

ASU: Talented, exciting receiver who has emerged as ASU's go-to guy...sensational player who has the ability to run after the catch...pre- and postseason awards candidate...has been named a 2005 *Playboy* preseason All-American, the 14th Sun Devil to earn that distinction...was a semifinalist for the Biletnikoff Award and a second-team All-American last season...has led the team in receiving in each of the last two seasons...is the second player in ASU history to turn in



back-to-back 1,000-yard receiving campaigns...should become ASU's career leader in yards, receptions and receiving in 2005...heads into his senior season needing just eight receptions, 265 yards and six touchdowns to set ASU's career records in each category...ranks second on ASU's career lists with 181 receptions and third with 2,729 yards and 19 receiving touchdowns...will be a four-year starter in 2005...has already turned in more 100-yard receiving games than any player in school history (14)...has caught a pass in 29 straight games, which is the second-longest active streak in the nation...was recognized as a Hard Hat Player for his work in ASU's winter strength and conditioning program for the second consecutive season.

2004: Played in all 12 games, starting 11...was one of 11 semifinalists for the 2004 Biletnikoff Award, which is annually presented to the top wide receiver in the nation...earned second-team All-Pac-10 honors after being named an honorable-mention all-league selection in 2003...was also a second-team All-America and All-Pac-10 selection by rivals.com...ranked second in the Pac-10 and seventh in the nation with 104.0 receiving yards per game...set the school record for receiving yards per game, while his 83 receptions and 1,248 yards both ranked second on the ASU single-season charts...was also second in the conference and 12th in the nation with 6.9 catches per game...caught 10 touchdown passes, which tied for sixth on the ASU singleseason charts...averaged 15.0 yards per reception...turned in 100 or more receiving yards in eight games to set the school single-season mark...led the team in receiving in nine of 12 games...passed the 100-yard mark in each of the first three games of the year and ended the season with four straight 100yard contests...caught nine passes for 182 yards (both season highs) with one touchdown vs. Purdue in the Sun Bowl...was named to the ESPN.com All-Bowl Team for his efforts against the Boilermakers...made eight receptions in each of the first three games of the season...hauled in four or more catches in every game in 2004...turned in eight catches for 154 yards and two TDs Sept. 11 at Northwestern...tied his career best with three TD catches Oct. 23 against UCLA...tallied 160 yards and the three scores on just five receptions vs. the Bruins...had four TD receptions of 40 yards or more, including a season-best 79-yard scoring strike vs. UCLA.

2003: Played in all 12 games with 10 starts...earned honorable-mention All-Pac-10 honors...led the team with 66 receptions and 1,076 receiving yards...scored nine touchdowns, which tied for seventh in the Sun Devil recordbook...ranked fifth in the Pac-10 and 20th in the country with an average of 89.7 receiving yards per game...also led the team and finished seventh in the league with 5.5 receptions per game...caught at least three passes in every game of the season...averaged 16.3 yards per reception...turned in six 100-yard receiving games...recorded career highs in receptions and receiving yards Oct. 18 at North Carolina with 11 receptions for 185 yards...set up ASU's game-winning touchdown against the Tar Heels with a 42-yard catch to bring the ball down to the UNC five-yard line on the final drive...his 11 receptions in that game tied with three other Sun Devils for the fourth-best single-game effort in school history...scored a career-high three touchdowns Nov. 8 at Stanford...ended the season with a streak of three straight 100-yard games...caught an 80-yard pass Nov. 28 at Arizona.

2002: Played in all 14 games, starting three..broke the ASU freshman record for receptions with 32, a mark previously held by College Football Hall of Famer John Jefferson (since broken by Zach Miller)...trailed Jefferson (and now Miller) with 405 yards...had a reception in every game but two...finished the year third on the team in receptions with 32...gained 405 receiving yards for an average of 12.7 yards per catch..had a big game in ASU's comeback win at then No. 6 Oregon with five catches for 95 yards, including a 51-yard reception...earned a place on the *Sporting News* Pac-10 All-Freshman team.

HIGH SCHOOL: A 2002 graduate of Palmdale (Calif.) High School...earned honorable-mention all-region honors by *PrepStar Magazine*...listed as the No. 65 player in the Farwest by *PrepStar*...ranked as the No. 113 player in the Farwest by *SuperPrep*... earned all-city honors his senior season...earned all-conference honors his junior and senior seasons...caught 65 passes for 843 yards and five touchdowns as a senior...his 843 yards set a school record...added nine interceptions on defense...was All-C.I.F. by the *Los Angeles Daily News*...made the All-*Valley Press* team as a senior...caught 19 passes for 303 yards on offense and had 23 tackles and four interceptions on defense as a junior...was the team MVP as a junior and a senior...also triple jumped 46 feet and averaged 12 points and five rebounds in basketball...coached by Jeff Williams...was a team captain in three sports his senior year (football, basketball & track).

PERSONAL: Is pursuing a degree in interdisciplinary studies (business and justice studies)...parents are Derek and Emelina...has two sisters, Jasmine (14) and Angela (11), and one brother, Raul (10)...born Sept. 21, 1984...full name is Derek Steven Hagan.
