Sun Devil Volleyball Ends 2003 Season With 9-18 Record Under First-Year Head Coach Brad Saindon

The Sun Devils finished the 2003 season with a 9-18 record and were ninth in the Pac-10 with a 4-14 record under first-year head coach Brad Saindon... previous head coach Patti Snyder-Park was also 4-14 and finished ninth in the Pac-10 in her first year at ASU... for the second straight year ASU beat rival Arizona at home with a thrilling come-from-behind 3-2 win over the then No. 21 Wildcats...redshirt junior Natalie Harris earned honorable mention All-Pac-10... she finished fifth in the league averaging 3.95 kills per game and recorded nine double-doubles... senior middle blocker Mandy Stephens set the ASU single-season record with a .383 hitting percentage and ranked fifth in the Pac-10... senior libero Courtney Blocher was fourth in the league with 3.50 digs per game and finished her career with 1,173 digs to rank 10th in school history... ASU finished the regular ranking second in the Pac-10 with 1.69 service aces per game... led by a team-high 34 aces from Harris, ASU finished with 166 total service aces after recording only 122 in 2002... senior outside hitter Kim Mehlhorn and sophomore outside hitter Sarah Watkins each recorded seven service aces in a single match... the seven aces are both rally-scoring records at ASU and tied for third in single-match history... Watkins and Mehlhorn each earned first-team Academic All-Pac-10 honors, while senior setter Cheryl Anglin and Blocher were named second-team... ASU now has 34 all-time All-Pac-10 Academic selections to rank first among conference schools... Anglin finished her career with 4,296 career assists, ranking second all-time in program history... senior outside hitter Juliana Escobar averaged 3.55 kpg and 3.12 kpg to ranks ninth in the Pac-10 in each category... the 2002 All-Pac-10 selection was dismissed from the team with four matches remaining in the season for violation of team rules... the Devils opened the season with an upset win over Utah to break a string of four straight season-opening losses... the Devils won the SMU Classic by sweeping UT Chattanooga, Stephen F. Austin and SMU... Stephens was named tournament MVP... in 12 home matches, the 2003 squad averaged an average crowd of 940 (11,283 total) to rank in the top 40 nationally... the 3,225 in the five-game win over Arizona (9/26) marked the fifth largest crowd in program history.

A Top Recruiting Class:

Arizona State Volleyball Head Coach Brad Saindon has announced the signing of five players to national letters of intent (NLI) to join the Sun Devil Volleyball program for the 2004 season. The class includes players from four different states (Arizona, California, Oregon, Illinois) and includes one setter, one libero, two middle blockers and an outside hitter. The Sun Devils inked setter Rachel Mittelstaedt (Phoenix, Ariz./Xavier Prep), highly-touted libero Sydney Donahue (Manhattan Beach, Calif./Mira Costa), middle blocker Staci Smith (Gresham, Ore./Gresham), middle blocker Kristin Trayser (Crystal Lake, Ill./Crystal Lake South) and outside hitter Danielle Fernandes (Santa Monica, Calif./Taft).

Aces Are Wild:

Twice during the 2003 season a pair of Sun Devils have recorded seven service aces in a single match. The seven aces served up by Sarah Watkins (8/29 vs. Utah) and Kim Mehlhorn (9/26 vs. Arizona) are tied for the third most in ASU single-match history. The school record for service aces in a match is nine set by Regina Stahl vs. New Mexico in 1984. The performances by Mehlhorn and Watkins both established records under the rally scoring format. For the season, ASU finished third in the Pac-10 averaging 1.69 aces per game (166 total). The Devils demolished their 2002 total of 122 in 27 matches. Junior outside hitter Natalie Harris finished the season ranked ninth with 0.35 aces per game and senior Juliana Escobar was eighth with 0.38 per game. ASU had four total players record 30 or more aces during the season (Harris, 34; Mehlhorn, 31; Escobar, 31; Watkins (30).

Watkins Named Academic All-District:

Arizona State sophomore outside hitter Sarah Watkins has been named to the CoSida Academic All-District VIII second-team for her outstanding accomplishments on the court and in the classroom. Watkins (Mishawaka, Ind.) has a 4.0 GPA in the classroom as an education major with an emphasis on Spanish. On the court, Watkins started all 27 of ASU's matches, averaging 2.26 kills per game.

