Three Dot Data...

NAU is playing its 99th season of football dating back to the 1915 season...Head Coach Jerome Souers has posted an 9-5 record in 14 previous season openers...NAU is playing its 12th game against a Pac-12 Conference opponent in the last 12 seasons (Oregon State in 2001, Arizona in 2002, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2009, 2011 and Arizona State in 2003, 2006, 2008 and 2010)...NAU has not beat a NCAA FBS or I-A opponent since 1987, posting a 7-46 all-time record in matchups against FBS/I-A opponents since 1957...Northern Arizona was ranked No. 27 in the Sports Network Preseason poll and No. 39 in the first FCS Coaches Poll, while the Lumberjacks were listed at No. 14 in Phil Steele's FCS College Football Preview magazine...Zach Bauman needs six yards to reach the 2,500 mark for his career...

Series History...

NAU and ASU have met 38 times dating back to 1915. The Sun Devils lead the all-time series 20-14-4 and have won eight consecutive games in the series including a 41-20 win in 2010. The meeting in 2003 was the first between the schools since 1950 despite the short distance (153 miles) between the two campuses. NAU and ASU played regularly as members of the Border Conference back in the day.

Scoreboard Watching...

NAU has played close to Arizona State for stretches in three of the last four meetings. In 2003, NAU scored the opening points of the game and led 7-6 at the completion of the first quarter. In 2006, NAU again scored first and was tied at 14 with the Sun Devils entering the fourth quarter. In 2010, the Lumberjacks pulled within 27-20 with six seconds left in the third quarter on a touchdown pass by Michael Herrick. But NAU was out-scored 14-0 in the final quarter as the Sun Devils pulled out the victory.

Five of the seven losses in 2011 were by eight points or less and by a combined 20 points including four games by four points or less. The only double digit losses were at FBS and Pac 12 member Arizona and FCS playoff participant and former No. 1 team in the country, Montana State.

Arizona's Team...NAU has 44 players on its roster from the state Arizona, the most of any of the three Arizona Division I schools.

Bauman in the Books...

Junior running back Zach Bauman ranks fifth in school history with 2,494 career rushing yards in 22 games, trailing Allan Clark (1975-78) by 229 yards for fourth all-time entering the season and 1,300 yards behind all-time leader Marcus King (1998-01). He is 10th among active players in the FCS in career rushing yards and third among returning juniors. He joined Archie Amerson (1995, 1996), Marcus King (2000, 2001) and Alex Henderson (2006, 2009) to rush for 1,000 yards two times in their careers and only Amerson and King have done it in back-to-back seasons. He is the first back in school history to rush for 1,000 yards in each of his first two seasons after setting the freshman rushing mark in 2010. The Chandler Hamilton product has 13 career 100-yard games in his career and two games of 200 or more yards, including 246 at Sacramento State and 219 against Idaho State in 2011.

Arizona State Connections...

Anders Battle's mother, Anna, ran track at Arizona State, as did brothers Avery and Allante...Father, Greg, played at ASU and professionally for the Winnipeg Blue Bombers from 1987-1993 and from 1997-1998...NAU's Covaughn Deboskie-Johnson (California) played four seasons in the Pac-10 for the Bears, earning his degree in May. Junior college transfer Jake Johnston played high school football with ASU starting quarterback Taylor Kelly in Idaho at Eagle High School. Mike Dosen and Nick Cole both started their careers at the University of Oregon.

Network Debut...

NAU will be part of Thursday's opening day of football broadcasts on the Pac-12 Networks. Action will get underway with Utah taking on Northern Colorado of the Big Sky at 4 pm. PST with the Sun Devil-Lumberjack matchup to follow. Ron Pitts will provide the play-by-play with Gary Plummer serving as the game analyst. Erin Coscarelli will provide the sideline reports. The game will be broadcast on Pac-12 Arizona on Cox Communications channels 75/1075 HD and Suddenlink channels in Flagstaff. Grossart Returns at Quarterback...

Senior Cary Grossart returns as the starting quarterback for the Lumberjacks after starting all 11 games last season. Grossart went 20-for-26 for 179 yards with a touchdown and an interception in a 41-10 loss to Arizona in his starting debut last season. He led the Lumberjacks on two scoring drives in the second quarter to close the score to 14-10 at the half and completed 16 consecutive passes, two short of the school record held by current assistant Jeff Lewis of 18. He has thrown at least one touchdown pass in seven consecutive games.

Repeat Performance?...

The Lumberjack offense ranked 14th in the Football Championship Subdivision in 2011 in total offense, producing the Big Sky's top rusher and pass efficiency leader. Bauman ranked fourth in the country in rushing with over 1,400 yards with seven games over 100 yards on the season. The Lumberjacks posted the top passing efficiency mark in the Big Sky and ranked sixth in the nation in 2011 behind the play of Grossart.

New Home in the Dome...

The Lumberjacks will play their second full season in the \$26 million newly renovated Walkup Skydome, including new press box, suites, chair back seating and locker rooms.

