The Sun Devil Softball squad (41-15 overall, 10-11 Pac-10) will kick the door open on the program's 24th trip to the postseason looking to make it five consecutive trips to the WCWS, with the journey beginning in the Amherst Regional. In this weekend's field are: Boston University, Long Island and UMass. First up for the Sun Devils are the Boston University Terriers Friday afternoon at 5 p.m. ET.

SERIES HISTORY

First in the competing field this weekend are the Boston University Terriers whom the Sun Devils have never gone head-to-head with until this Friday. Way to kick a series history off with a bang!

Up next are the Long Island Blackbirds who ASU has seen in the past with the Sun Devils holding a 3-0 record since 2005 against LIU. All-time against Long Island, Clint Myers is 1-0. Their last meeting came in 2006... in the first round of the NCAA Tournament at the Hofstra Regional. Where ASU pulled off a 6-0 win.

Last but most certainly not least are the UMass Minutewomen, whom ASU are giving way more than a minutes thought about. All time against the wily home team from this weekend ASU is 10-2. Don't let the record fool you though. The last time these teams met up was last season in Palm Springs where the pitchers battled it out... and UMass prevailed as the victor 1-0. All-time against UMass Clint Myers is 0-1.

UP NEXT

Should the Sun Devils emerge as the victor of the Amherst Regional, they'd take on the winners of the Gainesville Regional who's top seed are the 2009 WCWS runner-up themselves, the Florida Gators.

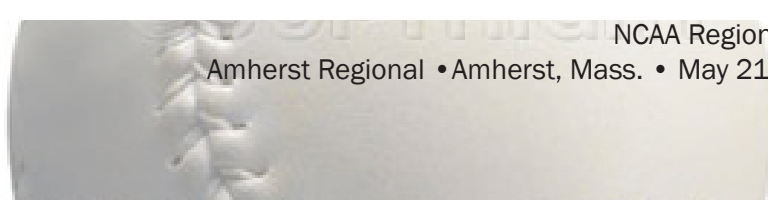

After another intense Pac-10 season, the Sun Devils dotted their names in both team and individual standings all over the dang place.

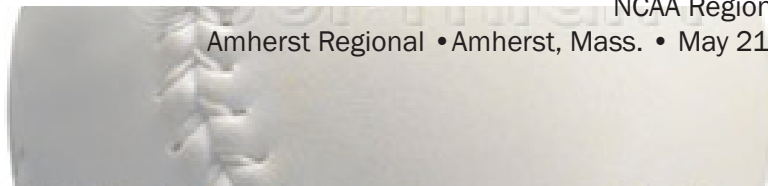

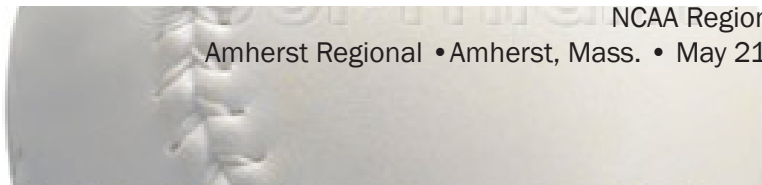

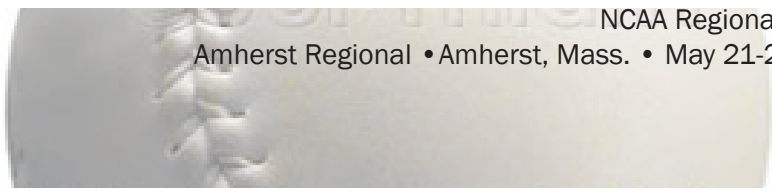

SMOKING SENIOR

Senior, Caylyn Carlson has battled off injuries all fall and into the beginning of this year to come back at full force for 2010. After being in & out of the line-up through the season, Carlson is hitting .349 on the season with six doubles and nine home runs already to her tally to boost her to fourth on the team in batting average and second in slugging percentage. She's already cracked 35 RBIs, with three grand slams on the year proving she's here to play. So much so that she's hitting a lethal .545 with bases loaded. That's just silly good. She's already listed all over the Pac-10 and NCAA stats this season as well as on the ASU single-season and career lists.

