Devils vs. Stanford

The Sun Devils lead the all-time series with Stanford, 94-91. The Devils are 6-8 in series' vs. the Cardina since 2000, with ASU recording three sweeps and Stanford recording one. ASU lost 2-of-3 to Stanford in 2013 at Tempe and were swept by the Cardinal in Palo Alto in 2012. The Devils won 2-of-3 in Tempe in 2011 and won 2-of-3 over then-No. 25 Stanford in Palo Alto in 2010.

Gaining Momentum In The Pac

The Sun Devils won their fourth consecutive Pac-12 series after taking two against Cal and have won eight of their past 11 Pac-12 Conference games.

There are 36 different teams ranked in one (or more) of the five major collegiate baseball polls (Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball, NCBWA, Perfect Game, USA Today Coaches' Poll) and the Sun Devils are one of seven ranked schools to win their past four conference series'. Of those seven, ASU is one of three major-conference schools to accomplish this feat, joining Virginia and Washington. The other schools to do so are Liberty, Louisiana-Lafayette, Pepperdine and UNLV.

Up Next

Arizona State heads to Tucson to take on Arizona in a three-game Pac-12 road series and the final three games of the Territorial Cup Series on April 25-27. First pitch on Friday is set for 7 p.m. PT, Saturday at 7:30 pm PT and Sunday at 4:30 p.m. PT. Friday and Saturday's games will be televised by the Pac-12 Networks and Sunday's will be televised on ESPNU. All three games will be broadcast on NBC Sports AM 1060 by Tim Healey (PxP, @) TimHealeyASU) and Seth Dhaenens (color, @sethdhaenens). Live stats will also be available.

Head Coach Tim Esmay

Tim Esmay is in his fifth season as head baseball coach at Arizona State after taking over his alma mater in 2010 and leading them to a Pac-10 title and a berth in the College World Series. The 2010 Pac-10 Coach of the Year, Esmay is in his 14th overall season as a coach at Arizona State and his 13th overall as a Div. I head coach. He spent 2005 to 2009 as an assistant coach, including the last three as the assistant head coach. He played two seasons as an infielder under Jim Brock in 1986 and 1987, and following his playing days, Esmay served as an assistant coach at ASU under Jim Brock from 1988 to 1990, then again in Brock's final season of 1994.

Esmay was the head baseball coach at the University of Utah from 1997 to 2004, winning a WAC title and WAC Coach of the Year honors in 1997. In eight seasons at Utah he compiled a 213-235-1 record.

His .810 winning percentage over his first 100 games at Arizona State is the second highest in school history.

In first four seasons at ASU:
Has guided ASU to the second-highest regular-season winning percentage in the Pac-12 since 2010, behind UCLA (183-74, .712), but ahead of Oregon State (165-76, .684) and Oregon (163-83-1, .662)

Has posted a winning record in the 78 games he has played against top-25 teams (43-35) and also has a winning record against four of the top teams in the Pac-12, including Arizona (11-9), Oregon State (7-6), Oregon (7-5) and UCLA (7-5)

One of just 10 Pac-12 coaches all-time to guide their teams to consecutive College World Series appearances (09-10)

Is 11-6 all-time in the postseason, including 8-2 in Regional play

Sophomore Sluggers

Sophomores infielder **Dalton DiNatale** and designated hitter/catcher **RJ Ybarra** have carried their freshmen success at the plate into their sophomore campaigns. They have a combined 57 RBI, 29 runs scored, 79 hits and 20 extra-bast hits. They both have over a .400 slugging percentage and a combined 23 multi-hit games, and DiNatale is currently riding a 14-game hitting streak. In 2013, **Ybarra** and **DiNatale** hit .313 and .302 on the season, respectively, to become the fourth pair of freshmen teammates since 2006 to bat over .300 in a single season. The duo joins a list of other Devil freshmen that includes current Major Leaguers **Ike Davis, Brett Wallace, Dustin Pedroia** and **Willie Bloomquist**.

#LileKKK

Sophomore left-hander **Brett Lilek** leads the team in strikeouts and WHIP (1.03), and is 29th in the nation (3rd in Pac-12) in hits allowed per nine innings with 5.59. He moved into the Friday Night Starter role against Tennessee on March 7 after spending the first three weeks of the season as the Sunday starter and did not disappoint. He allowed just four baserunners in a career-long seven innings in the win over No. 19 UT and did not allow a run in 20 consecutive innings from the fourth inning against Wright State on Feb. 23 to the seventh inning against UW on March 14. He has put together consecutive seven-inning outings, his career-long, and his outings increased each start in 2014 as he went six innings against Wright State and threw four in his first start of the season against Baylor on Feb. 16.

Freshman Behind The Dish

Freshman **catcher Brian Serven** earned the starting catcher job through the first three weeks of the season and has the chance to become just the third true freshmen catcher in the past 20 years at ASU to start the majority of the season, joining Petey Paramore in 2006 and Trent Pratt in 1999. He has started 26 games this season at catcher, has a .996 fielding percentage with 22 assists and nine caught stealing, and is batting .313 (31-for-99) with six doubles, a home run, 17 RBI and 18 runs scored. He knocked in a team-high four hits against Gonzaga on Feb. 28, tied a career high with three RBI vs Arizona March 26, and scored a team-high three runs vs Baylor on Feb. 16, and has nine multi-hit games.

Impressive Footsteps To Follow

Freshman **shortstop Colby Woodmanse**e has started the past 21 games at shorstop and has the chance to become the seventh true freshman shortstop in the past 20 years at ASU to start the majority of the season. Michael Collins, (1996-98), Dustin Pedroia (2002-04), Andrew Romine (2005-07) and Deven Marrero (2010-12) all were true freshmen starters who went to start three consecutive seasons at shortstop. Pedroia is a two-time World Series Champion and 2008 AL MVP with the Boston Red Sox, Romine plays for the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim and Marrero is in the Boston Red Sox organization. Woodmansee has turned 11 double plays.

From Closer To Starter To Closer

Sophomore **RHP Ryan Burr** became the third Sun Devil in the past five seasons (**RHP Jake Barrett -** current Arizona Diamondbacks minor leaguer and **RHP Trevor Williams** - current Miami Marlins minor leaguer) to begin his career as a reliever before moving into a starting role the following season. After three starts, however, Burr moved back into the closer role against Tennesse and recorded a four-out save in his only appearance of the weekend. Burr notched 12 saves in 2013 to set the school's freshman single-season

saves record and now has seven in 2014 to give him 19 career saves, third most in school history.

Gillies' Finds A Niche

RHP Darin Gillies started 10 games his freshman season and notched a 5.03 ERA in 39.1 innings. He then started the first weekend of 2013 and allowed five earned runs on no hits in one inning before he was moved into a reliever role where he flourished for the rest of the year. He made 27 relief appearances and did not allow a run in 21 of 27 relief appearances. In 2014, Gillies pitched three innings of relief in the season opener before he was thrust back into a starting role. He made his fourth quality start of the season on April 13 in a no-decision at Cal where he scattered two hits across a career-long seven scoreless innings, matched his season high with six strikeouts and allowed just two runners to move into scoring position. In his fourth start of 2014 Against Washignton on March 16 he did not allow an earned run in six innings and also matched his season high with six strikeouts in a no-decision. He did not allow an earned run in 12 1/3 consecutive innings from March 9 against Tennessee until the fifth inning against Oregon State March 23.

A Two-Way Tradition

Shortstop/right-handed pitcher Jordan Aboites has played at eight games at shortstop, including seven starts, and has made 14 relief appearances out of the bullpen, tied for the 2nd most on the team, and is second on the team with three wins. He is following a long tradition of two-way players at ASU as there have been 62 total Devils, including ASU Hall of Famers Jamie Allen, Doug Henry, Jerry Hochever and Lerrin LaGrow, and current Major Leaguers Kole Calhoun, Ike Davis and Mike Leake.

Causey At The Bat

Designated hitter/first baseman Nate Causey is picking up where he left off the 2013 season. He leads the team in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored and doubles, and is second on team in hits and total bases. He went 10-for-13 from the plate in the Devils' three-game winning streak against OSU and UA March 22-26, including a pair of four-hit performances. He went 10-for-19 with three runs scored and three RBI in five starts at first base against Wichita State and Oregon State, including six hits and two runs scored in three games against the 4th-ranked Beavers. He tallied 15 RBI and four home runs in his final 12 games of 2013 after notching just 11 RBI and zero home runs in his first 27 games of the year, including 10 RBI in two games May 12 against Cal and May 15 against Texas Tech.