Big Sky Preseason Polls

The Northern Arizona football team is predicted to finish seventh by the coaches and ninth by the media in the Big Sky Preseason polls released at the Media Days event.

The Lumberjacks received 75 points in the Coaches Poll just behind Weber State. Montana State was the favorite in both polls, receiving seven of the nine first-place votes from the coaches and 30 of the 37 first-place votes in the media poll.

Coming off a season that featured five losses by a combined 20 points, the Northern Arizona football team will look to turn around its fortunes this season and make a bid for the Football Championship Subdivision playoffs for the first time since 2003.

Just Kicking It...

The Lumberjacks will have new starters at both placekicker and punter this season. Departed senior Matt Myers took every field goal attempt over the last three seasons, while classmate Drew Zamora handled all but four punts and seven kickoffs (all by Wilder). Andy Wilder has served as the backup the last two seasons and a redshirt campaign. He will start at punter and handle kickoff duties while true freshman Ryan Hawkins will handle the kicking duties.

Souers' Among Big Sky's Best...

Head Coach Jerome Souers ranks fifth on the Big Sky's all-time victories list with 76 wins. Only former coaches Chris Ault (Nevada), Don Reed (Montana) and Bobby Hauck (Montana) and current Idaho State coach Mike Kramer (EWU/MSU) have won more games in conference history. Souers became the all-time winningest coach in school history in 2008, surpassing Max Spilsbury's 58 wins from 1956-64. He has the longest tenure of any football coach in school history and joins Nevada's Chris Ault and Idaho State's Mike Kramer as the only coaches in Big Sky history to serve 14 seasons or more as a head coach in the league.

Rich Scangarello and Jeff Lewis join the staff for the 2012 season. Scangarello takes over as the offensive coordinator and quarterback coach duties for the departed Brian Lindgren. Lewis joins the staff as the wide receivers coach. He is a member of the NAU Hall of Fame after a stand-out career for the Lumberjacks from 1992-95. He played in the NFL for the Denver Broncos, Carolina Panthers and New Orleans Saints from 1997-2002 after being a fourth round selection of the Broncos in the 1996 Draft. He was part of two Super Bowl teams during his career.

Football's Zach Bauman Named to Walter Payton Watch List

Northern Arizona junior running back Zach Bauman was one of the 20 nominees named to the Walter Payton Award Watch List.

"It is an honor to even be considered," said Bauman. "It is something you dream about and have worked real hard towards. For it to actually come into play, it is real exciting."

The candidacy for Bauman and the 19 other candidates began as the race for the 26th annual Payton Award kicked off with The Sports Network's announcement of a stellar Watch List for the Football Championship Subdivision's top individual honor.

After the season, the most outstanding player in the FCS will join a list of Payton Award greats such as Steve McNair, John Friesz, Brian Westbrook, Tony Romo, Brian Finneran, Armanti Edwards and 2011 winner Bo Levi Mitchell. NAU's Archie Amerson won the award in 1996.

Bauman led the Big Sky Conference in rushing at 130.5 yards per game (fifth in the FCS) and ranked ninth in total offense and fourth in scoring. He rushed for 1,435 yards, the third-best total in school history, with 15 touchdowns, the second-best total in school history, while recording 1,787 all-purpose yards from scrimmage. He was also third on the team with 29 receptions for 352 yards and one touchdown. The Chandler, Ariz., product posted seven 100-yard rushing games on the season, including five consecutive to end the season and totaled 100 or more yards in seven of the last eight overall.

The 2011 finalists returning to the Watch List are quarterbacks Casey Brockman of Murray State, DeNarius McGhee of Montana State and Brad Sorensen of Southern Utah; running backs Shakir Bell of Indiana State, Jordan Brown of Bryant, Jamaine Cook of Youngstown State, Timothy Flanders of Sam Houston State, Andrew Pierce of Delaware and Terrance West of Towson; fullback Eric Breitenstein of Wofford; and wide receivers Aaron Mellette of Elon and Rodrick Rumble of Idaho State.

Joining the Watch List are quarterbacks Taylor Heinicke of Old Dominion, Kurt Hess of Youngstown State and Jeff Mathews of Cornell; running backs Bauman, Matt Denham of Eastern Kentucky and Miguel Maysonet of Stony Brook; all-purpose player Richard Sincere of Sam Houston State; and wide receiver Ryan Spadola of Lehigh.

ARIZONA STATE 41, NORTHERN ARIZONA 20 GAME 2 - SEPT. 11, 2010 - TEMPE, ARIZ. SUN DEVIL STADIUM (49,043)

In a game not decided until the fourth quarter, the Northern Arizona football team was defeated by Arizona State 41-20 Saturday night at Sun Devil Stadium in front of 49,043 fans.

The Lumberjacks played tough, pulling within a touchdown at 27-20 when quarterback Michael Herrick hit Khalil Paden for a 35-yard score with 21 seconds left in the third quarter. But the Sun Devils added two scores in the decisive final quarter to seal the victory over their in-state rivals from the north.

