THIS WEEK

The Sun Devil Softball squad (34-8 overall, 3-4 Pac-10) head home to the comfy confines of Farrington Stadium this weekend as they set to host the No. 14 Cal Golden Bears on Friday, April 17 at 7 p.m. and No. 2 Stanford on Saturday, April 18 and Sunday, April 19 at 7 p.m. and noon. All games will be played in Tempe at Farrington Stadium. Please note that Saturday's game against Stanford at this time only has 100 standing room only tickets left.

SERIES HISTORY & SCOUTING REPORT

Since 1981 the Sun Devils and the Golden Bears have gone head-to-head 99 times, with Friday's match-up as their centennial face-off. In that time Cal has taken the edge in the series with a 40-59 lead over A State. Last season, the Sun Devils swept the Bears for the first time this century with a 5-2 and two 4-2 wins over the Blue & Gold. All-time against the Bears, Clint Myers is 5-4.

1984 saw the Sun Devils kick-off a series against the Stanford Cardinal, where ASU has since ruled the roost with a 40-20 all-time record against the Cardinal. Last season, ASU took a 4-2 and 6-0 win from the Cardinal before they snaked a 2-1 win back from ASU. All-time against Stanford, Clint Myers is 7-2.

UP NEXT

The Sun Devils will remain home next weekend as Pac-10 play continues as they set to play hostess to the Washington Huskies and UCLA Bruins. They'll take on the Huskies on Friday, April 24 at 7 p.m. and UCLA on April 25 at 1 p.m. on FSN and April 26 at noon.

Non-Stop Until they reach the top

In the polls for 2008, the Sun Devils enjoyed a new record in the rankings section as they attained their highest ranking ever with a #2 ranking coming in Week 2 and continuing until Week 5. The best ranking was saved for the middle of the season....and the end. Number One in all polls. The ranking also marked the first time the Sun Devils have ever surpassed the Arizona Wildcats in ranking and only the second time they have passed UCLA (Last was in 2002.) This season, the Sun Devils have also set a new ranking record as they were awarded a No. 2 preseason ranking by USA Softball, the highest preseason ranking the Devils have ever received.

RUNS IN SCORING POSITION?

Last year the Sun Devil offense has had an affinity for starting off ahead. This year's squad is no exception, though might be even better as they seem to surge in the middle of games as well since most of their 325 runs have been scored in the first, second and third inning with 54 scored in the first 61 in the second and 67 in the third.

BIG POWER, LITTLE PACKAGE

Sophomore transfer from Louisville, Kaylyn Castillo showed up on ASU's doorstep this season and has refused to produce nothing but power. The tiny catcher has a quick arm behind the plate and even quicker bat while at it. She's currently batting .378 with 23 RBIs and four home runs for a .595 slugging percentage, one long ball coming against UCLA in Westwood.





Sun Devils have a goal of ensuring they put up runs before their opponents do...and when they have scored first this season, they're 23-2.

Don't Call It A Comeback...

Don't count them out if they can't post the first run though, as they're still 11-6 on the season when their opponent takes it to them first.

HOME SWEEEEEET HOME

The Sun Devils have found their home at Farrington Stadium to be a welcome one. Last season they held a 43-2 overall record at home, as well as an 9-1 Pac-10 record. They're currently 27-1 playing in Farrington Stadium in 2009.

We've Got Our Eye On You...

The Amateur Softball Association, the National Governing Body of Softball in the United States, has selected its 'Top 50 Watch List' for the 7th Annual USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Award. This award, which is considered one of the most prestigious honors in women's collegiate softball, is designed to recognize outstanding athletic achievement by female collegiate softball players across the country.

This season three-time First-Team All-American Kaitlin Cochran was again added to the Watch List for the third consecutive season and has made the cut yet again to the Top 25 Finalists.

OH MERCY, MERCY ME...

The Sun Devils seem to have a habit of giving opponents a bit of mercy. Out of 41 games, ASU has mercyruled opponents 15 times. One a 20-5 win over South Alabama at the Wilson/DiMarini Invitational. In addition, their first weekend of Pac-10 conference play, ASU swept the Oregon schools with three straight run-rule victories, the first time in ASU program history that they run-ruled an entire Pac-10 weekend. The Sun Devils also topped the UNLV Rebels on April 7 with a 20-15 win and a 15-2 win.

YOU MIGHT WANT TO MAKE A NOTE...

A State isn't just satisfied with season records and winning. They're etching their name all over the NCAA record books in single-game fun as well. Against UNLV on April 7, ASU hit 10 home runs in their 20-10 win over the Rebels, which ties the NCAA all-time single-game record. On the day they hit 15 home runs, adding five more in game two of that double-header.

Bring Your Green Hat...We're Going Streaking!

The Sun Devils won't be streaking through the quads, but they will be streaking through this season. Some of the more notatble streaks ASU has been on this season is:

- Kaitlin Cochran's seven consecutive games with a home run
- Kaitlin Cochran & Kaylyn Castillo's current 13 game hitting streaks
- Katelyn Boyd collected a 12 game hitting streak...is currently on a four-game one
