### **Elisha Davis, ASU Junior Guard:**

# On whether last years' experience in the NCAA Tournament is helping the team this year:

"Yes, I would say so, because now we know what to expect. So when you actually play in 'March Madness' it doesn't matter what your seed or ranking is because everybody's playing for everything and teams have gotten better, and everyone plays their best in March. So that's what we learned, just to take every game as if it's our last or it's our championship game, just to bring urgency. We're going to stay connected as a team no matter what happens in the game."

On what stands out about Ohio after watching the Bobcats game film: "Threes. They're a good shooting team. It means we need to have better communication on our defense because if they're shooting a lot of threes, it means you have to talk, you have to be in tune, and in sync. From them, it's going to make us be more on point on defense, and that's our catalyst.

### **Kelsey Moos, ASU Sophomore Forward:**

### On whether last years' experience in the NCAA Tournament is helping the team this year:

"After playing, you know how much different it is from the rest of the season. You know how important it is for you to come out and be together and play your best basketball right now. It helps to be in that situation last year so we know what to expect a little bit."

## On her emotions going into the game against Ohio:
