In the split, ASU has claimed six wins to LSU's three, with their last meeting in the 2007 Super Regional where ASU topped the Tigers in two wins, 1-0 (10 innings) and 7-4 giving Coach Myer's a 2-0 record in the books against LSU.

# WHERE THEY STACK UP






# **BIG POWER, LITTLE PACKAGE**