ASU quarterback Steven Threet completed 33-for-49 for 391 yards and three touchdowns to lead the ASU offense. Devil wide receiver Mike Willie had eight receptions for 114 yards and a touchdown. The Sun Devils were held to just 56 yards on the ground on 29 carries on the night.

Junior Austin Shanks tied for game-high honors with eight receptions for 66 yards for the Lumberjacks and added a 34-yard pass to Chasen Stangel in the second quarter. Herrick finished 13-for-26 for 131 yards with a touchdown and interception in the contest.

Practice attendance is a privilege that will be revoked with the publication of any strategy, game plan or injury-related information that may be obtained during practice observation.

All health-related questions regarding student-athletes will be addressed by Souers on Fridays when the medical and athletic training staffs have made the travel and dress roster decisions. Discussions will be based on proper federal

HIPPA guidelines regarding student-athlete privacy.

Academic Performance

All academic performance issues will be addressed by Souers under the Family Educational Rights Privacy Act (FERPA) guidelines.

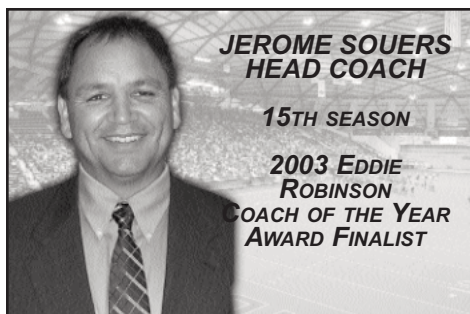


Big Sky Conference Coaches Conference Call

Entering his 15th year as head coach of the Northern Arizona football program, Jerome Souers, the dean of the Big Sky Conference coaches, has taken the Lumberjack program to new milestones. Under Souers, NAU made a record-breaking NCAA I-AA Quarterfinal appearance in 2003, won the first Big Sky Conference title since 1978, recorded two playoff berths and posted eight winning seasons. During his 14-year tenure, Souers has coached 119 student-athletes to all-conference honors a combined 196 times with 44 first-team selections and 42 All-Americans accolades.

Souers, who was named the 1999 Big Sky Conference Coach of the Year, also has the Lumberjacks posting impressive results in the classroom. The football program has produced the Golden Eagle Scholar Athlete of the Year six times (Blair Boynton, Eric Damko, Steve Gomez, Mark Gould, Paul Ernster and Jeff Wheeler) and had a program-best 14 student-athletes named to the 2011 Big Sky Fall All-Academic team. Overall, 69 student-athletes have earned 122 Big Sky academic honors over the last 14 seasons. There have also been six Academic All-Americans, as well.

Souers increased the program's Academic Progress Rate, a real-time measure of eligibility, retention and graduation of student-athletes, five straight academic years (872 to 953) and had the highest multi-year rate in the Big Sky Conference in 2011, earning the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Athletics Directors Association APR Award. The award is given to the highest APR score in each of the 14 FCS conferences.

But there is still work ahead. Souers, who has coached a national champion, strives everyday to get his Lumberjack program in position to play for the title not just a playoff appearance or high ranking. And the 2003 season was his best effort to date, earning him finalist honors for the 2003 Eddie Robinson Award, an award presented by The Sports Network to the top head coach in I-AA football.

Behind the play of true freshman Big Sky Offensive Player of the Year Jason Murrietta, the Lumberjacks upset top-seeded McNeese State on the road and played host to the first home playoff game since 1996 with a quarterfinal appearance against Florida Atlantic. NAU finished ranked 10th in the national polls as Souers' players were honored on and off the field for their performances. Eighteen players

were recognized with All-Big Sky honors highlighted by first-team All-America accolades for punter Mark Gould, who was recognized by five different organizations. Gould led the accolades off the field, too. He was a CoSIDA Academic All-America selection for the second consecutive season as NAU led the nation with five CoSIDA academic all-district selections.

In 2006, Murrietta led a reemergence that produced significant improvements in the offensive production, resulting in a winning season with six wins and ranking among the top turnarounds in the country. Murrietta had a stellar senior season highlighted by a runner-up finish for the Walter Payton Award, All-America honors and his second Big Sky Conference Offensive Player of the Year award. He threw for 2,827 yards with a 65.0 completion percentage and a school-record 34 touchdowns, leading the Big Sky in passing efficiency (168.2) and total offense (243.1), while ranking fifth and 11th nationally.

Souers arrived in Flagstaff after spending 12 years at Montana with a proven track record. His last eight seasons in Missoula he served as defensive coordinator. During his stay with the Grizzlies, Montana was transformed from a Big Sky also-ran into a perennial league and national title contender. Souers' tenure in Missoula produced 12 straight winning seasons, seven playoff berths, four appearances in the national semifinals, a national runner-up finish (1996) and a national title (1995). Montana won three Big Sky titles during that span.

Souers and his wife, Paula, have two daughters, Anna (23) and Alaina (21).
