# No. 14 Sun Devils to Host Marquette and Part One of the 'Duel in the Desert'

#### THIS WEEK

The 14th-ranked Arizona State Women's Tennis Team (9-3) will return home again this week as they set to host the Marquette Golden Eagles and the Arizona Wildcats. The Sun Devils will face Marquette on Tuesday, March 18 at 1:30 p.m. and Arizona on Saturday, March 22, with both matches being held in Tempe at the Whiteman Tennis Center. Both times are Pacific.

Last time out saw the Sun Devils come out red-hot as they made quick work of the Oregon Ducks with a definitive 7-0 sweep to give ASU their ninth win on the season and their first Pac-10 win of the season.

#### How the Eagles Soar:

Marquette comes into the weekend with a 6-9 overall record, but don't let it fool you. as six of their nine losses are to ranked opponents. Their strength lies in their upperclassmen, which five of the ten roster members of the Golden Eagles are Juniors or Seniors. They are led by Maria Calbeto a senior from Guaynabo, P.R. who currently holds an 11-11 singles record, with a 3-0 record in the No. 1 spot. Freshman Christina Ruiz is also making noise with an 11-10 record with a 3-0 record in the No. 2 spot.

#### STALKING THE 'CATS

The Sun Devils' in-state and longtime rival, the Arizona Wildcats also travel up to Tempe this weekend with a 7-8 overall record coming off of two losses against No. 4 Stanford (7-0) and No. 7 California (6-1). They are led by the 62nd ranked Danielle Steinberg, a junior from Tel-Aviv with a 15-7 overall singles record and a 10-5 record in the No. 1 spot.

#### **UP NEXT**

The Sun Devils will remain home next week as they host Pac-10 power-houses Stanford and Califronia for Pac-10 standings on Friday, March 28 at 1:00 p.m. and Saturday the 29th at noon. All matches will be held in Tempe at the Whiteman Tennis Center.

It marks the 37th straight poll that the Devils have been in the top 30.

#### AT THE HELM

Coach Sheila McInerney enters her 24th season at the helm of the Sun Devil program, the fourth longest tenure of any head coach at ASU, after leading last year's team to its 20th consecutive appearance in the NCAA tournament, a school record. In her 23 seasons, McInerney has led her team to 22 berths in the tournament. Prior to the last three year's tournament rounds, McInerney had led eight straight teams to the Sweet 16. She holds a career record of 346-221 and has posted three 20-win seasons in her career. ASU has finished in the top-10 of the nation an astounding 13 times under McInerney's tutelage.