RJ Clutch

Sophomore RJ Ybarra has delivered five game-winning hits in the ninth or later in his career, including three in the past three weekends.

- One-out sacrifice fly in bottom of the 11th inning to give ASU 10-9 win over USC on April 5, 2014
- Two-out, pinch-hit RBI single in top of the 10th inning to give ASU 6-5 win at No. 15 UCLA on March 30, 2014
- RBI single with one out in top of the 10th inning to give ASU 3-2 win at No. 4 Oregon State on March 22, 2014
- One-out RBI single in the bottom of the 11th inning to give ASU a 6-5 win over No. 11 Oregon on April 5, 2013 RBI single with two outs in the top of the ninth to give ASU a 4-3 win at Wichita State on April 2, 2013

Defending The Diamond

The Devils have not committed an error in back-to-back games THREE times this season (final game against UCLA, first game against USC, against Gonzaga and Oklahoma State, and final two games against Baylor). ASU did not commit an error in back-to-back games only FOUR times in 2013, including a season-high three games March 9-10 against Long Beach. In 2012, the Devils did not commit an error in two or more consecutive games only THREE times, but that includes a stretch of seven errorless games from April 29-May 13. ASU is 7-2 this season when they do not commit an error.

Free Baseball

The Sun Devils are 4-2 in six extra-innings games this season. Five other schools have also played six extra-innings games and only South Dakota State also has a 4-2 record. Southern Illinois leads the nation with eight extra-innings games (4-4), while eight schools have played seven extra-innings games. Hartford and Florida are both 5-2 in extrainnings games.

Preseason Golden Spikes

Sophomore right-hander Ryan Burr and sophomore left-hander Ryan Kellogg were both named to the USA Baseball Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List. ASU is one of only four schools in the nation with a pair of pitchers on the watch list, along with Cal State Fullerton, Kentucky and Oregon State. The pitchers become the ninth and 10th Sun Devils, respectively, to be named to the award's preseason watch list since 2010. Nine Sun Devils have been named finalists and threee have won the award.

Packing Them In:

ASU has led the West Coast and Pac-12 in average attendance for nine consecutive years and 10 of the past 11 seasons. The Devils currently rank 20th in average attendance at 2,790 (58,606 total in 21 games), which is close to more than 200 fans per game than the next closest West Coast team, Oregon State.

The Sun Devils welcome back 22 lettermen, including eight pitchers and 14 position players. The returners are headlined by preseason All-American pitchers RHP Ryan Burr and LHP Ryan Kellogg, as well as 2013 freshmen All-Americans C RJ Ybarra and INF Dalton DiNatale. Three 2013 All-Pac-12 honorees return, incluing Burr, Kellogg and OF Trever Allen.

The freshmen class features five local products, including RHP Hever Bueno (Mesa, Ariz.), INF Cooper Esmay (Casa Grande, Ariz.), INF David Greer (Scottsdale, Ariz.), RHP Seth Martinez (Peoria, Ariz.), INF Colby Woodmansee (Phoenix, Ariz.), as well as RHP Colin Ashworth (Placentia, Calif.), C Zach Cerbo (Montville, N.J.), RHP Eder Erives (El Paso, Texas). Both transfers are local products: INF Cory Bernard (Chandler, Ariz./CG CC), INF Joey Bielek (Scottsdale, Ariz./Cincinnati, PV CC).

No. 34 On The Stirrups - The Cory Hahn Story

The Sun Devils wear the No. 34 on their stirrups to honor former sutdent-athlete and current student coach **Cory Hahn**, who was paralyzed from the chest down sliding into second base in the third game of his college career in 2011. Hahn was California's Mr. Baseball and Orange County Player of the Year, led Mater Dei to a CIF title, played on the United States' first gold medal 18U team alongside Bryce Harper and Manny Machado, and was a 26th round pick by the San Diego Padres in the 2010 MLB Draft.

