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The Battle for the Pac: Top-Ranked Softball Faces No. 21 Washington & No. 4 UCLA

ON TAP:

The top-ranked Sun Devil Softball squad (52-3, 14-1 Pac-10) squad continues their Pac-10 slate this weekend, hitting the road to Seattle to face the 21st-ranked Washington Huskies before traveling to Hollywood to take on the fourth-ranked UCLA Bruins. The Sun Devils will take on Washington on Friday afternoon at 1 p.m. After the completion of that game, they will travel down to Los Angeles to play UCLA on Saturday at 3 p.m. followed with the completion of their series with the Bruins on Sunday at noon.

LAST TIME OUT:

In Friday night's game against Oregon State, the Sun Devils continued their halted game from April 6th where they only needed to complete the 7th inning to close out a 6-4 lead they gained in Corvallis. The Sun Devils weren't quite done yet though offensively as Krista Donnenwirth led-off the 7th with a single that was belted home by a two-run shot from Kristen Miller as ASU rolled to an 8-4 final win.

In their regularly scheduled match-up with the Beavers, Katie Burkhart stepped to the circle to pitch a one-hit gem, striking out 14 as Krista Donnenwirth went 2-for-3 with a home run and Mindy Cowles belting a long ball as well to give ASU the 5-1 win.

Against the Ducks on Saturday Donnenwirth was 3-for-4 and Mindy Cowles belted a three run shot in the first as Megan Elliott pitched phenomenally as she hurled a three-hit complete game for her first complete game Pac-10 victory.

Sunday saw the Sun Devils come out to dominate the Ducks as Katie Burkhart put in only five innings of flawless work as the offense did the rest as Kaitlin Cochran belted a grand slam and Pac-10 Player of the Week Kristen Miller hit another home run for two more runs in ASU's five inning 9-0 win.

SERIES HISTORY & SCOUTING REPORT

Washington Huskies:

A rivalry for the Sun Devils, the Huskies and Sun Devils are 2-0 in series history under Head Coach Clint Myers. Though Myers is 5-3 overall against the Huskies, the series history is one Washington has a definitive edge in with a 15-43 overall record against since 1993 when they first met.

The Huskies and fourth-year Head Coach Heather Tarr have continued to keep the program on track this year, compiling a 26-18-1 overall record and a 5-9 conference record.

Leading the offensive attack for the Huskies is freshman lefty hitter Jace Williams, who's currently hitting at a .375 clip with 10 doubles and five home runs for 32 RBIs. Not far behind is sophomore lefty, Bailey Setenson who's hitting .360 overall with six doubles and a home run. Overall, UW is hitting .290 as a team, good for fourth in the Pac-10.

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In the circle for the Huskies is freshman righty Aleah Macon who is currently 15-11 overall and 5-7 in the Pac-10 with a 1.86 ERA and 216 strikeouts.

UCLA Bruins:

Another rivalry for the Sun Devils, the Bruins and Sun Devils are split an even 1-1 in all-time series under Head Coach Clint Myers. While the Bruins bested Myers in his first year, his 2007 team came back to take the series 2-1. Overall against the Bruins, Myers is 3-4 and in the series history, the Bruins have the definitive advantage compiling a 20-85 record since their first meeting in 1980.

The Bruins have put the program back on track this year, led by second-year Head Coach Kelly Inouye-Perez, and her 15th with UCLA. As a Head Coach against ASU, Inouye-Perez is 1-3 overall.

Leading the offensive attack for the Bruins is freshman lefty hitter Samantha Camuso, who's currently hitting at a .390 clip with 15 doubles, two triples and two home runs. Not far behind is another freshman lefty, GiOnna DiSalvatore who's hitting .389 overall with a similar line of 13 doubles, two triples and two home runs. Overall, UCLA is hitting .319 as a team, good for second in the Pac-10...behind ASU.

More importantly, is the Bruins defense as star hurler Angelica Selden has come out red-hot for UCLA, with a current 20-3 record and .82 ERA with 232 strike outs.

UP NEXT

The Sun Devils will wrap their Pac-10 schedule at home next weekend they host the Bay Area schools. They face Stanford on Thursday, May 8 at 7 p.m. In addition ASU takes on the Cal Bears as well on May 9 and 10 at 7 p.m. and noon. All games will be played in Tempe at Farrington Stadium.

THE TOP ISN'T ENOUGH FOR THESE DEVILS...

In the polls for 2007, the Sun Devils enjoyed a new record in the rankings section as they attained their highest ranking ever with a #2 ranking coming in Week 2 and continuing until Week 5. The ranking also marked the first time the Sun Devils have ever surpassed the Arizona Wildcats in ranking and only the second time they have passed UCLA (Last was in 2002.)

