THIS WEEK

The Sun Devil Softball squad (31-4 overall) is ready to kick the 2010 season into a higher gear as they set to host third-ranked and in-state rival, Arizona in their annual 'Duel In The Desert'. The series will count toward the State Farm Territorial Cup Series as the winning school will add a point to their current standings. Games this weekend will be on Thursday and Friday night at 7 p.m. and Saturday afternoon at 1 p.m. in Tempe at Farrington Stadium. Friday and Saturday's games are sold out with standing-room only remaining while Thursday night's game still has about 200 tickets remaining.

SERIES HISTORY

The series history between the Sun Devils and the 'Cats is a long one as it's gone on for 31 years since 1971. In that time the two foes have met up 178 times. While the Arizona Wildcats MAY have more national titles and hold the series edge with 95 wins to ASU's 83, it's always interesting to note that in the first decade of match-ups, ASU held a 46-10 record in those 10 years with ASU winning the first 11 match-ups.

UP NEXT

The Sun Devils hit the road for only the second time next weekend as they take on the UCLA Bruins in Los Angeles at the legendary Easton Stadium.

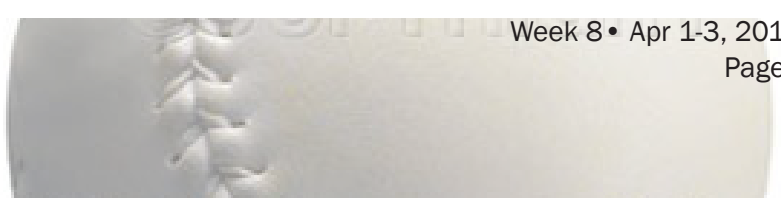
TEAM WITH A DREAM:

A now-junior transfer from Louisville, Kaylyn Castillo showed up on ASU's doorstep last season and has refused to produce nothing but power. The tiny catcher has a quick arm behind the plate and even quicker bat while at it. She's currently batting .304 with 31 RBIs and two home runs. Lil Castillo also holds the team lead with 10 multiple RBI games

BEAT EM' TO THE SCOREBOARD

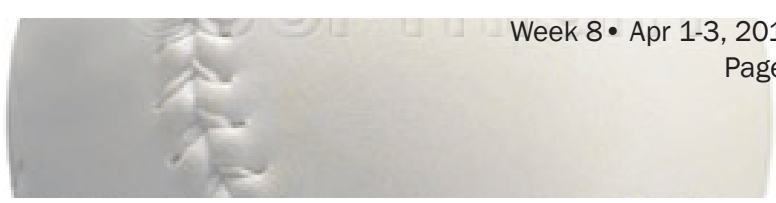
Sun Devils have a goal of ensuring they put up runs before their opponents do...and when they have scored first this season, they're 23-1.

The Sun Devils have found their home at Farrington Stadium to be a welcome one. Last season they held a 36-5 overall record at home. They're currently 28-2 playing in Farrington Stadium in 2010.



OH MERCY, MERCY ME...

The Sun Devils seem to have a habit of giving opponents a bit of mercy. Out of 35 games, ASU has mercy-ruled opponents 12 times.

OH BOY, OH BOYD!

Sophomore shortstop is kicking buns and taking names... or just putting hers everywhere. With her crafty glove play giving ASU one of the best middles in the nation, (they're 9th in the nation in double plays turned) her bat is giving them something to talk about. Already inching into ASU record books, Boyd is ruling the roost in the Pac-10 ranked in batting average, home runs, and dang near every offensive category as well as pasting her name all over NCAA stats as well. Boyd makes sure her Devils are taken care of as she's leading the team in multiple hit games with 13 and 10 multiple RBI games. She's currently riding the tide on a six game hitting streak.

IT'S MS. ROGERS' NEIGHBORHOOD...

Junior Lesley Rogers has stepped up to bat in her first season as an upperclassman where she's taken over as one of the premier slappers for the Sun Devils where through the season she's found herself hitting .463 when she's leading off for A State. She enjoys having friends on the bases as well as she's hitting .441 with runners on and a rediculous .500 with a runner on third and less than two outs. Her success in advacing runners is also something to marvel at as 71% of the time she gets the job done. While nationally ranked in pulling walks, Rogers also shows her smart pitch selection as she collected a 21-game hitting streak this season already.

No, YOU LOCK IT UP...

Sophomore Annie Lockwood has come into her own this season as she didn't see the playing field much her freshman season to a full-time starter with a punch to pack. Just behind Katelyn Boyd with 12 multiple hit games and third on the team with nine multiple RBI games. She also posted a ten game hitting streak on the season. None to shabby to go from the bench to the clean-up spot....

PARLICH-ITY SPLIT

Froshie Sam Parlich has jumped out of the minors and right into the bigs as she's come right out of high school to snag a starting spot for the Sun Devils. Parlich has come out to be a triple threat for ASU as she has the ability to flash the leather at second base, swing the bat with a .403 average on the season and one of the hardest hitters in the NCAA to strikeout. Then on the flipside? The girl can hurl it as she currently holds a 5-2 record in the circle with a 2.08 ERA. She's already posted two two-hit complete game shutouts with 27 strikeouts to her tally.
