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No. 1 Softball to Host Santa Clara in a Three-Game Series

THIS WEEK

The top-ranked Sun Devil Softball (27-1) squad will continue their 2008 home season this weekend as they set to host the Santa Clara Broncos in a three-game series in Tempe this Friday and Saturday at Farrington Stadium. Friday's first pitch is set for 7 p.m. while game one of Saturday's double-header starts at noon, with game two following 20 minutes after the culmination of game one.

SERIES HISTORY & SCOUTING REPORT

Santa Clara Broncos:

Since their first meeting in 1987 against the Santa Clara Broncos, the Sun Devils hold a 16-1 lead in the series history with their last meeting coming in 2006 on March 9 in Santa Clara, Calif. which ended in a 9-0 final score in five innings with Katie Burkhart in the circle and pitching ASU to their 21st win of the season and her ninth of the year with a two-hit complete game shutout. They were slated for a double-header that day, but had game two rained out.

This weekend, Santa Clara travels to Tempe with a current 4-24 record overall. Last weekend they went 1-4 at the Fresno State Bulldog Classic in Fresno, Calif. They started off strong with a 5-1 win over Rhode Island before falling to three straight ranked opponents: Houston 4-0, DePaul 6-0 and Fresno State 8-0 (5 innings) before finishing the weekend with an 8-3 loss to Cal Poly.

The Broncos come in with a .185 team batting average with 15 doubles, a triple and seven home runs to their tally. Leading the offense is junior infielder, Noelanie Ho'opi'i who rides a .296 average into this weekend with three doubles and two home runs for seven RBIs.

In the circle for the Broncos is senior ace Jerrica Castagno who has a current 2-11 record with a 4.81 ERA. On the year she's only allowed 36 earned runs while striking out 45 in 67.1 innings of work.

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THE TOP ISN'T ENOUGH FOR THESE DEVILS...

In the polls for 2007, the Sun Devils enjoyed a new record in the rankings section as they attained their highest ranking ever with a #2 ranking coming in Week 2 and continuing until Week 5. The ranking also marked the first time the Sun Devils have ever surpassed the Arizona Wildcats in ranking and only the second time they have passed UCLA (Last was in 2002.)

This season, the Sun Devils have also set a new ranking record as they were awarded a No. 2 preseason ranking by USA Softball, the highest preseason ranking the Devils have ever received, the have now, however, surpassed that ranking in Week 4, taking the No. 1 spot in both the USA Softball and the NFCA polls for the first time in program history. In addition, the baseball team is also ranked #1 simultaneously, a rare feat only matched by the Arizona teams in history during this year's pre-season rankings.

WHERE THEY STACK UP

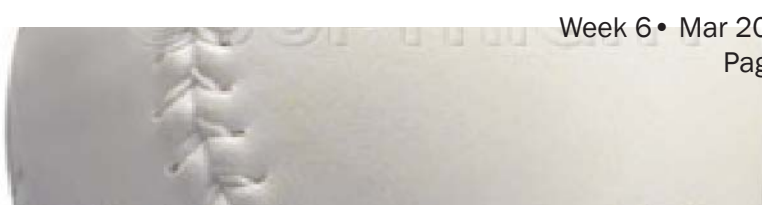

RUNS ON FIRST AND THIRD?

This year's line-up kicks into gear rapidly in the first and third as they've scored 50 of their 241 runs in the first inning and 49 in the third.

BIG POWER, LITTLE PACKAGE

Senior secondbaseman Mindy Cowles has again and again proved why she is such a threat at the plate. Standing only 5'3, Mindy set the ASU single-season home run record of 17 (tied with Kaitlin Cochran in 2006) and last season had 15 home runs, added to this year's tally of four which gives her a current total of 46, making her the all-time career leader in home runs. She also tied an NCAA record in March of 2006 where she stepped up in game two of a doubleheader against UTEP and hit three home runs for 10 RBIs.

This season she's found her rhythm as she had a 17-game hitting streak going with three multiple hit and multiple RBI games. Her hitting streak was broken on March 4, as she was brought into the game in the fourth where she was intentionally walked. She finished 0-2 in the game.

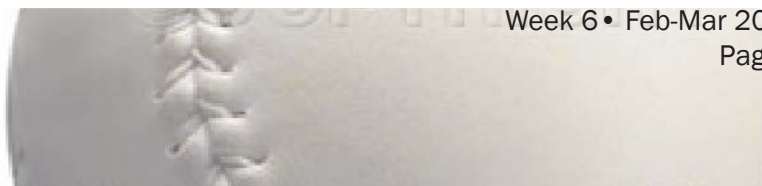

One of the all-important stats, the Sun Devils have proven that drawing first blood can make the difference. So far, the Sun Devils are 23-0 on the season when scoring first.



HOME SWEEEEEEET HOME

The Sun Devils have found their home at Farrington Stadium to be a welcome one. Last season they held a 28-3 overall record at home, as well as an 8-2 Pac-10 record. Already in '08 they're 24-0 at home.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT...

While the Sun Devil softball team has returned a solid backbone of upperclassmen, don't be surprised to see the fresh faces taking starting time this season. Shining stars for Rookie Devils are third-baseman Krista Donnenwirth who's batting clean-up with a .337 average and a team and Pac-10-high 39 RBIs. She also has 10 games with two or more hits and 11 games with two or more RBIs, including one grand slam. During the Wilson/DeMarini Invitational, Donnenwirth was awarded Most Valuable Hitter as she went 9-for-16 at the plate with a .563 average with one double, three home runs and 11 RBIs to compile a slugging percentage of 1.188 on the weekend.

Next up for the frosh is left-fielder Lesley Rogers, a slapper with a penchant for placing the ball wherever she desires. While she has speed and a solid arm, her work at the plate is getting her noticed. Hitting lead-off and in the nine-spot Lesley has amassed a .373 average with three doubles and a triple for 13 RBIs in the 25 games she's played in. In addition she has seven multiple hit games and four games with two or more ribbys.

WE'VE GOT OUR EYE ON YOU...

The Amateur Softball Association, the National Governing Body of Softball in the United States, has selected its 'Top 50 Watch List' for the 7th Annual USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Award. This award, which is considered one of the most prestigious honors in women's collegiate softball, is designed to recognize outstanding athletic achievement by female collegiate softball players across the country.

This season both First-Team All-Americans Katie Burkhart and Kaitlin Cochran were again added to the Watch List for the second consecutive season.

THE LOWE DOWN:

Also on the plate for the Sun Devils is senior ourfielder Jackie Vasquez being named one of the candidates for the Lowe's Senior Class Award. The award, presented to NCAA® Division I student-athletes each year in eight sports, focuses on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition. The winner is one who excels in the classroom and makes an impact in their respective community.

AT THE HELM:

Head Coach Clint Myers enters his third season as the leader of Sun Devil Softball after two campaigns that saw the Sun Devils set offensive records in: wins, runs, home runs, RBIs, walks and strikeouts. His two Sun Devil squads have also recorded back-to-back winning Pac-10 records in conference play, the first time ever. Another milestone for the Sun Devils under Clint were their consecutive appearances at the Women's College World Series, a program first.
