanta), Chuck Daley (Orlando) and Doc Rivers (Magic).

1,000-POINT SCORER: Evan Gordon (brother of NBA guard Eric) with 17 points at Oregon on Jan. 14 reached the 1,000-point mark in his college career. He averaged 14.4 points in 2010-11 (460 points) and 12.0 in his freshman year of 2009-10 (372 points) and has 334 points this year (10.1 pg). His 29-point effort vs. Sacramento State on Dec. 1 is a career high including his two years at Liberty as he has 12 20-point games. He made 112 three-pointers in his two-year career at Liberty and led Liberty in scoring (14.4 ppg., eighth in Big South) in his sophomore year (2010-11) before transferring to ASU. He now has 1,166 career points.

FROM ACC: From 2001-2002 season through 2005-2006 (Herb's final five seasons) NC State won 53 total ACC games (regular season and ACC tournament). Only Duke was better (76) in that time frame. Maryland also had 53.

DEVELOPING: After not playing his senior year in high school (2007-08) due to an injury and then taking two years off from hoops for LDS Mission to Miami (2008-10), Jordan Bachynski (ba-CHIN-ski) has developed into a solid post presence. One thing to keep in mind about his development is how two of ASU's past big men developed, as in his senior year (2008-09) Jeff Pendergraph led the nation in field goal percentage (.660) en route to become the first pick of the second round in the 2009 NBA Draft, while Eric Boateng, who played for the 2012 Great Britain Olympic team, led the Pac-10 in field goal percentage in 2009-10 (.665).

THE FIRST: Junior Jordan Bachynski's 13 points, 12 boards and 12 blocks vs. Cal State Northridge on Dec. 8 is the only triple-double in Sun Devil history. He set school record with 12 blocks, topping his own mark of nine set in the opener on Nov. 10 vs. Central Arkansas. It marked first triple-double by a Pac-10/12 player since Daniel Hackett had 22 points, 10 rebounds and 10 dimes vs. South Carolina on Nov. 17, 2007. The 12 blocks is tied for the second-most by a Pac-10/12 player along with Stanford's Brook Lopez, who had a dozen vs. USC on Jan. 25, 2007.

NBA: Two Sun Devils are NBA coaches, as Byron Scott (Cleveland Cavaliers) and Lionel Hollins (Memphis Grizzlies) are also two of the three Sun Devils to have their numbers hanging in the rafters of Wells Fargo Arena (1964 Olympic gold medalist Joe Caldwell is the other). IU has three players coaching NBA teams in Keith Smart, Randy Wittman and Mike Woodson (along with manager Lawrence Franks), while LMU has Rick Adelman and Mike Dunlap.

PAC-10 COACH OF YEAR: Herb Sendek became the second Sun Devil to earn Pac-10 Coach of the Year in ASU's first 32 Pac-10 seasons in 2009-10 (Ned Wulk/1978-79). What is even more eye opening is the 30 years between Sun Devil winners. That is nothing new as his 2003-04 ACC honor was NC State's first in 15 seasons (Jim Valvano/1988-89).

JACOBSEN UPDATE: Hamilton High School's Eric Jacobsen had 16 points vs. Hartford on Dec. 5, the most by a Sun Devil freshmen off the bench since Trent Lockett had 17 vs. Texas State on Nov. 16, 2009...team's youngest player (born in June of 1994)...entered Sacramento State Dec. 1 game with 10 rebounds on the year and three offensive rebounds and then used his size 17 shoes to post six offensive boards and nine total rebounds in 16 minutes.

WINS VS. THE TOP GUYS: We are not sure how many current coaches are able to say they got a W over the top two coaches in terms of wins in college basketball history, but Coach Sendek is one of them. Coach Sendek topped Coach K while at NC State on three occasions. NC State beat top-ranked Duke 78-74 in Raleigh on Feb. 15, 2004 and the year prior beat third-ranked Duke 80-71 on Jan. 22, 2003. His other win was in the 1997 ACC Tournament on March 7 when the Wolfpack shocked seventh-ranked Duke on the way to the ACC title game in his first season. The win over Jim Boeheim's Syracuse squad was an 82-68 win over the ninth-ranked Orangemen in the Carrier Dome on Dec. 8, 2001. Among other top-10 coaches, Coach Sendek posted single wins over Jim Calhoun (873 career wins) which was a win to get NC State to the Sweet Sixteen, Jim Phelan of Mt. St. Mary's (830 career wins) and one win over Lute Olson (780 wins), which was a 1995 NCAA Tournament victory in Dayton. Coach Sendek was 0-1 vs. Bob Knight, as his Miami (Ohio) squad lost at Indiana 92-77 on Dec. 10, 1994.

