Second-Ranked Softball Hits the Home Stretch With Eyes Set on First Pac-10 Title

ON TAP:

The second-ranked Sun Devil Softball squad (54-4, 16-1 Pac-10) squad will close out their Pac-10 slate and regular season this weekend, settling in to the confines of their home at Farrington Stadium to take on eighth-ranked Stanford Cardinal (45-10, 10-8 Pac-10) and the 23rd-ranked Cal Golden Bears (40-21, 7-11 Pac-10). Games are set to start on Thursday, May 8 with ASU taking on Stanford at 7 p.m. followed by a 7 p.m. game versus Cal on Friday, May 9 and a noontime game against the Bears on Saturday, May 10. All games will be played in Tempe at Farrington Stadium.

LAST TIME OUT:

In Friday afternoon's game against the Washington Huskies, Clint Myers remained unblemished in series against the Huskies in his career as ASU went into Friday tied 1-1 in this year's series. Washington's pitching struggled early on, walking in two runs to give ASU a boost before Katie Crabb hit her fifth home run of the year in the third inning to cement a 3-0 lead that Katie Burkhart never relinquished, cruising to her 30th win of the year.

In Saturday's afternoon contest against the fourth-ranked UCLA Bruins, the road-weary Sun Devils gave in to a tough loss, with UCLA coming out firing on all cylinders, tabbing Katie Burkhart with three home runs for five runs, two by Amanda Kamekona alone. ASU put runners in scoring position in the 2nd, 3rd, 6th and 7th inning, but were unable to capitalize, falling in only their second shutout of the season.

Sunday's Sun Devil squad showed a renewed vigor as Megan Elliott threw four masterful innings as ASU took it to the Bruins early in the game with Kristen Miller lifting her 13th home run of the season to plate three in the first, which was couple with two sacrifice hits in the fourth to take home a 5-2 win from the Bruins, the first time ASU has taken the series from the Bruins on their own turf since 1980.

SERIES HISTORY & SCOUTING REPORT

No. 8 Stanford Cardinal

Since they first met in 1984, the Sun Devils have compiled a 40-19 overall record over the Cardinal. Last season alone, the Sun Devils swept the Cardinal winning two at home 7-0 and 8-2 as well as taking one in Palo Verde 2-0. Overall under Coach Myers the Sun Devils are 7-1 against the Cardinal.

Don't let the series history fool you though, Stanford has rallied back stronger than ever this year and looks to be a national championship threat. Entering into the weekend at 45-10 the Cardinal have show strength both defensively and offensively. The majority of Stanford's 10 losses come from high-ranked powerhouse teams.

The Cardinal are also earning high marks in the Pac-10 stats as they enter week 13 ranked second in walks (235) and doubles (79), third in home runs (47) fourth in batting average (.284), slugging per-

centage (.447), and in on-base percentage (.389), while striking out almost the fewest in the Pac-10 ranked sixth with 237 strikeouts.

On the offensive front sophomore outfielder Alissa Habner leads the way followed by sophomore catcher Rosey Neill. Habner has played in all 55 games for the Cardinal and is hitting .379 with 15 doubles and six home runs for a .565 slugging percentage. Neill is right on her heels as well, batting .359 with nine doubles and a Pac-10 leading 17 home runs.

Defensively Missy Penna has stepped up huge for Stanford as the junior right-handed hurler enters the series with a 33-9 record and a 1.06 ERA. On the year Penna has only allowed 43 earned runs in 283.2 innings of work while striking out 353 batters.

No. 23 California Golden Bears:

Since their first meeting in 1981, the Bears hold a 37-60 all-time record over the Sun Devils. For the Cal program, since 1988 when head Coach Diane Ninemire first took the helm, she's brought the team to nine Women's College World Series, 20 consecutive NCAA Regional appearances and one national title, making Cal a national contender every year.

While Coach Myers has brought the ASU program to new heights and levels, he still has one feat remaining against the Cal Bears. To take a series from them. The last time ASU took a Pac-10 series from Cal was in 2002 where ASU took the series 2-1 with an 8-4 and 2-1 win.