Harris Becoming Big-Time Player:

Redshirt junior Natalie Harris has quickly become ASU's go-to player on the court. The honorable mention All-Pac-10 selection finished fifth in the Pac-10 with a team-leading 3.95 kpg average. She also led the Devils with 34 service aces and was fourth on the team averaging 2.39 dpg. She recorded 21 matches with 10 or more kills (78% of ASU's matches) and recorded nine double-doubles. Harris made the all-tournament team at the SBC/Sand Regency Volleyball Classic in Reno, Nev. Harris tied her previous career high with 17 digs against Tennessee (9/6) and set a new high with 24 kills. She also had 27.5 points and four total blocks vs. the Lady Vols. She tallied five matches with 20 or more kills, including a career-high 23 at nationally ranked Stanford (10/31).

Stephens Sets School Record:

Senior middle blocker Mandy Stephens (Napa, Calif.) broke the single-season hitting percentage record with a .383 mark. She ranked fifth in the Pac-10 and 13th in the NCAA. She broke the old ASU single-season record set by Julia Leddy in 2002 with a .367 attack percentage. Stephens made only 52 hitting errors on 462 total attacks. She was named the tournament MVP of the SMU Radisson Volleyball classic held Sept. 12-13 in Dallas. Stephens averaged 3.00 kills per game and did not make a hitting error on 46 attacks (.587%) during tourney play. She recorded one of the best matches of her career in the three-game win over SMU (9/13) when she tallied 10 kills (.625 attack percentage) and a career-high six blocks. She recorded 10 or more kills in 11 matches and had a hitting percentage over .500 in nine matches. Stephens finished her senior season averaging 2.34 kpg and 0.66 blocks per game.

Packing the House:

The official attendance of 3,225 for the Arizona (9/26) match marked only the fourth time since 1990 that an ASU Volleyball match had a crowd of over 3,000. The crowd was the fourth best dating back to 1990 and is second most dating back to the 1994 season. The school record for attendance at a home match was in 1986 against Stanford when 8,516 fans attempted to break the NCAA record. ASU also drew 1,114 in the home match against No. 1 USC, marking the 21st largest recorded crowd in program history. In the NCAA Volleyball Attendance Rankings, ASU ranked in the top 40 in the nation with an average crowd of 940 and the 3,225 vs. Arizona is the 62nd highest attended match this year.

Down 0-2... No Problem:

After being down 0-2 to Arizona, the Devils stormed back to capture the thrilling 3-2 win over the Wildcats. The come-from-behind win marked the third straight year under the rally scoring format that ASU has rallied for victory after being down a pair of games. The Devils defeated California (Oct. 11) last year at home by scores of 27-30, 21-30, 30-27, 30-26, 15-10. In 2001, the Devils defeated in-state rival Northern Arizona (Oct. 23, 2001) also after being down 2-0. The Devils came back to defeat the Lumberjacks 28-30, 25-30, 30-21, 30-19, 15-9. ASU is 2-1 this year in five-game matches. ASU almost defeated No. 9 Stanford (10/31/03), coming back from a 2-0 deficit before falling 15-9 in the final set.

Anglin Ends Career No. 2 Among All-Time Setters:

Senior setter Cheryl Anglin became only the second Sun Devil to record 4,000 assists in a career. Anglin gained sole possession of second place in the ASU career record books midway through her junior season, moving past former Sun Devil Jennifer Helfrich. She ended her career with 4,296 career assists in 110 matches (10.56 per game average). She recorded 76 assists vs. Oregon (10/18/02) to rank as the sixth most in ASU single-match history and established an ASU and Pac-10 rally-scoring (adopted in 2001) record. Anglin also holds the single-season school record and freshman record when she had 1,452 in 2000 and also has the second (84) and fifth (77) most assist in single-match history. Anglin led the Devils in 2003 with 7.51 assists per game and recorded 10 matches with 30 or more assists.

Blocher Ends Career Ranked 10th With 1,173 Career Digs:

Senior libero Courtney Blocher made history during the Arizona match when she recorded her 1,000th career dig. Blocher, a four-year starter for the Sun Devils, notched 14 digs to pass the milestone, becoming only the 13th player in Sun Devil Volleyball history to reach 1,000 digs in a career. Current assistant coaches Jami Coughlin (1,528) and Terri Cox (1,382) are second and third respectively in ASU's career record books. Blocher ended her career by recording 10 or more digs in six of her last eight matches and fell just five digs of reaching No. 9 on the list (Tammy Webb). Blocher recorded 17 matches in 2003 with 10 or more digs and 63 in her career.