An ESpecial Coach - Since 2010

- Have the second-highest regular-season winning percentage in the Pac-12 with a record of 168-70-1 (.703). That is just behind UCLA (183-74, .712), but ahead of Oregon State (165-76, .684) and Oregon (163-83-1, .662)
- Lead the Pac-12 in First Team All-Conference selections with 20, two more than UCLA and Arizona, who each have 18.
- Rank 1st in the Pac-12 slugging percentage, fewest sacrifice bunts and most home runs per season, and 2nd in the conference batting average, most hits per season and most RBI per season.
- Lead the nation in MLB Draft picks with 38, five more than the next closet team, Florida.

Streaking In February Series'

The Sun Devils have now 15 consecutive series in February, including all nine under head coach Tim Esmay. The last time ASU lost a series in February was Feb. 18-20, 2005, when they were swept by No. 1 Tulane on the road.

Summer Lovin'

Fifteen members of the 2014 Arizona State baseball team participated in summer collegiate baseball this past summer, including Ryan Burr, who competed for Team USA. Other Devils who played in summer leagues include Ryan Kellogg (Bourne Braves, Cape Cod League), Drew Stankiewicz (Hyannis Harbor Hawks, Cape Cod League), Darin Gillies, David Graybill and Brett Lilek (Newport Gulls, New England Collegiate League), Dalton DiNatale (Ocean State Waves, New England Collegiate League), Jake Peevyhouse (Laconia Muskrats, New England Collegiate League), Cullen O'Dwyer, Jordan Aboites and Eric Melbostad (Bend Elks, West Coast League), RJ Ybarra, Chris Beall and Johnny Sewald (Bellingham Bells, West Coast League), and Kyle Bilbrey (Derby Twins, Jayhawk League)

Senior Leader. On & Off The Field

Right-hander **Josh McAlister** was nominated for the Senior CLASS Award, given to student-athletes who display leadership and character on and off the field. He graduated Magna Cum Laude (3.57 GPA) with a Bachelor's of Science in Accountancy in December 2013 and is now a graduate student currently enrolled in a Masters of Accountancy program at ASU. He is the current President of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA), is the current spokesperson for the Holiday Food Drive for the Sun Devils Serve Organization and represents Sun Devil baseball on the ASU Student Athlete Advisory Committee. He allowed just one run in the final 12 2/3 innings of the 2013 season dating back to May 15 against Texas Tech, including a career-high 5.1 scoreless innings in the final game of the season against Cal State Fullerton June 2 in game four of the NCAA Regional. He allowed just four hits 6.1 combined scoreless innings in a doubleheader that day, including one hit in a win against Columbia and three hits in the loss to Cal State Fullerton.

Legacy Devils

Trever Allen (father, Jamie Allen), Tucker Esmay (father, Tim Esmay; brother, Cooper), Cooper Esmay (father, Tim Esmay; brother, Tucker); David Graybill (father, Dave Graybill), Colin Ashworth (uncle, Floyd Bannister); Mark Lambson (brother, Mitchell Lambson), Emilio Torrez (brothers, Raoul and Riccio Torrez), and Joey Bielek (uncle, Brett Wallerstedt (football)).

A Tradition Of USA Collegiate Baseball

Tim Esmay served as an assistant coach and **Ryan Burr** tied the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team record with six saves this past summer and recorded the final out of the summer to give Team USA a historic five-game series sweep over the Cuban National Team (first USA team ever to defeat Cuba in five consecutive games). ASU has had a representative on the team each year since 2007and a Sun Devil has been represented on the Collegiate National Team 15 seasons, which is fourth most behind Stanford (21), Cal State Fullerton (19) and Miami (17). ASU's 20 players are tied for the fourth most with Georgia Tech and trail Stanford (29), Cal State Fullerton (22) and Miami (21).

Academic Success

Eighteen student-athletes earned Scholar Baller® recognition during the Fall 2013 semester, which honors those who achieved a 3.0 GPA or higher. Eight Sun Devils have earned Scholar Baller® recognition in each of the past three semesters (Fall 2012-Fall 2013) semesters while a total of 26 current baseball student-athletes have earned it in at least one of the past three semesters.
