## The 'Duel in the Desert': Part Two

### FRIDAY NIGHT:

The top-ranked Sun Devil Softball squad (46-3, 8-1 Pac-10) squad continues their home Pac-10 slate Friday, hosting in-state rival and back-to-back National Champions, the seventh-ranked Arizona Wildcats (29-12, 6-4 Pac-10). First pitch for Friday night's event is at 7 p.m.

### LAST TIME OUT:

Last week saw the Sun Devils play one last road game against the Arizona Wildcats in Tucson before opening their home Pac-10 slate against UCLA and Washington.

Against the 'Cats last week, the story was a little different than usual as ASU headed down to the 'Cats den in Tucson and gave them an 8-1 loss, with four Sun Devil home runs in the game, the most '07' World Series MVP Taryne Mowatt has even given up in her career.

The Sun Devils shone again Friday night as they took on the only remaining undefeated team in the Pac-10 in No. 4 UCLA and downed them in an easy 3-0 shut-out. Krista Donnenwirth went 2-for-3 with two RBIs to lead the team, with a highlight on the night coming from Lesley Rogers who hit her first career home run off a 2-1 pitch in which she took Angelica Selden deep to right field, for only Selden's fourth home run of the season.

Saturday night pitted ASU against No. 23 Washington where live on Fox Sports Net, the Sun Devils showed what they're made of, scoring seven runs on only four hits, one a grand slam in the first inning from sophomore outfielder, Caylyn Carlson for her ninth home run of the season. Kaitlin Cochran also went yard in the game, cracking a solo shot in the fourth to become the fourth Sun Devil this season with double digit home runs.

Sunday afternoon saw the Sun Devils fall flat though as an exhausted Katie Burkhart still struck out 11 Huskies in the game, but the offense flatlined, leaving 11 on base en route to a 3-0 loss, their first of the Pac-10 season.

In addition to their Pac-10 slate, the Sun Devils added a doubleheader against UNLV on Monday. Megan Elliott came out to take claim to both wins on the day as ASU came from behind in both to win 6-5 and 14-7. In game two Renee Welty went 4-for-4 with a home run and five RBIs in the game. Mandy Urfer, Krista Donnenwirth and Caylyn Carlson also hit home runs in the doubleheader. With Carlson's home run she became the fifth Sun Devil with double digit home runs on the season.

For her phenomenal efforts in the circle last week, Katie Burkhart was also named Pac-10 Pitcher of the Week. She pitched 28.2 innings in six days for a .73 ERA and 48 strikeouts for three wins, a loss and a save.

## SERIES HISTORY & SCOUTING REPORT

### Arizona Wildcats:

In one of the oldest and most bitter rivalries in college softball, Arizona and Arizona State's history goes back to 1971 when they first met. While Arizona may currently hold the series history title with an 81-92 overall record, what many don't know is the success ASU had over Arizona for years. From 1971-1974 the Sun Devils went 12-0 in their first 12 meetings before the 'Cats took one. The Sun Devils also won 16 straight against the 'Cats from 1978-1981 as well. It actually took the 'Cats a decade to get 10 wins against ASU, with ASU holding the series record at 45-10 by the end of 1981. Friday's meeting will be the 144th time the teams have matched-up with their last match-up coming last week as the Sun Devils headed down to the 'Cats den to put an 8-1 hurting on the Wildcats for their first win against UA in Tucson since 1991 and first ever in Hillenbrand Stadium. The last time ASU beat UA in the regular season series was also in 1991.

The back-to-back champions come into the weekend ranked seventh with a 29-12 overall record and a 6-4 Pac-10 record. Last weekend they went 2-2 topping No. 23 Washington once in extra innings and UCLA once, run-ruling the Bruins Saturday afternoon before UCLA stole back a 2-1 win on Sunday.

Leading the offense for Arizona is freshman, Brittany Lastrapes, who's hitting .380 in the 38 games she has played and started in. Right behind her are Jenae Leles and Lanie Roth who are hitting .358 and .346 respectively. One main worry about the 'Cats is their affinity for the long ball, with 65 on the year thus far, with four different 'Cats holding double-digit home run totals.