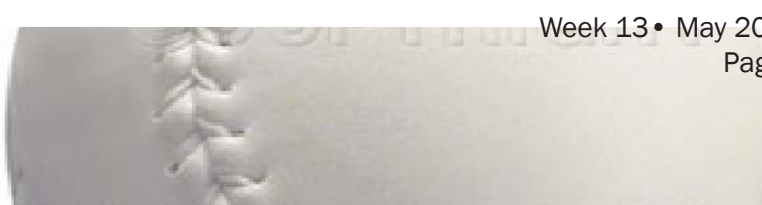

This season, the Sun Devils have also set a new ranking record as they were awarded a No. 2 preseason ranking by USA Softball, the highest preseason ranking the Devils have ever received. They surpassed that ranking in Week 4 though, taking the No. 1 spot in both the USA Softball and the NFCA polls for the first time in program history.

WHERE THEY STACK UP

As always, the Sun Devils will play one of the toughest schedules in the country, with the always powerful Pac-10 Conference schedule. Currently, the Pac-10 has six of the eight teams ranked in the top 25, with four in the Top-10 alone.

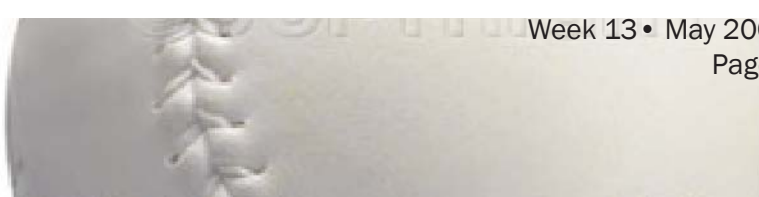

2008:

- Made the 2008 ASA Top-25 Finalist List for USA Softball Player of the Year

- Holds the second and tenth highest season strikeout totals in Pac-10 history from 2007 (517) and 2006 (420). Currently has 369 strikeouts.

- Is currently 7th in NCAA career history in strikeouts and 114Ks behind 6th place.

- Has 1,526 career K's... joining the 1,500+ K club, where only 6 others in NCAA history reside.

- Currently has 106 wins, which is the career-record in Sun Devil pitching history and puts her at 6th place in Pac-10 Career history, as well as 29th in NCAA history.

- Is now 3rd all-time in Pac-10 Career Strikeout Standings, needs 114 Ks to tie for second all-time with Cal's Michele Granger at 1,640.

- Is currently seventh in NCAA history in career strikeout ratio with a 10.9 ratio.

- Recorded her second career perfect game on Feb. 22, 2008 in Tempe against Illinois State as the Sun Devils won 8-0 in five innings. Was only three hit batters from another perfect game against Utah on March 19 in Fullerton.

- Added a third career perfect game to her resume on March 14, 2008 against Santa Clara with an 8-0 win in five innings....the game comes nearly EXACTLY to the date of her first career perfect game on March 15, 2007 against Notre Dame.

-Was named Pac-10 Pitcher of the Week on February 19, March 25 and April 15 her seventh, eighth and ninth career Pitcher of the Week honor.

Kaitlin's longest hitting streak in the 2006 season was 17 games, she hasn't matched it again as her longest in 2007 was been 11 games. Her longest thus far in 2008 has been a 10 game streak, which she has reached twice already this season.

RUNS ON FIRST AND THIRD?

This year's line-up kicks into gear rapidly in the first and third as they've scored 83 of their 406 runs in the first inning and 79 in the third.

BIG POWER, LITTLE PACKAGE

Senior secondbaseman Mindy Cowles has again and again proved why she is such a threat at the plate. Standing only 5'3, Mindy set the ASU single-season home run record of 17 (tied with Kaitlin Cochran in 2006) and last season had 15 home runs, added to this year's tally of 11 which gives her a current total of 53, making her the all-time career leader in home runs. She also tied an NCAA record in March of 2006 where she stepped up in game two of a doubleheader against UTEP and hit three home runs for 10 RBIs.

This season she's found her rhythm as she had a 17-game hitting streak going with three multiple hit and multiple RBI games. Her hitting streak was broken on March 4, as she was brought into the game in the fourth where she was intentionally walked.



This season Mindy has proven herself to be a 'Cat Killer' as she had two home runs against in-state rival and back-to-back National Champions Arizona in Tucson. And to hammer the point home about her feelings about UA? She hit another which proved to be the game winning shot when Arizona took ASU's home field in their second match-up in ASU's 2-0 win on April 18.

In addition to currently owning the ASU Career Home Run Record with 55, she's also claimed the ASU Career RBI record as well with her current total of 176.

Little Mindy Mae is also currently making some marks in Pac-10 Stat Standings. Some are:

OH MERCY, MERCY ME...