Cal rolls into this weekend with a 40-21 overall record and 7-11 in Pac-10.

The Bears come into this weekend with some impressive stats as they're batting .278 overall, good for sixth in the Pac-10. As a team they've scored 295 runs, with 72 doubles, six triples and 35 home runs on the season. With their 295 runs scored, they are third only to ASU and Arizona.

On defense, the Bears have the fifth highest team ERA in the Pac-10 with a 2.17, but they are fourth in batters struck out with 403. They're fourth in wins with 40.

For the Bear's offense, Freshman first baseman Sanoe Keka-huna is getting it done at the plate. Playing in all 61 games, Sanoe leads the team in batting average, hitting .333 with 32 runs scored and a team-high 15 doubles and eight home runs for 45 RBIs .

Also leading the Bears is yet another freshman, Valerie Arioto who's hit .330 on the year with her speed doing most of the damage as she's collected 17 doubles and four triples and two home runs already.

The main upperclassman making a splash for the Bears is junior outfielder Gina Leomiti who has hit .311 on the year with the third-highest tally of RBIs with 41.

In the circle for the Bears is sophomore ace Marissa Drewery, who boasts a 1.72 ERA and a 26-13 record overall. Drewery was named Pac-10 Pitcher of the Week on March 25, and thus far this season she's thrown ten shutouts and 30 complete game efforts of the 39 games she's started. In her 261 innings pitched she's allowed only 64 earned runs and struck out 266, good for fourth in the Pac-10 standings.

THE TOP ISN'T ENOUGH FOR THESE DEVILS...

In the polls for 2007, the Sun Devils enjoyed a new record in the rankings section as they attained their highest ranking ever with a #2 ranking coming in Week 2 and continuing until Week 5. The ranking also marked the first time the Sun Devils have ever surpassed the Arizona Wildcats in ranking and only the second time they have passed UCLA (Last was in 2002.)

This season, the Sun Devils have also set a new ranking record as they were awarded a No. 2 preseason ranking by USA Softball, the highest preseason ranking the Devils have ever received. They surpassed that ranking in Week 4 though, taking the No. 1 spot in both the USA Softball and the NFCA polls for the first time in program history.

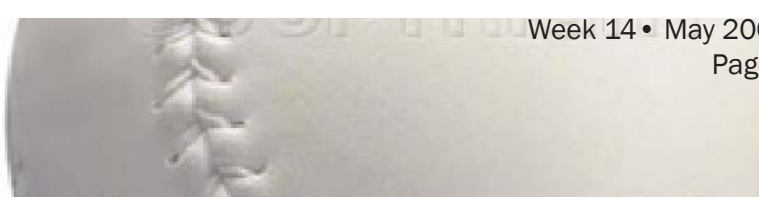

- Currently has 107 wins, which is the career-record in Sun Devil pitching history and puts her at 6th place in Pac-10 Career history, as well as 26th in NCAA history.

- Is now 3rd all-time in Pac-10 Career Strikeout Standings, needs 89 Ks to tie for second all-time with Cal's Michele Granger at 1,640.

- Is currently seventh in NCAA history in career strikeout ratio with a 10.9 ratio.

- Recorded her second career perfect game on Feb. 22, 2008 in Tempe against Illinois State as the Sun Devils won 8-0 in five innings. Was only three hit batters from another perfect game against Utah on March 19 in Fullerton.

- Added a third career perfect game to her resume on March 14, 2008 against Santa Clara with an 8-0 win in five innings....the game comes nearly EXACTLY to the date of her first career perfect game on March 15, 2007 against Notre Dame.

-Was named Pac-10 Pitcher of the Week on February 19, March 25 and April 15 her seventh, eighth and ninth career Pitcher of the Week honor.