In addition to their potent line-up they also have World Series MVP Taryne Mowatt holding down the circle. Thus far in the 2008 season, Mowatt has gone 17-9 overall with a 1.90 ERA and 264 strikeouts, putting her high up in the Pac-10 statistics.

## UP NEXT

The Sun Devils will continue their home Pac-10 schedule as they host the Oregon schools. They take on Oregon State on Friday, April 25 at 6:30 as a continuation of their halted game in Corvallis on April 5. After the completion of the final inning, the Sun Devils will take on the Beavers in their regularly scheduled game. In addition ASU takes on the Oregon Ducks as well on Saturday, April 26 at 7pm and Sunday April 27 at noon at Farrington Stadium in Tempe.

## THE TOP ISN'T ENOUGH FOR THESE DEVILS...

In the polls for 2007, the Sun Devils enjoyed a new record in the rankings section as they attained their highest ranking ever with a #2 ranking coming in Week 2 and continuing until Week 5. The ranking also marked the first time the Sun Devils have ever surpassed the Arizona Wildcats in ranking and only the second time they have passed UCLA (Last was in 2002.)

This season, the Sun Devils have also set a new ranking record as they were awarded a No. 2 preseason ranking by USA Softball, the highest preseason ranking the Devils have ever received. They surpassed that ranking in Week 4 though, taking the No. 1 spot in both the USA Softball and the NFCA polls for the first time in program history.



## It's Only a Matter of Time...Pt. 2

### Katie Burkhart

#### 2008:

- Made the 2008 ASA Top-25 Finalist List for USA Softball Player of the Year
- Holds the second and tenth highest season strikeout totals in Pac-10 history from 2007 and 2006. Currently has 324 strikeouts.
- Is currently 7th in NCAA career history in strikeouts and 159Ks behind 6th place.
- Has 1,481 career K's...joining the 1,400+ K club, where only 6 others in NCAA history reside.
- Currently has 102 wins, which is the career-record in Sun Devil pitching history and ties her for 10th place in Pac-10 Career history, as well as 33rd in NCAA history. Her 103rd win will tie her for 9th in Pac-10 career stats and 32nd in NCAA history.
- Is now 3rd all-time in Pac-10 Career Strikeout Standings, needs 185 Ks to tie for second all-time with Cal's Michele Granger at 1,640.
- Is currently seventh in NCAA history in career strikeout ratio with a 10.9 ratio.
- Recorded her second career perfect game on Feb. 22, 2008 in Tempe against Illinois State as the Sun Devils won 8-0 in five innings. Was only three hit batters from another perfect game against Utah on March 19 in Fullerton.
- Added a third career perfect game to her resume on March 14, 2008 against Santa Clara with an 8-0 win in five innings....the game comes nearly EXACTLY to the date of her first career perfect game on March 15, 2007 against Notre Dame.
- Was named Pac-10 Pitcher of the Week on February 19, March 25 and April 15 her seventh, eighth and ninth career Pitcher of the Week honor.





Last season alone, Kaitlin had 19 two-hit games and nine three hit games, as well as 16 games with two or more RBIs. This year, Kaitlin has nine two-hit games and three three-hit games already, and nine games with two or more RBIs. Kaitlin's longest hitting streak in the 2006 season was 17 games, she hasn't matched it again as her longest in 2007 was been 11 games. Her longest thus far in 2008 has been a 10 game streak, which she has reached twice already this season.



This year's line-up kicks into gear rapidly in the first and third as they've scored 75 of their 367 runs in the first inning and 65 in the third.



## BIG POWER, LITTLE PACKAGE

Senior secondbaseman Mindy Cowles has again and again proved why she is such a threat at the plate. Standing only 5'3, Mindy set the ASU single-season home run record of 17 (tied with Kaitlin Cochran in 2006) and last season had 15 home runs, added to this year's tally of eight which gives her a current total of 50, making her the all-time career leader in home runs. She also tied an NCAA record in March of 2006 where she stepped up in game two of a doubleheader against UTEP and hit three home runs for 10 RBIs.

This season she's found her rhythm as she had a 17-game hitting streak going with three multiple hit and multiple RBI games. Her hitting streak was broken on March 4, as she was brought into the game in the fourth where she was intentionally walked.