COACH OF YEAR: The Pac-12 has six current coaches who have earned Pac-10/12 Coach of the Year. Herb Sendek earned it in 2009-10, while Dana Altman (2012-13), Sean Miller (2010-11), Lorenzo Romar (2011-12, 2008-09 and 2004-05) and Ben Howland (2005-06) earned kudos at their school. Mike Montgomery did it four times at Stanford (2003-04, 2002-03, 1999-2000 and 1998-99).

HOW THEY WERE PICKED: Arizona was picked to win the Pac-12 by 36 media members it was announced on Pac-12 Media Day Nov. 1. Here is how the voting broke down: 1. Arizona (15 first-place votes/403 total points), 2. UCLA (16/402), 3. California (3/325), 4. Stanford (296), 5. Washington (2/278), 6. Colorado (262), 7. Oregon (217), 8. Oregon State (166), 9. MANY WINS, MANY PLACES: Colorado in January of 2013 became the 26th state where Herb Sendek has won a game during his 20-year head coaching career. He has won multiple games in North Carolina (152), Arizona (85), Ohio (51), California (13), Florida (9), Oregon (7), Michigan (6), South Carolina (5), Virginia (5), Georgia (4), Indiana (4), Massachusetts (3), New York (3), Nevada (3), Texas (3), Washington (3), Alaska (2), Hawaii (2) and Maryland (2). He also has won two games in Puerto Rico and one in Washington D.C. One win states are Alabama, Colorado, Illinois, Kentucky, New Jersey, Oklahoma, Tennessee and Utah.

100: In his 20-year coaching career, only three teams have scored 100 points against Herb Sendek. The last team to do it was No. 1 Duke in a 108-71 at Cameron on Feb. 14, 2002.

PAC-10/12 POY: In the past 14 years, ASU has had three Pac-10 Players of the Year, as only Cal (four) can top that number. Eddie House won the honor in 1999-2000, Ike Diogu in 2004-05 and James Harden in 2008-09. UCLA has had two while Arizona, USC, Oregon, Stanford and Washington have had one each.

FEATHER IN THE CAP: ASU became just the third Pac-10 team to win three straight in McKale Center in the past 29 seasons (1983-84 to 2011-12) when Herb Sendek's squad beat UA 73-69 on Feb. 21, 2010. Stanford under Mike Montgomery won four straight from 2001-04 and UCLA under Ben Howland won three straight (2006-08).



Sun Devil Coach Herb Sendek

Head Coach 🏆 20th Season 🏆 7 NAAs 🏆 373-266 Career

A 1985 graduate of Carnegie-Mellon (Pa.), Herb Sendek **is 373-266 (.584) in his 20 seasons as a head coach and has a 119-108 (.524) record** in seven seasons at Arizona State. Heading into the 2012-13 season, Sendek's 606 games as a head coach ranked third in the Pac-12 and his 352 Division I wins were fourth-best in the conference. He is a three-time conference Coach-of-the-Year recipient and has made seven NCAA Tournament appearances.



Sendek led ASU to three straight 20-win seasons in 2007-08 (21-13), 2008-09 (25-10) and 2009-10 (22-11), which had not happened since 1961-63. Prior to his four 20-win seasons, ASU had just three 20-win seasons in the previous 25 years. Between 2007-10, Sendek led ASU to 68 wins, a school record 16 home wins in 2009-10, seven wins over ranked teams, five straight wins against Arizona and six-of-seven overall, including three consecutive in Tucson, and a sweep of UCLA in 2008-09.

He was 191-132 (.591) at North Carolina State in 10 seasons. He earned Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year in 2003-04 and has taken 15 teams to the postseason. He posted five 20-win seasons, including his final three, while competing in one of the nation's most intense conferences.

After eight years as an assistant, including Final Four appearances in 1987 with Providence and 1993 with Kentucky, 30-year-old Sendek took over the Oxford-based program at Miami (Ohio). There, in his first venture as a head coach, he led the Redskins to three consecutive postseason appearances and the 1995 Mid-American Conference regular-season championship. His three-year record at Miami was 63-26, giving him the highest winning percentage (.708) in school history.



Sendek has collected 36 wins over teams ranked in the top 25, including 16 over top-10 teams. He has had nine former assistant coaches (eight in 2012-13) earn D-I head coaching positions.

He was one of only three coaches who had NBA first-round picks in both the 2005 and 2006 drafts, and then followed that up in 2009 with a top-three pick (James Harden at No. 3) and the first pick of the second round (Jeff Pendergraph).