TEAM WITH A DREAM:

While the 2010 Sun Devil Softball team is chasing a second NCAA title, they also have other goals in mind. 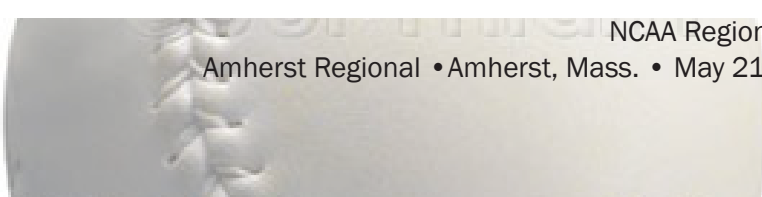

THAT TANTALIZING THIRD...

There's something about the third inning that gets ASU's engine's revving as they have posted 367 runs on the year but for some reason, they've scored 10 more runs in the third than in any other inning with their 75 plate touches in the third.

BIG POWER, LITTLE PACKAGE

A now-junior transfer from Louisville, Kaylyn Castillo showed up on ASU's doorstep last season and has refused to produce nothing but power. The tiny catcher has a quick arm behind the plate and even quicker bat while at it. She's currently batting .321 with 39 RBIs and three home runs, one at Easton Stadium, the second year she's hit one there. Lil Castillo also holds third on the team with 10 multiple RBI games and with multiple hit games with 14. Here's a little fun fact as well, while the little catcher that could has remained fiesty all season, her batting average has actually IMPROVED in Pac-10 play. A rare feat.

BEAT EM' TO THE SCOREBOARD

Sun Devils have a goal of ensuring they put up runs before their opponents do...and when they have scored first this season, they're 32-4.

DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK...

Don't count them out if they can't post the first run though, as they're not as potent, but still scrappy with a 9-11 record on the season when their opponent takes it to them first.

HOME SWEEEEEEET HOME

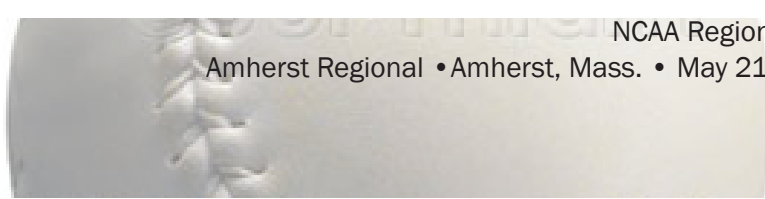
The Sun Devils have found their home at Farrington Stadium to be a welcome one. Last season they held a 36-5 overall record at home. They're currently 32-10 playing in Farrington Stadium in 2010.

OH MERCY, MERCY ME...

The Sun Devils seem to have a habit of giving opponents a bit of mercy. Out of 38 games, ASU has mercy-ruled opponents 13 times... including the program's first run-rule of Arizona on April 2 with an 11-1 win in five.

OH BOY, OH BOYD!

Sophomore shortstop is kicking buns and taking names... or just putting hers everywhere. With her crafty glove play giving ASU one of the best middles in the nation, (did I mention, they're SECOND in the nation in double plays turned?!) her bat is giving them something to talk about. Already inching into ASU record books, Boyd is ruling the roost in the Pac-10 with top-10 rankings in batting average, home runs, and dang near every offensive category as well as pasting her name all over NCAA stats as well. Boyd makes sure her Devils are taken care of as she's leading the team in multiple hit games with 18 and 13 multiple RBI games. She's also posted as high as a 15 game hitting streak already this season. And to prove she's tougher than nails (what an awful pun!) she shattered two fingers taking a ball off her left hand against UCLA on April 9 and came back to hit in the next two games with no sign of slowing down.



IT'S MS. ROGERS' NEIGHBORHOOD...

Junior Lesley Rogers has stepped up to bat in her first season as an upperclassman where she's taken over as one of the premier slappers for the Sun Devils where through the season she's found herself hitting .459 when she's leading off for A State. She enjoys having friends on the bases as well as she's hitting .414 with runners on and a ridiculous .500 with a runner on third and less than two outs. Her success in advancing runners is also something to marvel at as 65% of the time she gets the job done every time ;). While nationally ranked in pulling walks, Rogers also shows her smart pitch selection as she collected a 21-game hitting streak this season.

LOCK IT UP, No, YOU LOCK IT UP...