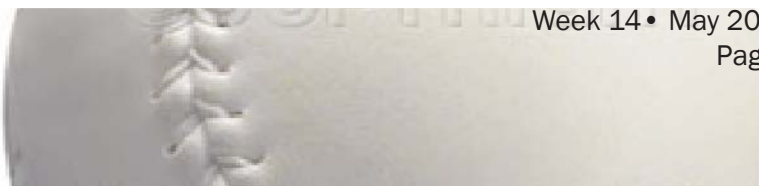

Last season alone, Kaitlin had 19 two-hit games and nine three hit games, as well as 16 games with two or more RBIs. This year, Kaitlin has 15 two-hit games and three three-hit games already, and 11 games with two or more RBIs. Kaitlin's longest hitting streak in the 2006 season was 17 games, she hasn't matched it again as her longest in 2007 was been 11 games. Her longest thus far in 2008 has been a 10 game streak, which she has reached twice already this season.

RUNS ON FIRST AND THIRD?

This year's line-up kicks into gear rapidly in the first and third as they've scored 88 of their 414 runs in the first inning and 79 in the third.

BIG POWER, LITTLE PACKAGE

Senior secondbaseman Mindy Cowles has again and again proved why she is such a threat at the plate. Standing only 5'3, Mindy set the ASU single-season home run record of 17 (tied with Kaitlin Cochran in 2006) and last season had 15 home runs, added to this year's tally of 13 which gives her a current total of 55, making her the all-time career leader in home runs, and ties her for 10th in Pac-10 history. She also tied an NCAA record in March of 2006 where she stepped up in game two of a doubleheader against UTEP and hit three home runs for 10 RBIs.

This season she's found her rhythm as she had a 17-game hitting streak going with three multiple hit and multiple RBI games. Her hitting streak was broken on March 4, as she was brought into the game in the fourth where she was intentionally walked.

This season Mindy has proven herself to be a 'Cat Killer' as she had two home runs against in-state rival and back-to-back National Champions Arizona in Tucson. And to hammer the point home about her feelings about UA? She hit another which proved to be the game winning shot when Arizona took ASU's home field in their second match-up in ASU's 2-0 win on April 18.

In addition to currently owning the ASU Career Home Run Record with 55, she's also claimed the ASU Career RBI record as well with her current total of 177.

BEAT EM' TO THE SCOREBOARD

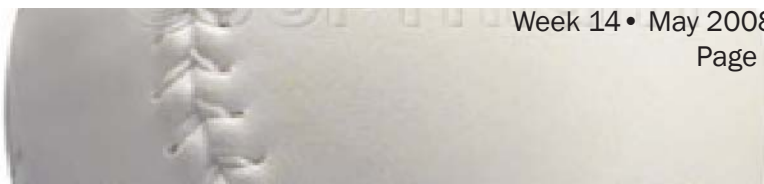
One of the all-important stats, the Sun Devils have proven that drawing first blood can make the difference. So far, the Sun Devils are 45-1 on the season when scoring first.

The 2008 team has been guilty of a bit of streaking...but at least one of them includes winning.

Already in the '08 season, the Sun Devils claimed a 28 game winning streak, the longest winning streak in ASU Softball history. In addition, some of the players themselves are guilty of a few streaks, including:

- Mindy Cowles went buckwild at the plate, with a 17-game hitting streak, and currently on a 4-game streak
- Kaitlin Cochran has compiled two 10-game hitting streaks.
- Jackie Vasquez has already claimed an 11 game hitting streak.
- Krista Donnenwirth had a nine-game hitting streak.
- Kristen Miller is currently on a nine-game hitting streak.
- Jessica Mapes and Renee Welty have also been steady hitters, all grabbing a six game hitting streak at one point this season.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT...