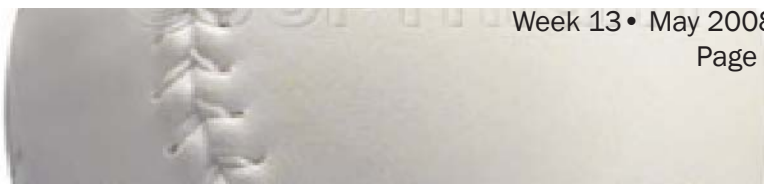
The Sun Devils seem to have a habit of giving opponents a bit of mercy. Out of 55 games, ASU has mercy-ruled opponents 15 times.

BRING YOUR GREEN HAT, WE'RE GOING STREAKING!

The 2008 team has been guilty of a bit of streaking...but at least one of them includes winning.

Already in the '08 season, the Sun Devils claimed a 28 game winning streak, the longest winning streak in ASU Softball history. In addition, some of the players themselves are guilty of a few streaks, including:

- Mindy Cowles went buckwild at the plate, with a 17-game hitting streak, and currently on a 4-game streak
- Kaitlin Cochran has compiled two 10-game hitting streaks.
- Jackie Vasquez has already claimed an 11 game hitting streak.
- Krista Donnenwirth currently holds a nine game hitting streak.
- Jessica Mapes and Renee Welty have also been steady hitters, all grabbing a six game hitting streak at one point this season.



THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT...

While the Sun Devil softball team has returned a solid backbone of upperclassmen, don't be surprised to see the fresh faces taking starting time this season. Shining stars for Rookie Devils are third-baseman Krista Donnenwirth who's batting clean-up with a .369 average and a team and Pac-10-high 64 RBIs, which puts her for second in ASU single-season history...three from first. She also has 21 games with two or more hits and 18 games with two or more RBIs, including one grand slam. During the Wilson/DeMarini Invitational, Donnenwirth was awarded Most Valuable Hitter as she went 9-for-16 at the plate with a .563 average with one double, three home runs and 11 RBIs to compile a slugging percentage of 1.188 on the weekend. She also got the ball rolling against Arizona as she teed off on an 0-1 pitch from Taryne Mowatt in the first inning for her 10th home run of the season. While most tend to say that froshies don't know good pitching, in addition to going long on Taryne Mowatt, Donnenwirth took it to UCLA ace Angelica Selden in their first match-up, going 2-for-3 with two RBIs in the win. She wasn't done there yet though, showing her patience at the plate against UCLA's feared Angelica Selden, she went 2-for-3 batting in two runs in their 3-0 shutout of the Bruins. Donnenwirth proved again that she cares not if you're a name-brand...after taking Taryne Mowatt deep in Tucson, she took her deep in back-to-back at-bats against the 'Cats in ASU's win on April 19.

Next up for the frosh is outfielder Lesley Rogers, a slapper with a penchant for placing the ball wherever she desires. While she has speed and a solid arm, her work at the plate is getting her noticed. Hitting lead-off and in the nine-spot Lesley has amassed a .311 average with four doubles, a triple and her first career home run, which came against UCLA's Angelica Selden...only Selden's fourth of the season. Rogers now has 16 RBIs in the 45 games she's played in. In addition she has nine multiple hit games and four games with two or more ribbys and claimed a five game hitting streak at one point.

Not to overlook the sophomores of the bunch, Caylyn Carlson has come out to become a powerhouse at the plate. While her stature is small, her power is big as she's already hit 10 home runs on the season, one a grand slam against No. 23 Washington.

And while she may not be new to the game, she's new to the Sun Devils. Transfer Renee Welty has come in to be a huge asset in only her first season with ASU. A junior transfer from Chandler-Gilbert, Renee has nine home runs on the season for 28 RBIs as a back-up catcher. She's one long ball short from joining the double-digit home run club with five of her fellow Sun Devils.

The Amateur Softball Association, the National Governing Body of Softball in the United States, has selected its 'Top 25 Finalist' for the 7th Annual USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Award. This award, which is considered one of the most prestigious honors in women's collegiate softball, is designed to recognize outstanding athletic achievement by female collegiate softball players across the country.

The Sun Devils also earn the bragging rights of having the most finalists of any other team on the list as they have three still in contention for the award: Katie Burkhart, Kaitlin Cochran and Jackie Vasquez.

**PARTNERS IN CRIME:**

Unbeknownst to most, the Sun Devils saw a change in coaching staff this year as former Assistant Coach Robert Wagner was named Associate Head Coach this fall before kicking off the spring 2008 season. Under his tutelage, the offense has exploded, setting the vast majority of offensive records in Sun Devil history in only two years.

AT THE HELM:

Head Coach Clint Myers enters his third season as the leader of Sun Devil Softball after two campaigns that saw the Sun Devils set and re-set offensive records in: wins, runs, home runs, RBIs, walks and strikeouts. His two Sun Devil squads have also recorded back-to-back winning Pac-10 records in conference play, the first time ever. Another milestone for the Sun Devils under Clint were their consecutive appearances at the Women's College World Series, a program first.
