No. 14 Sun Devils to Travel to the Bay Area to Face No. 8 Cal and No. 6 Stanford

THIS WEEK

The 14th-ranked Arizona State Women's Tennis Team (8-3) will hit the road for only the second time this season as they travel to Oregon to face Pac-10 foe, the Oregon Ducks in a duel that counts towards conference standings. The Sun Devils will face Cal on Friday, March 7 in Berkeley at 1:30 p.m. and Stanford on Saturday, March 8 in Palo Alto at noon. Both times are Pacific.

Last time out saw the Sun Devils come out swinging as they made quick work of the visiting UC Santa Barbara Gauchos with a definitive 7-0 sweep to give ASU their eighth win on the season.

DUCK TRACKS:

The Ducks come into the weekend with a 7-7 overall record coming off wins over Sacramento State and Portland, but falling to Nevada in the last week. Their strength lies in their upperclassmen, which five of the ten roster members of the Ducks are Juniors or Seniors. They are led by Anna Powaska a senior from Gdynia, Poland who currently holds a 10-15 singles record.

Last year the Sun Devils bested the Ducks, sweeping them in Tempe 7-0 where they won nearly every match in straight sets.

UP NEXT

The Sun Devils will return home next week as they host Marguette on Tuesday, March 18 at 1:30 p.m. before hosting Pac-10 rival, Arizona on Saturday the 22nd at 1:00 p.m. All matches will be held in Tempe at the Whiteman Tennis Center.

LEGENDS OF THE FALL

The Sun Devils had a very strong showing during their 2007 fall season, especially with such a young team making their collegiate debuts. They handled well as freshman, Kelcy McKenna was even able to jump into the rankings after going 11-3 through the fall to grab a #93 ranking before even playing in a duel match! After going 6-1 in singles through duel season as well, Kelcy has now

jumped to No. 63!

AT THE HELM Coach Sheila McInerney enters her 24th season at the helm of the Sun Devil program, the fourth longest tenure of any head coach at ASU, after leading last year's team to its 20th consecutive appearance in the NCAA tournament, a school record. In her 23 seasons, McInerney has led her team to 22 berths in the tournament. Prior to the last three year's tournament rounds, McInerney had led eight straight teams to the Sweet 16. She holds a career record of 346-221 and has posted hree 20-win seasons in her career. ASU has finished in the top-10 of the nation an astounding 13 times under McInerney's tutelage.