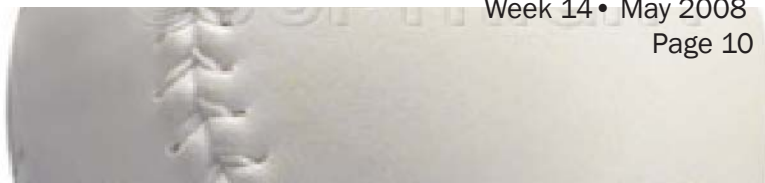
While the Sun Devil softball team has returned a solid backbone of upperclassmen, don't be surprised to see the fresh faces taking starting time this season. Shining stars for Rookie Devils are third-baseman Krista Donnenwirth who's batting clean-up with a .369 average and a team and Pac-10-high 64 RBIs, which puts her for second in ASU single-season history...three from first. She also has 21 games with two or more hits and 18 games with two or more RBIs, including one grand slam.

During the Wilson/DeMarini Invitational, Donnenwirth was awarded Most Valuable Hitter as she went 9-for-16 at the plate with a .563 average with one double, three home runs and 11 RBIs to compile a slugging percentage of 1.188 on the weekend. She also got the ball rolling against Arizona as she teed off on an 0-1 pitch from Taryne Mowatt in the first inning for her 10th home run of the season.

While most tend to say that froshies don't know good pitching, in addition to going long on Taryne Mowatt, Donnenwirth took it to UCLA ace Angelica Selden in their first match-up, going 2-for-3 with two RBIs in the win. She wasn't done there yet though, showing her patience at the plate against UCLA's feared Anjelica Selden, she went 2-for-3 batting in two runs in their 3-0 shutout of the Bruins. Donnenwirth proved again that she cares not if you're a name-brand...after taking Taryne Mowatt deep in Tucson, she took her deep in back-to-back at-bats against the 'Cats in ASU's win on April 19. Add to that a nine-game in-conference play hitting streak and you have All-American caliber.

Next up for the frosh is outfielder Lesley Rogers, a slapper with a penchant for placing the ball wherever she desires. While she has speed and a solid arm, her work at the plate is getting her noticed. Hitting lead-off and in the nine-spot Lesley has amassed a .298 average with four doubles, a triple and her first career home run, which came against UCLA's Angelica Selden...only Selden's fourth of the season. Rogers now has 17 RBIs in the 48 games she's played in. In addition she has nine multiple hit games and four games with two or more ribbys and claimed a five game hitting streak at one point.

Not to overlook the sophomores of the bunch, Caylyn Carlson has come out to become a powerhouse at the plate. While her stature is small, her power is big as she's already hit 10 home runs on the season, one a grand slam against No. 23 Washington.



And while she may not be new to the game, she's new to the Sun Devils. Transfer Renee Welty has come in to be a huge asset in only her first season with ASU. A junior transfer from Chandler-Gilbert, Renee has nine home runs on the season for 28 RBIs as a back-up catcher. She's one long ball short from joining the double-digit home run club with five of her fellow Sun Devils.

WE'VE GOT OUR EYE ON YOU...

The Amateur Softball Association, the National Governing Body of Softball in the United States, has selected its 'Top 25 Finalist' for the 7th Annual USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Award. This award, which is considered one of the most prestigious honors in women's collegiate softball, is designed to recognize outstanding athletic achievement by female collegiate softball players across the country.

The Sun Devils also earn the bragging rights of having the most finalists of any other team on the list as they have three still in contention for the award: Katie Burkhart, Kaitlin Cochran and Jackie Vasquez.

PARTNERS IN CRIME:

Unbeknownst to most, the Sun Devils saw a change in coaching staff this year as former Assistant Coach Robert Wagner was named Associate Head Coach this fall before kicking off the spring 2008 season. Under his tutelage, the offense has exploded, setting the vast majority of offensive records in Sun Devil history in only two years.

AT THE HELM:

Head Coach Clint Myers enters his third season as the leader of Sun Devil Softball after two campaigns that saw the Sun Devils set and re-set offensive records in: wins, runs, home runs, RBIs, walks and strikeouts. His two Sun Devil squads have also recorded back-to-back winning Pac-10 records in conference play, the first time ever. Another milestone for the Sun Devils under Clint were their consecutive appearances at the Women's College World Series, a program first.
