The Sun Devil Softball squad (25-5 overall) gear up this weekend to open their 2009 conference slate as they set to host Pac-10 foes, Oregon & Oregon State. The Sun Devils will face the Oregon Ducks at 7 p.m. on Friday, March 27 and the Oregon State Beavers Saturday, March 28 at 7 p.m. and Sunday March 29 at Noon in Tempe at Far-5 W rington Stadium.

### SERIES HISTORY & SCOUTING REPORT

9-1 (5) Since 1987 the Sun Devils have gone Duck hunting and com-4 W. 1 L piled a 44-33 overall record against Oregon. Last season, the Sun Dev-3 Ws ils swept the series from under the Ducks with 3-2, 6-1 and 9-0 over 7:00 pm Oregon. All-time, Head Coach Clint Myers is 8-1 against UO. The Sun 7:00 pm Devils also ride a three-game winning streak against the Ducks into this Noon weekend.

1:00 pm One of the oldest rivals to ASU, Oregon State first matched 3:00 pm up against ASU in 1977 and since then ASU has compiled a 65-25 record against the Beavs. Last season, the Sun Devils went a perfect 3-0 Noon against Oregon State, winning 3-2, 8-4 and 5-1 over OSU. This season, the Sun Devils have also set a new ranking record as they were awarded a No. 2 preseason ranking by USA Softball, the highest preseason ranking the Devils have ever received.

RBIs: ASU Season Record: 439 - Set in 2008 Current: 233



This year's squad is no exception, though might be even better as they seem to surge in the middle of games as well since most of their 245 runs have been scored in the second and third inning with 46 scored in the second and 51 in the third.





#### **BIG POWER, LITTLE PACKAGE**

Sophomore transfer from Louisville, Kaylyn Castillo showed up on ASU's doorstep this season and has refused to produce nothing but power. The tiny catcher has a quick arm behind the plate and even quicker bat while at it. She's currently batting .327 with 14 RBIs and two home runs for a .481 slugging percentage.

The Sun Devils have found their home at Farrington Stadium to be a welcome one. Last season they held a 43-2 overall record at home, as well as an 9-1 Pac-10 record. They're currently 21-1 playing in Farrington Stadium in 2009.
