Devils Dancefloor No. 4 Softball to Tango With No. 7 UCLA and No. 3 Washington

THIS WEEK

The Sun Devil Softball squad (31-5 overall) hit the road this weekend for one of their toughest weekends of the season as they travel to Los Angeles, Calif. to face the seventh-ranked UCLA Bruins on Friday at 1 p.m. before heading up to Seattle, Wash. to take on the thirdranked Huskies on Saturday at 3 p.m. and Sunday at noon. Friday's game versus UCLA will be aired on tape delay by Fox Sports Net.

SERIES HISTORY & SCOUTING REPORT

Since 1980 the Sun Devils have gone head-to--head with the powerhouse that is UCLA Softball. Claiming the most national titles in NCAA history, ASU actually has their worst all-time record against the Bruins than against any other team. Overall UCLA holds the lead 86-22, though last year the Sun Devils edged the Bruins in the series, winning two of the three en route to a Pac-10 crown. The series win last season was the first time ASU has claimed the series since their first meetings in 1980. Overall, Clint Myers holds a 4-6 record against the Bruins, one of those wins coming in the 2008 WCWS to advance to the Championn ship Series.

Another tough series history for the Sun Devils happens to be against the Washington Huskies as well, who ASU first met in 1993. Since then Washington has compiled a 43-16 overall record, though ASU took two of three as well against the Huskies last season. Overall, Clint Myers holds a 6-3 record against the UW in his career.

UP NEXT

The Sun Devils will return home for a brief doubleheader against UNLV on Tuesday, April 7 at 1 & 3:30 p.m. in Tempe at Farrington Stadium before heading south to kick-off the Duel in the Desert, with games against Arizona Friday and Saturday night in Tucson.

NON-STOP UNTIL THEY REACH THE TOP

In the polls for 2008, the Sun Devils enjoyed a new record in the rankings section as they attained their highest ranking ever with a #2 ranking coming in Week 2 and continuing until Week 5. The best ranking was saved for the middle of the season....and the end. Number One in all polls. The ranking also marked the first time the Sun Devils have ever surpassed the Arizona Wildcats in ranking and only the second time they have passed UCLA (Last was in 2002.) This season, the Sun Devils have also set a new ranking record as they were awarded a No. 2 preseason ranking by USA Softball, the highest preseason ranking the Devils have

The tiny catcher has a quick arm behind the plate and even quicker bat while at it. She's currently batting .362 with 17 RBIs and two home runs for a .517 slugging percentage.