Little Mindy Mae is also currently making some marks in Pac-10 Stat Standings. Some are:

## HOME SWEEEET HOME

The Sun Devils have found their home at Farrington Stadium to be a welcome one. Last season they held a 28-3 overall record at home, as well as an 8-2 Pac-10 record. Already in '08 they're 33-1 in the hallowed confines of Farrington Stadium.

## OH MERCY, MERCY ME...

The Sun Devils seem to have a habit of giving opponents a bit of mercy. Out of 49 games, ASU has mercy-ruled opponents 14 times.

## BRING YOUR GREEN HAT, WE'RE GOING STREAKING!

The 2008 team has been guilty of a bit of streaking...but at least one of them includes winning.

Already in the '08 season, the Sun Devils claimed a 28 game winning streak, the longest winning streak in ASU Softball history. In addition, some of the players themselves are guilty of a few streaks, including:

- Mindy Cowles went buckwild at the plate, with a 17-game hitting streak.
- Kaitlin Cochran has compiled two 10-game hitting streaks
- Jackie Vasquez has already claimed an 11 game hitting streak, and is riding a three game hitting streak going into this weekend.
- Jessica Mapes, Renee Welty and Krista Donnenwirth have also been steady hitters, all grabbing a six game hitting streak at one point this season.



## THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT...

While the Sun Devil softball team has returned a solid backbone of upperclassmen, don't be surprised to see the fresh faces taking starting time this season. Shining stars for Rookie Devils are third-baseman Krista Donnenwirth who's batting clean-up with a .329 average and a team and Pac-10-high 58 RBIs. She also has 16 games with two or more hits and 16 games with two or more RBIs, including one grand slam. During the Wilson/DeMarini Invitational, Donnenwirth was awarded Most Valuable Hitter as she went 9-for-16 at the plate with a .563 average with one double, three home runs and 11 RBIs to compile a slugging percentage of 1.188 on the weekend. She also got the ball rolling against Arizona as she teed off on an O-1 pitch from Taryne Mowatt in the first inning for her 10th home run of the season. While most tend to say that froshies don't know good pitching, in addition to going long on Taryne Mowatt, Donnenwirth took it to UCLA ace Angelica Selden in their first match-up, going 2-for-3 with two RBIs in the win. She wasn't done there yet though, showing her patience at the plate against UCLA's feared Angelica Selden, she went 2-for-3 batting in two runs in their 3-0 shutout of the Bruins.

Next up for the frosh is outfielder Lesley Rogers, a slapper with a penchant for placing the ball wherever she desires. While she has speed and a solid arm, her work at the plate is getting her noticed. Hitting lead-off and in the nine-spot Lesley has amassed a .318 average with four doubles, a triple and her first career home run, which came against UCLA's Angelica Selden...only Selden's fourth of the season. Rogers now has 16 RBIs in the 40 games she's played in. In addition she has nine multiple hit games and four games with two or more ribbies and claimed a five game hitting streak at one point.


Not to overlook the sophomores of the bunch, Caylyn Carlson has come out to become a powerhouse at the plate. While her stature is small, her power is big as she's already hit 10 home runs on the season, one a grand slam against No. 23 Washington.

And while she may not be new to the game, she's new to the Sun Devils. Transfer Renee Welty has come in to be a huge asset in only her first season with ASU. A junior transfer from Chandler-Gilbert, Renee has nine home runs on the season for 26 RBIs as a back-up catcher. She's one long ball short from joining the double-digit home run club with five of her fellow Sun Devils.

Unbeknownst to most, the Sun Devils saw a change in coaching staff this year as former Assistant Coach Robert Wagner was named Associate Head Coach this fall before kicking off the spring 2008 season. Under his tutelage, the offense has exploded, setting the vast majority of offensive records in Sun Devil history in only two years.

**AT THE HELM:**

Head Coach Clint Myers enters his third season as the leader of Sun Devil Softball after two campaigns that saw the Sun Devils set offensive records in: wins, runs, home runs, RBIs, walks and strikeouts. His two Sun Devil squads have also recorded back-to-back winning Pac-10 records in conference play, the first time ever. Another milestone for the Sun Devils under Clint were their consecutive appearances at the Women's College World Series, a program first.