Sophomore Annie Lockwood has come into her own this season as she didn't see the playing field much her freshman season to a full-time starter with a punch to pack. She's just behind Katelyn Boyd and Lesley Rogers and tied with Kaylyn Castillo with 14 multiple hit games and second on the team with 11 multiple RBI games. She also posted a ten game hitting streak on the season as well. None to shabby to go from the bench to the clean-up spot....

PARLICH-ITY SPLIT

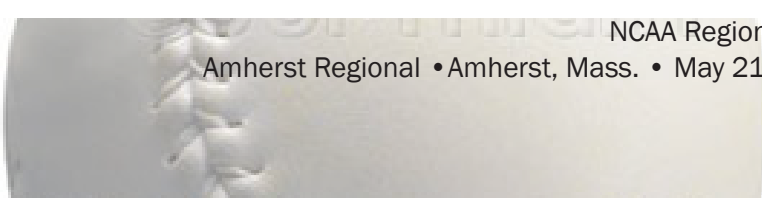
Froshie Sam Parlich has jumped out of the minors and right into the bigs as she's come right out of high school to snag a starting spot for the Sun Devils. Parlich has come out to be a triple threat for ASU as she has the ability to flash the leather at second base, swing the bat with a .311 average on the season and one of the hardest hitters in the NCAA to strikeout. Then on the flipside? The girl can hurl it as she currently holds a 7-6 record in the circle. She's already posted two two-hit complete game shutouts with 45 strikeouts to her tally. She also made a little history in her first year as she pitched the Sun Devils to their first run-rule victory over the Arizona Wildcats, holding the top-ranked scoring team to just one run in the game. To add insult to injury....she added an RBI triple to her tally in the 11-1 win. To add to her history theme her play and pitching win against No. 5 UCLA also helped make history for ASU... with the first three-game program sweep over UCLA in Westwood.

RISP-Y BUSINESS...

A State is no sloth when it comes to bringin' em on home as they are currently tenth in the nation in scoring and a lot of that is due to their success with a few ducks on the pond... or at least ones in scoring position. As a team overall the Sun Devils are hitting .315. And with runners on third and less than two outs? Forget about it, as ASU is slaughtering a .509 average. And call me a braggart, but hitting .317 with bases juiced is no laughing matter for opposing teams.

NIGHTTIME IS THE RIGHT TIME?

While they may be Sun Devils, ASU isn't afraid of a little mood lighting as they've posted a 20-6 record in night games. But give these Devils a lil sun and they shine as they hold a 21-9 record in day games.



YOU'LL PITCH YOUR ARM OFF!

If anything has been proven this season, it's that the Sun Devils are here to make teams WORK for the W. Pushing opposing pitchers to an average of 132 pitches thrown per-game, they've kicked it up even higher in Pac-10 play. Against Arizona, they made Kenzie Fowler throw 182 pitches in their first match-up and 111 in their second match-up. Against the UCLA Bruins? Donna Kerr threw 154 in the first game and 145 in the second, rendering her near unable to pitch the third. And in the third? Whitney Baker threw 105... to Hillary Bach's 85. Against Stanford, they forced over 300 pitches over the three games, and against Oregon State they demanded a whopping 413 pitches for a 137 average. They even forced the reigning USA Softball Player of the Year Danielle Lawrie to 143 pitches in a close 6-5 loss this season as well.

HEAVEN...MUST BE MISSING SOME ANGELS...

Heaven is indeed missing some angels as the 2010 Sun Devils are kicking back to the community more than ever before, included in Marketing campaigns throughout the season, the players have brought their own causes to the forefront. Dani Rae Lougheed a junior who had two brain surgeries her senior year of high school has already helped to host a SSBTR (Students Supporting Brain Tumor Research) night at Farrington Stadium with all proceeds going towards the organization.

In addition, senior Caylyn Carlson has put together Smile Train Night which will happen during the Cal series next weekend with proceeds benefitting Smile Train, an organization which helps children with cleft lips and palates get them surgically repaired.

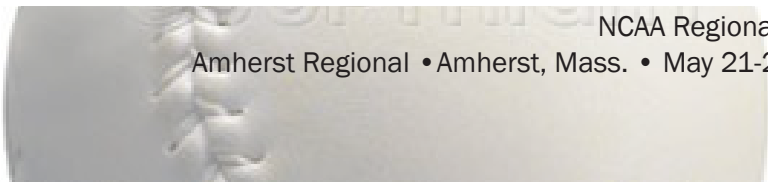
